

ROBBEN ISLAND BLUE STONE QUARRY PHOTOGRAPHS WINTER 2001

A survey was undertaken as part of an HIA commissioned for the construction of a concrete retaining wall on the inside of the sea dyke.

The wall was built between 1963 and 1977 by political prisoners sentenced by the apartheid regime.

The wall was maintained between ca 1980 and ca 1990 by common law prisoners after quarry activities ceased in 1977.

METHODOLOGY

Images have been reproduced in this document to enable easy access.

The digital images of the photographs are high resolution 4272x3066.

Images were taken with a Fujifilm Finepix S2960 digital camera.

Only the first photograph in each sequence is provided with a digital number.

The provenance of the photographs is not known.

The photographer and type of camera is not known.

AGFA 100 colour film was used.

The photographs were taken in the winter of 2001.

The photographs were developed on 2001-06-27.

The original images were found in a metal filing cabinet at the research unit in no particular order, unaccessioned and not curated.

The original photographs are housed at RIM.
