Thank you for allocating time we sincerely hope all is well with you. We're a mineral exploration company based in Bethlehem in the Free State. We were referred to your organization(SAHRA) by the Department of Mineral Resources(DMR) in Welkom to kindly request a comment in connection with our prospecting right application to prospect for diamondiferous kimberlite in the farm De Villiers Drift 338 situated in the magisterial district of Fouriesburg in the Free State province.
