

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION

In support of application for Exploration Right for Petroleum on various farms in Registration Divisions ET, FT, GS, GT, GU & GV in the Magisterial district of Pietermaritzburg, Kwazulu-Natal

Rhino Oil and Gas Exploration South Africa (Pty) Ltd has lodged an application for an exploration right to the Petroleum Agency South Africa (PASA) in terms of section 79 of the Minerals and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002. Rhino Oil and Gas will make an application to PASA for environmental authorisation of exploration activities as set out in the Listing Notices made in terms of Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA).

The initial exploration area includes nearly 10 000 farms over an area of ~ 1 500 000 ha. In broad terms the exploration area extends from Richmond in the south to Ladysmith and Dundee in the north-west, passing just eastwards of Mooi River and Estcourt. In the north the area extends east almost to Ulundi and includes the regions around Tugela Ferry and Nkandla. The extent of the area narrows toward the south, including Kranskop, New Hanover and Asburton but being bounded just west of Camperdown. Residential properties within the block are not included. A map and list of included farms are available on request.

Rhino Oil and Gas proposes to undertake early-phase exploration for oil and gas which may be located underground within suitable geological strata. The purpose is to determine the presence of a petroleum resource which could be investigated further. The initial 3-year exploration work programme will be restricted to non-invasive techniques, seismic surveys and the drilling of less than 10 core boreholes. Rhino will require access to only a few farms for exploration activities and will agree terms with those land owners. No hydraulic fracturing or fracking is proposed.

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OUSTING GOVERNING BODIES

'Changes will compromise SA education'

PROPOSED changes to the South African Schools Act would wrest power from parents, and compromise the quality of public education, governing body associations and teachers' unions said yesterday.

A draft version of the Basic Education Laws Amendment Bill, which The Mercury has seen a copy of, proposes that school governing bodies have no part in the appointment of school-level heads of department, deputy principals or principals. It also says the law should be amended so the heads of provincial education departments have the final say on school admissions, and may instruct a public school to have more than one language of instruction.

Governing body associations and teachers' unions argue that should these amendments be made law, public-school parents will take their money and their children to independent schools.

Paul Colditz, the head of the Federation of Governing Bodies of South African Schools, said while the draft of the bill was under discussion, it was a "kick in the teeth" for parents and undermined the principles on which the post-1994 public education system was founded. "A principal is the guiding spirit of the school, and a school dies when the principal is not accepted by the school community."

Tim Gordon, the head of the Governing Body Foundation, said it was neither unusual, nor sinister for the Schools Act to be revised – but that this time, the signs were worrying.

Basil Manuel, the head of the National Professional Teachers' Organisation of South Africa, expressed "discomfort" over the proposal that governing bodies have no say in the appointment of principals. "We cannot reject the amendments until we see

them in full. But how many senior officials acquire posts through dishonest means? What happens when these people are responsible for appointing principals?

"The practicalities have also not been thought through. KwaZulu-Natal has 3 700 promotion posts to be filled. If there are 50 applicants for each post, how will education officials be able to sift through 185 000 CVs? And if there are committees all over the show to conduct the interview process, who will oversee them, inept and overloaded officials?"

Manuel said amending the law on school admissions was tantamount to "swotting a mosquito with a canon" because few of the country's 24 000 public schools had admissions problems.

Amendment

The head of the Suid Afrikaanse Onderwysersunie, Chris Klopper, said education authorities needed to realise that in a constitutional dispensation, parents did not take kindly to being prescribed to by politicians.

Basic Education Department spokesman Elijah Mhlangu would not be drawn on the issue yesterday.

The draft bill is expected to be finalised by next year at the latest, according to the department's 2014/15 annual report.

The ANC's 53rd national elective conference resolved that legislation be amended so the current process by which principals were appointed, deemed "deficient" and "open to undue influences," could be changed.

According to the National Development Plan, union interference in appointing principals is possible because education officials responsible for Human Resources have a limited understanding of labour law. It also says many governing bodies are hampered by parents' lack of expertise and social status.

Just seven more years for KZN adventurer

IT IS a year since Pietermaritzburg adventurer Angelo Wilkie-Page left home on an eight-year solo journey to circumnavigate the globe twice – from west to east, and from the South Pole to the North Pole – without motors, sails or solar power.

Wilkie-Page, 29, is an interior design graduate from the Durban University of Technology. He has just completed one year of his eight-year expedition.

"I made it into Nome (in

Alaska) today, walked in the last 20 miles (32km) as it was snowing and high winds east of Cape Nome this morning. This has been a tough segment from Fairbanks, and a great test for what is to come. Feeling strong," he posted on his website at the weekend.

Along the way, Wilkie-Page has been speaking about his experiences at schools and public places.

His spokesman, Patrick Cromwell, said Wilkie-Page had completed the first leg from Los Angeles to Fairbanks in Alaska, a distance of

6 500km in which he was exposed to extreme opposites of climate.

"A warm start on the west coast to cycling through the Rocky Mountains," he said.

Cromwell said that in Fairbanks, Wilkie-Page had changed his mode of transport to a custom-built kayak and paddled down the Yukon River towards the Bering Sea.

"Winter was coming in too fast, and Angelo had to make a quick decision. In Kaltag, he flew his kayak ahead to Unalakleet, an Alaskan town on the Bering Sea, and became the

first person to solo walk successfully from Kaltag to Unalakleet through the mountain range, in summer," he said.

Cromwell said Wilkie-Page had, to date, covered more than 2 000km in his kayak.

"Angelo's next obstacle is to overcome red tape and bureaucracy to enter Russia from the Bering Sea with his kayak.

"He will then kayak around the Russian coastline till the town of Magadan, where he will be reunited with his bicycle and cycle through Siberia, Asia, the Middle East and Africa, ending Leg 2 in Cape

Town," he said. The second leg is estimated to be in the region of a whopping 35 000km.

The third leg will see him row from Cape Town to Rio in a purpose-built solo rowing boat, whereafter he will cycle to Argentina and then back up the West Coast to end his first circumnavigation in Los Angeles.

Cromwell said Legs 5 to 8 would be the second circumnavigation – north to south.

Wilkie-Page's expedition aims to raise funds for Heifer International South Africa.

Other law changes proposed

THE security around Radovan Krejcir's court cases has massively increased, after police discovered the Czech businessman had multiple plots in play to escape from prison.

It was revealed that another escape attempt that was planned for yesterday morning had been foiled.

The sentencing proceedings for Krejcir and his five co-accused were set to start at the high court in Johannesburg yesterday, but the usual SAPS team monitoring the court had more than doubled in number.

Late last month, Krejcir's

cell at Zonderwater Correctional Centre was raided and several illegal items were discovered hidden inside, including a 9mm pistol, a knife, ammunition, a taser and 10 cellphones.

It's understood that these items were meant to be used as part of an escape bid from the facility, with Krejcir allegedly planning to flee to Swaziland, and then to Mozambique and eventually to Argentina.

However, national police spokesman Lieutenant-General Solomon Makgale said yesterday that this was not the only escape attempt Krejcir had been planning.

This, he said, was the rea-

son that security had been increased.

It is also understood, from another police source, that the reason the security had to be upped so quickly was because of an alleged plan by Krejcir to escape yesterday morning. The police apparently became aware of this at the weekend.

Makgale said intelligence sources had revealed that Krejcir had constantly been requesting medical attention from a specific doctor at a specific time and date, which police believed was part of another

plan for the Czech businessman to make his escape.

"We know that he wants to escape... He realises the court proceedings have come to a certain point, and he believes his only option is to escape," said Makgale.

While police have several leads on those who were, and are, set to assist Krejcir in his escape plots, Makgale said no arrests had been made.

However, numerous witnesses and possible suspects were being interviewed.

"He is getting help from fellow inmates and correctional services (officials)... There will be arrests in the near future."

Meanwhile, Krejcir's legal team has also lodged a formal request at the high court in Pretoria to have him transferred to another prison.

The application is set to be heard today.

Makgale said the police were aware of this transfer application, but that if it was successful, it would be up to the Department of Correctional Services to ensure that he did not try to make any escape attempts while being moved.

Krejcir was convicted earlier this year on charges of kidnapping, attempted murder and drug dealing for abducting the brother of one of his business contacts who had fled with a shipment of drugs worth millions of rand.

Yesterday, the sentencing proceedings in the matter had to be postponed, after it was revealed that the pre-sentencing reports had not yet been received by the state or defence.

Department officials assured the legal teams they would be prepared by October 28.

Three days have been set down for arguing mitigating and aggravating circumstances for the six convicts, although it is unclear if the sentencing will be completed by the end of the year.

Cecil hunter gets off

HARARE: A US trophy hunter who killed a GPS-collared lion in July would not be charged, Zimbabwean Environment Minister Oppah Muchinguri-Kashiri said yesterday.

"We have decided not to pursue the matter. It was causing unnecessary friction," he said.

Minnesota dentist Walter Palmer sparked worldwide outrage when he killed Cecil, a 13-year-old lion who had been lured out of the Hwange National Park and wounded with an arrow.

Palmer and his guide, Theo Bronkhorst, then took 40 hours to track him down and finish him off. Bronkhorst and the owner of the land where the hunt took place have been charged with an illegal hunt.

Zimbabwe had initially said it would seek the extradition of Palmer, but Muchinguri-Kashiri backed track from that stance yesterday. – dpa

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Msunduzi sues SA Incinerator Co

Company that installed Mountain Rise cremators allegedly breached contract by sub-contracting job

MSUNDUZI Municipality wants the company that installed two new cremators and refurbished a third at Mountain Rise cemetery in 2013 to refund the R5 728 616 it was paid.

The municipality complains in high court papers that the SA Incinerator Co (Pty) Ltd failed to comply with the terms of its contract.

It allegedly breached the contract by sub-contracting out all (or a major part) of the job and by providing work and equipment that was "materially defective". The municipality is also asking the company to pay additional damages of R1 064 856 to cover the increased costs that will have to be borne by Msunduzi if it has to appoint new contractors to start again. Alternatively Msunduzi says SA Incinerator could correct the alleged-

ly defective work on the cremators at a cost of R389 500.

The SA Incinerator Co is opposing Msunduzi's demands and has filed a motion asking the high court to dismiss the case on grounds that the summons and particulars of claim lodged by the municipality are "confusing, vague and embarrassing".

The case was yesterday adjourned *sine die* (without a court date being set) by high court Judge Trevor Gorven.

Two weeks ago *The Witness* reported on the crippling effect that the pending legal wrangle and a malfunctioning furnace at Mountain Rise was having on the community wanting to conduct cremations. Local undertakers said they were under "immense pressure" after two cremators had stopped operations three weeks earlier.

In yesterday's high court papers

Msunduzi Municipality says it first invited tenders in respect of the contract for the replacement of cremators at Mountain Rise Crematorium in October 2012.

In March 2013, Msunduzi accepted the tender submitted by the SA Incinerator Co. In terms of their contract the company allegedly undertook to entirely remove one existing cremator, and to supply and install two new cremators.

The papers state that the company undertook to comply with all applicable legislation, and warranted that all the materials and components used and supplied, would comply with SABS specifications. Work would be performed and completed in a "proper workmanlike manner" and meet the required health and safety regulations.

Msunduzi maintains that in terms of the agreement the company undertook not to sub-contract the work to anyone

else without Msunduzi's consent. It also accepted responsibility for the "repair and replacement" of any defects within 12 months of delivery.

The agreed contract price was R5 324 283, plus a further R495 000 for the "refurbishment" of the existing cremator and R40 000 per month for five years for maintenance. To date, Msunduzi said it has paid the company R5 728 616 but maintains the company breached its contract by subcontracting all "or a substantial part" of the work without consent, and "performed work and supplied services and equipment which were materially defective".

The company has also allegedly not provided any maintenance.

Msunduzi alleges that if it had to award the contract from scratch to someone else the cost would increase to R6 389 139.

Hlaudi: 'I have no doubt I will be found not guilty'

CAPE TOWN — SABC COO Hlaudi Motsoeneng believes a disciplinary hearing scheduled for the end of the month will exonerate him.

"I have no doubt that I will be found not guilty of the charges that have been instituted against me," he stated in an affidavit. The affidavit accompanied an application to the Constitutional Court for leave to appeal a recent Supreme Court of Appeal (SCA) judgment, specifically regarding his suspension.

The SCA upheld a Western Cape High Court order by Judge Ashton Schippers that he be suspended for 60 days while a disciplinary hearing into his alleged malfeasance was conducted. The high court is currently hearing an application by the Democratic Alliance to have Motsoeneng's appointment set aside.

Motsoeneng indicated in the affidavit that the SABC on Monday delivered a charge sheet to him and a notice to attend a disciplinary hearing on October 30.

SABC spokesperson Kaizer Kganyago said yesterday that they would not divulge the charges as the matter was between "employer and employee".

Motsoeneng stated under oath that the relief granted by Schippers went beyond the remedial action urged by Public Protector Thuli Madonsela, in her report into governance at the SABC. Madonsela found he lied about having a matric certificate, and that his appointment as acting COO and his one-year salary hike from R1,5 million to R2,4 million were irregular.

"While I have the utmost respect for the office of the public protector and the position it occupies in our constitutional democracy, I nevertheless with respect, dispute many of the findings contained in the report," Motsoeneng stated.

He believed the SCA had extended its reach and effectively found him guilty at the least of misrepresenting his qualifications to the SABC in 1995, "ignoring clear evidence to the contrary". — News24.

Muthambi 'was convinced of Motsoeneng's expertise'

CAPE TOWN — Communications Minister Faith Muthambi applied her mind when she decided to appoint Hlaudi Motsoeneng as the chief operating officer of the SABC, her lawyer told the Western Cape High Court yesterday.

The court was hearing an application by the Democratic Alliance to have his appointment set aside.

Lawyer Vincent Maleka said Muthambi had been concerned by the Public Protector Thuli Madonsela's finding that Motsoeneng lied about having a matric certificate. Maleka said the minister looked at the transcript of the interview between Madonsela and Motsoeneng and was satisfied that he did not lie to

the SABC about the qualification. She believed that he was competent and had the necessary expertise to be appointed.

"The SCA [Supreme Court of Appeal] has found that on undisputed facts, the minister applied her mind," Maleka said.

Judge Dennis Davis said that may be so, but he was still trying to find in the court papers where Muthambi had stated what she had done about the concerns raised in the public protector's report into governance at the SABC, "When Governance and Ethics Fail".

The judge said his job was to determine whether Muthambi had acted lawfully and had been a rational decision maker.

Govt preparing to address Marikana claimants

JOHANNESBURG — The government is still preparing for the alternative dispute resolution process planned to address the consequences of the Marikana shooting, the presidency said yesterday.

"The government is aware of the anxiety of the families and will engage with the legal representatives of claimants in due course to take this process forward," said spokesperson Bongani Majola in a statement.

President Jacob Zuma announced that the government is looking at starting the process to expedite all claims arising from

the Marikana massacre.

He said a judge, assisted by experts, will lead the process.

At the time, the presidency said the government was still considering the recommendations made by the Farlam Commission of Inquiry, which investigated the deaths of 44 people — 34 of whom were killed by police — during strike-related violence at Marikana in 2012.

The final report was handed to Zuma on March 31, who then released it to the public on June 25.

Du Toit puts Wartburg on SA's cycling map

IN 2015, Wartburg matricular Frankie du Toit blazed a trail across South African cycling, winning national mountain bike titles in cross country and marathon, and national road titles in the individual time trial and road race.

She is now headed into the next phase of her career after turning professional and joining the Kargo Pro MTB Team.

Although her focus is on cross country competition, Du Toit will still compete in some road competitions and this past weekend that meant contesting the KwaZulu-Natal Road Championships.

It was an excellent outing for Kargo, South Africa's first ever UCI Trade Team, with Du Toit finishing second in the elite women's race behind Heidi Dalton, Brendon Davids winning the men's title, and Alan Hatherley and Marco Joubert finishing one-two in the men's under-23 division.

Describing the change from focusing on school books to becoming a full-time professional, Du Toit said in an interview with *The Witness*: "It has been amazing. Obviously it is a big change. We're focusing on training, but we can wake up when we want to," she laughed.

"It is not like when you're at school when cycling was a last-minute thing that you did at the end of the day.

"Now your whole day is planned around when you are going to train and what the best time is to train. It has been amazing. I am loving the independence. I am also coming to realise that the big wide world can be quite mean."

Du Toit had planned on attending university, but when Kargo approached her to race for them, she knew she had to accept the opportunity. Nonetheless, she will be studying on the side.

"Through an online academy based in the UK, I am doing a few courses, like exercise physiology, sports nutrition and sports psychology.

"When I found it was so chuffed because I hadn't been able to find anywhere else where I could do short courses on those subjects," she explained.

Pietermaritzburg now serves as home for Du Toit and the city's extensive links to cycling make it an ideal base for a professional cyclist.

"We have Cascades right here. We have Karkloof just a few minutes the other way, and there is also Hilton and Howick, and the roads are fairly safe to ride on," the former Wartburg Kirchdorf deputy head girl said.

While she has turned professional, Du Toit still remains on the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Sport and Recreation's Elite Athlete Development Programme (EADP) and continues to work with the Department's Prime Human Performance Institute.

Although Prime is based in Durban, living in Pietermaritzburg is not a problem, Du Toit said: "Prime has a satellite business that we can go to here in Pietermaritzburg and Prime pays for their services. It is very convenient."

Coming up for the multiple South African champion is the opening round of the Stihl 2016 XCO Cup Series in Mankele, Mpumalanga on January 30, with the SA National Road, Time Trial and Para-cycling Championships set to follow from February 10-14.

Du Toit will no doubt take some confidence from the fact that the road part of the event will take place around Wartburg and Noodsberg, areas that she knows very well. After all, competing on the same courses last year, she won the African Continental Championships junior individual time trial and was third in the road race.

Working toward a stress-free co-existence with snakes. JUST A QUIET DAY IN THE AFRICAN BUSH.

I'm sitting on the pool-deck of a posh but somewhat incongruous mansion situated in an upmarket 'Bush Camp' that's been incorporated into the southern boundary of the Kruger Park, on the banks of the Crocodile River. I was privileged to have been invited to join the R&F who can enjoy this sort of lifestyle, but a number of things have struck me whilst I've been here.

I know it's holiday time, but the early morning queues to get into the main park remind me of rush hour in Durban. Under the circumstances and despite the rudeness and impatience of some of the "me first!" visitors, the staff at the entry points remained courteous and helpful - I wouldn't last 5 minutes in their jobs! Once across the threshold, the drive turns into something akin to a trip through a super-heated Jurassic Park. Every time you slow down or stop to look at something, you get surrounded by gawkers, festooned with freshly sun-baked long-lens cameras, all jostling for best viewing positions whilst simultaneously yelling at you, "what you looking at?" Makes you feel like a magnet in a bag of nails! The animals generally seem to be tolerant of this human circus that visits their home every day, and I'm sure that a well-planned trip, away from

the madding crowd, could be very rewarding for those who're genuinely interested in the bush, rather than for those who're there to tick the box.

As could be expected, the temperatures quickly rose and stayed up in the early forties, making the Banting Diet for rapid weight loss look amateurish by example, especially if you're in an open game-viewing vehicle, but the animals seem to adapt with ease - sliding down into cool holes or resting under tree canopies. Those who drive around the park at midday, whilst consuming litres of bottled warm water and feverishly casting about for the Big 5, are the ones who come back and tell you they saw nothing.

Coming as I had, from the Camperdown/Cato 'snake park' where I've lived for over 8 years, I was immediately struck by the dearth of snakes out in the open. I thought this was odd, until the penny dropped. If the ambient temperature at 4.30 in the morning is about 32 degrees C, and rising to 40 plus in the late afternoon, surely there'd be no need to bask? Ordinarily, if they're intending to hunt or move around, reptiles would heat up by sun-basking or lying on warm roads or rocks, to get their temperatures up to the required levels to enable them to go hunting and to digest their subsequent meals, but here in this environment, they're there already. It makes sense then, that in the northerly climes, the best time to see snakes out in the open, might actually be in the winter months when, with the colder morning and evening temperatures, there would certainly be a need to mechanically raise the body temperature.

As could be expected, the temperatures quickly rose and stayed up in the early forties, making the Banting Diet for rapid weight loss look amateurish by example, especially if you're in an open game-viewing vehicle, but the animals seem to adapt with ease - sliding down into cool holes or resting under tree canopies. Those who drive around the park at midday, whilst consuming litres of bottled warm water and feverishly casting about for the Big 5, are the ones who come back and tell you they saw nothing.

In this application Rhino Oil and Gas has only applied for approval to undertake early-phase exploration for oil and gas which might be located within suitable geological strata. The purpose of the work would be solely to determine the presence of any possible petroleum resource which could be investigated further. The initial 3-year exploration work programme will be restricted to non-invasive techniques, as well as seismic surveys and the drilling of less than 10 core boreholes. No hydraulic fracturing (fracking) is proposed in the 3-year programme. Rhino will require access to only a few farms for exploration activities and will agree terms with those land owners. I have watched in morbid fascination over the last few years as investors in shares like Anglo's, Kumba, Sasol and Anglo Platinum have been decimated.

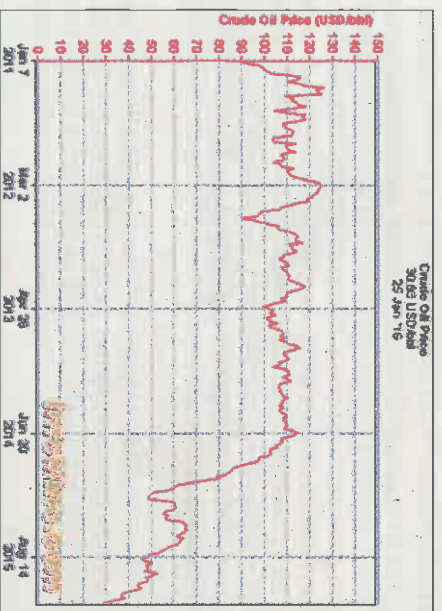
If you are walking down a railway track and you see a train speeding towards you, what do you do? Well you simply step to the side. And do you pat yourself on the back and say: "What a clever chap"? Of course not. Doing that is not even mildly intelligent.

But many investors in Anglo's for example, have held this share on the portfolios from circa @ R600 to where it is now trading at +-R60. What is their problem? Are they mesmerized? Is it simply because they are advised that you should never sell Anglo's.

For years now I have warned that the world is in a deflationary spiral and going ex-growth. Commodity shares are not the place to be in this environment.

Commodity shares rise and fall in pretty predictable and regular fashion. Contract this with investment in growth stocks. These are not affected by the cyclical trend in commodity prices.

One possible reason why investors lose so heavily on their commodity investments

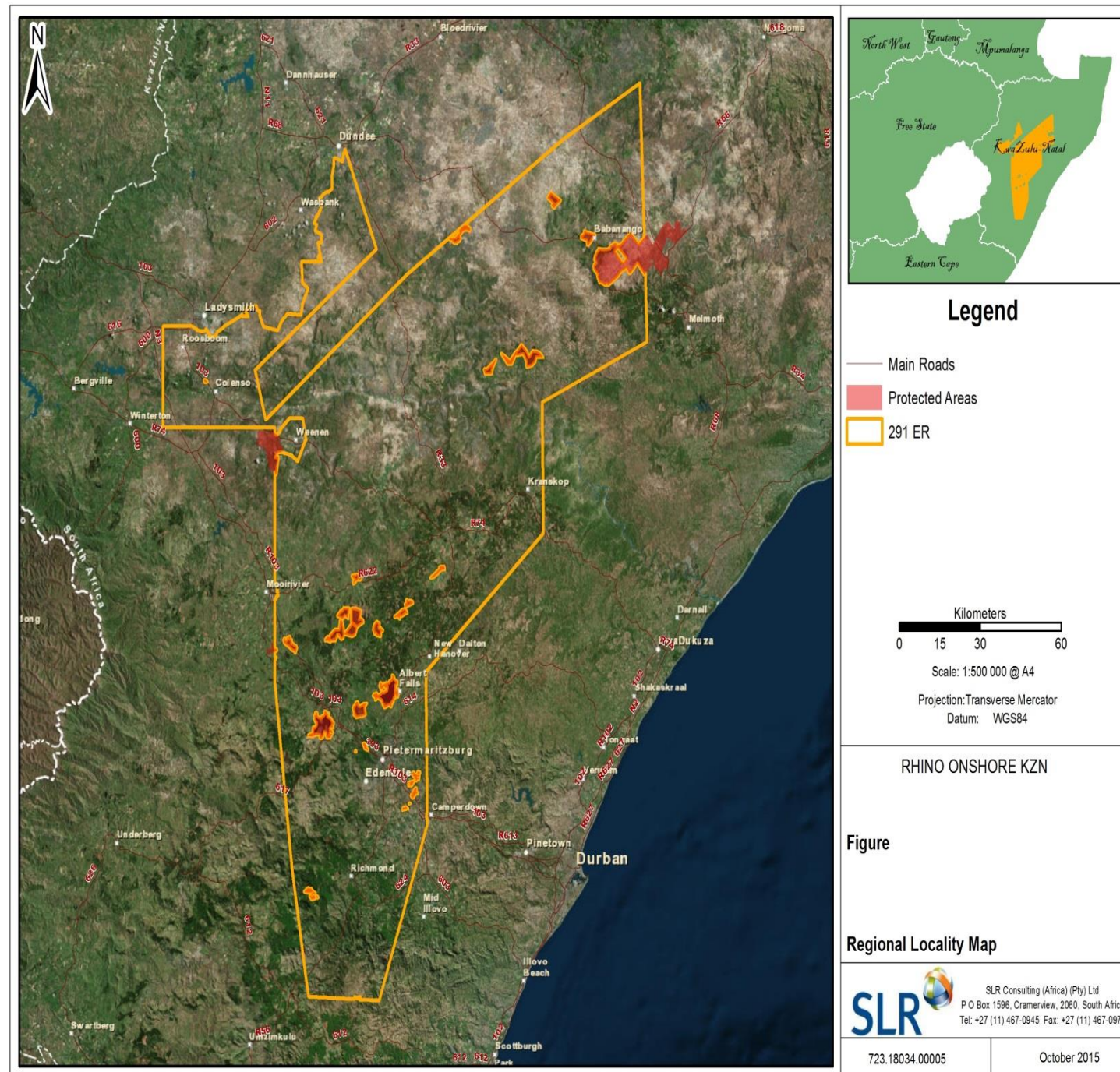

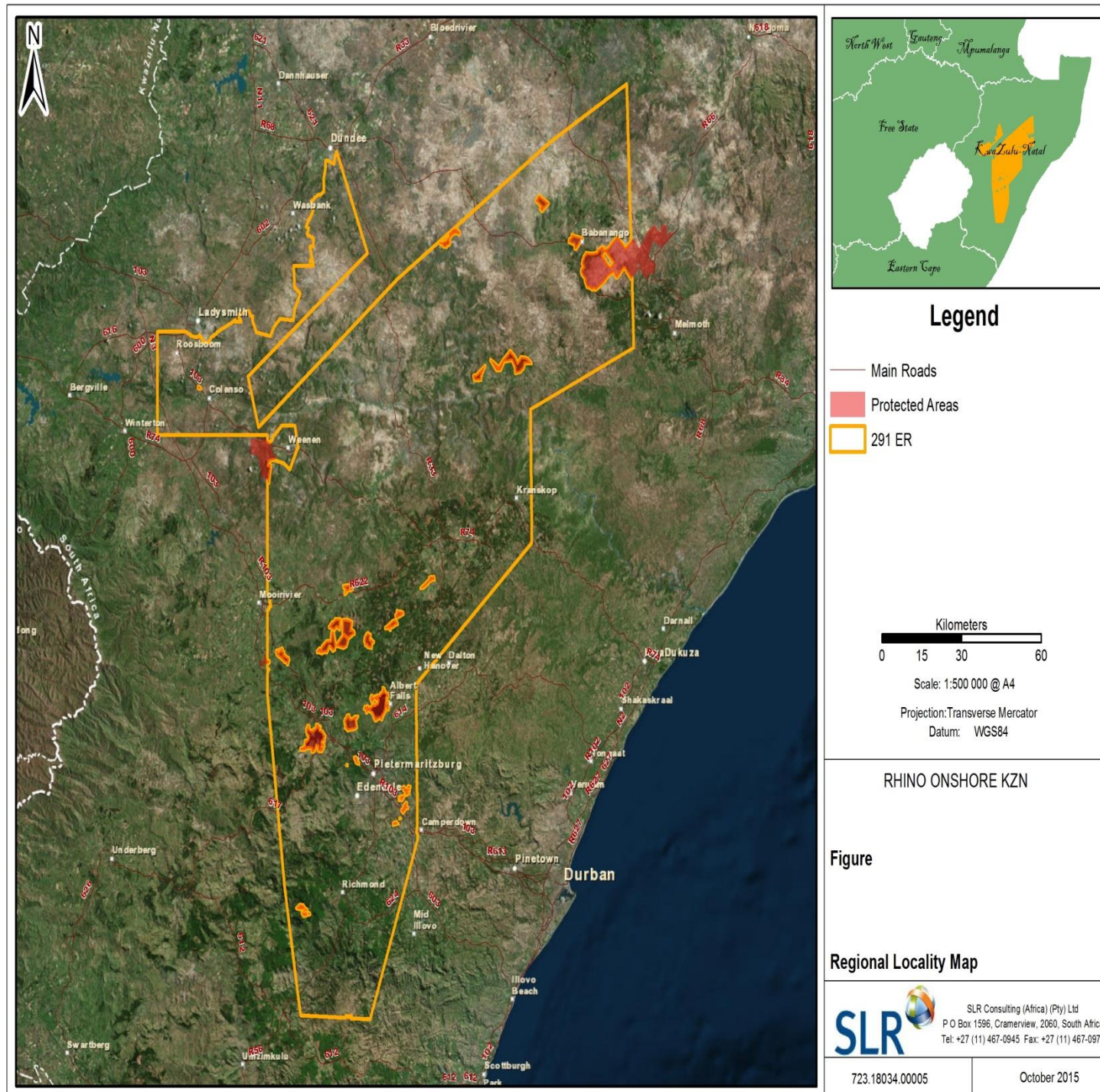
