Project Description and Location

The proposed building waste storage, handling and distribution facility (study site) is located on Portion 31 of the farm Nietgedacht 535 JQ, within Ward 96 of the City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality.


The site is situated adjacent to the N14 highway between Roodepoort and Centurion and the provincial road 1027 is located immediately south of the site.

The competent authority for this integrated authorisation is the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD) responsible for matters associated with the integrated environmental authorisation and waste licence and the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) is responsible for the use, allocation and protection of water resources.

Sand Shifters are proposing the development of the waste handling and storage facility for functions associated with the movement, treatment, recycling and processing of the rubble and construction waste to recyclable materials and/or saleable products.

National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998)

The following listed activities are triggered in terms of the EIA Regulations, 2014:

Listing Notice 1: GN R 983 of 4 December include:

1(27): The clearance of an area of 1 ha or more, but less than 20 ha of indigenous vegetation.

National Environmental Management: Waste Act (NEM:WA), 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008).

List of Waste Management Activities: GN R 921 of 29 November include:

- **3(2):** The storage, shredding, grinding, crushing, screening or bailing of general waste at a facility that has an operational area in excess of 1000m².
- **4(3)**: The recovery of waste including the refining, utilization, or co-processing of the waste at a facility that processes in excess of 100 tons of general waste per day or in excess of 1 ton of hazardous waste per day, excluding recovery that takes place as an integral part of an internal manufacturing process within the same premises.
- **4(6):** The treatment of general waste in excess of 100 ton per day calculated as a monthly average; using any form of treatment.
- **4(9):** The disposal of inert waste to land in excess of 25000 tons, excluding the disposal of such waste for the purposes of levelling and building which has been authorized by or under other legislation.
- 4(10): The construction of a facility for a waste management activity listed in Category B of this schedule.

National Water Act, 1998 (NWA), 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998)

Section 21 water uses of the NWAinclude:

21(c): Impeding or diverting the flow of water in a watercourse; and

21(i): Altering the beds, banks and characteristics of water in watercourse.

Be an Integral Part of the Environmental Impact Assessment Process

Public involvement is an essential part of any environmental assessment process. All comments will be captured, considered and incorporated into the relevant impact assessment reports. As a registered Interested and Affected Parties (I&AP), you will receive updates at the various phases of the project process.

How to Register and get involved?

Parties wishing to register as I&APs, who wish to participate by contributing comments, or require additional information, should register and/or submit their contact details and correspondence in writing to Prism EMS.

Public Participation Process

The key objective of Public Participation is to assist stakeholders to identify issues of concern and suggestions for enhanced benefits, and to comment at various phases of the application process. The Public Participation Process is an integral part of the impact assessment and is undertaken in the following systematic approach:

- Step 1: Identify and notify potential I&APs of the proposed development, through newspaper advertisements, written notices, and/or BIDs to obtain registered I&APs.
- Step 2: Provide I&APs with a 30 day comment period to review documents (impact assessment reports, specialist studies and EMP) and submit written comment on these.
- Step 3: Notify the registered I&APs of the outcome of the Environmental Authorisation (Record of Decision) and including the Water Use Licence.
