# Straat kry lewe met kleurvolle projek

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'n Treffende verfprojek wat vroeër vanjaar in Bloemfontein begin is, het Vrydag (30/07) nog 'n lagie gekry.

Wilhelm van Zyl van die onderneming Iqvia sê hy is mal oor kuns en wou graag iets aanpak waarmee hy en sy kollegas 'n verskil in Bloemfontein kon maak.

Hy het eendag die kunstenaar Marius Jansen van Vuuren raakgehoop, wat hom vertel het van die projek waaraan hy en straatkunste-

naar Junior Mentz 'n rukkie vantevore gewerk het.

Die twee het muurkuns geskep op die perseel waar Lerato Mbhele die afgelope tyd sy wegneemetstalletjie Plated by the Side Walk op die hoek van Kellnerstraat en Eerstelaan in Westdene bedryf.

Dié kunswerk was deel van 'n nasionale kunsprojek. Mentz sê die Vrystaat het uitgeblyk in die projek, wat van Maart tot Mei geduur het, met 21 kunswerke wat oor die provinsie heen geskep is.

Iqvia het besluit om betrokke te raak en Mentz het spesiaal hier-

voor nog twee kunswerke geskep, wat Vrydag onder sy kuratorkap weerskante van die oorspronklike kunswerk aangebring is.

Charmaine Thompson, 'n direkteur by Iqvia, sê sowat 70 van dié onderneming se personeel het deur die loop van Vrydag 'n draai kom maak en saam geveerf.

"Ons werk meestal nog van die huis af en sien ons kollegas net op spesiale geleenthede soos hierdie," sê sy.

Thompson sê dit is lekker om by so 'n projek betrokke te raak. Iqvia het die verf gekoop en personeel

en van hul kinders het saam geveerf.

Van Zyl is baie opgewonde oor die projek.

"Dit was vir ons lekker om deel te neem aan so 'n mooimaak-projek. Mense glo nog in Bloemfontein en wil graag 'n bydrae maak," meen hy.

Die oorspronklike kunswerk, wat onder kuratorkap van Jansen van Vuuren en Mentz geskep is, bestaan uit 'n kleurvolle toneel met twee luiperds weerskante van 'n vrou in 'n groen rok wat op 'n stoel sit.

Mentz sê met die muurkuns wil hulle 'n dieretuin van kultuur uitbeeld.

"Ons wou iets *delightful* skep. Die nuwe werke is 'n sebra aan een kant en 'n nguni-bees aan die ander kant. Altime is in swart en wit geskilder en trek jou oog na die veelkleurige kunswerk in die middel."

Mbhele is verheug oor die kuns wat by sy stalletjie geskep is. Hy sê benewens die wegneemkos wat weerskade hier beskikbaar is, gaan daar binnekort ook 'n karwas-onderneming op die perseel wees.

Notice is hereby given of the pre-application public participation process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, No. 107 of 1998 (NEMA) and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (2014), as well as the National Water Act, No. 36 of 1998 (NWA). EnviroAfrica CC has been appointed by Keren Renewable Energy (Pty) Ltd, to undertake the EIA application process for the above proposed project. As part of the application for an environmental authorisation, a basic assessment report (BAR) is required since the proposed development falls within renewable energy development zone 5.

#### Project Location and Description:

The proposed development is primarily a linear development but includes the construction of two substations located at each end of the grid connection line i.e. on Visserspan Farm no. 40 to be located at approximately 28°36'37.82"S, 25°44'50.21"E (estimated central point) a combined switching station and high voltage (HV) substation will serve as the 'collection' point for electricity evacuated from the Visserspan Solar PV plants. From this single facility, electricity will be fed via overhead power lines to the east, turning north-east to trace the northern boundary of Mooihoek Farm No. 1547 and Vasteveld Farm No. 1548 before turning north-east and running along the southern boundary of Kinderdam Farm No. 1685 connecting to the Kinderdam main transmission substation (MTS) to be located at 28°37'0.82"S, 25°48'14.76"E (estimated central point). From the Kinderdam MTS, connection will be to the existing Eskom Perseus/Theseus 400kV powerline. Estimated total length of the grid connection line is approximately 6km and will be either via 132kV steel monopole or 400kV pylon overhead power lines. As a precautionary approach, the servitude for a 400kV powerline will be used to determine potential development footprint (55m width). Existing roads will be used (farm access and fence maintenance roads) and clearance of vegetation/land will only occur for substation and pylon/monopole footprints (not the entire servitude corridor).

#### Description of Alternatives:

Due to proximity to the Eskom Perseus substation, there is a possible alternative route for grid connection directly to the south of Visserspan Farm which will be investigated in the Draft Basic Assessment Report (DBAR). The DBAR will include specialist reports and will undergo a further round of public participation.
