ESTABLISHMENT OF A WIND ENERGY FACILITY SITUATED ON THE EASTERN PLATEAU (SOUTH) NEAR DE AAR, NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCE: PART 1 APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION: AVAILABILITY OF THE DRAFT AMENDMENT MOTIVATION REPORT FOR COMMENT

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

The purpose of this letter is to inform Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs), including relevant State Departments and Organs of State, that Mulilo De Aar 2 South (Pty) Ltd, i.e. the holder of the Environmental Authorisation (EA) for *the Wind Energy Facility (WEF) situated on the Eastern Plateau (South) near De Aar*, in the *Northern Cape Province* (also referred to as the De Aar 2 South WEF), has submitted an Application for Amendment of the Environmental Authorisation to the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) in terms of Part 1 of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, as amended. The DFFE responded to the Applicant on 14 November 2022, requesting additional information in terms of Regulation 30(1)(a) of the EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended. A draft Amendment Motivation Report containing the requested information has been compiled (including specialist inputs), and is being made available for public participation, as requested by DFFE.

This letter serves to notify Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) that the Draft Amendment Motivation Report is being made available to I&APs for a 30 day comment period excluding the period 15 December – 5 January¹, i.e. **2 December 2022 – 23 January 2023**.

1. Background

The project was granted an Environmental Authorisation (EA) from the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) (now known as the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment (DFFE)) on 1 March 2013, in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (2010), as amended. Furthermore, on 24 July 2014, a further EA (DENC Reference No. NC/BA/14/PIX/EMT/DEA5/2014) for the project was granted by the Northern Cape Department of Environment and Nature Conservation (DENC) for activities that had not been

applied for in the original Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for the project.

The WEF would be located on the following properties: Slingers Hoek (Farm No. 2 Remainder of Portion 2 and Remainder); Slingers Hoek (Farm No. 2 Portion 4); Knapdaar (Farm No. 8 Portion 1); Maatjes Fountain (Farm No. 1 Portion 5); Vendussie Kuil (Farm No. 165 Remainder of Portion 2, and Portion 7); Vendussie Kuil (Farm No. 165 Portion 11 and Remainder), and Vendussie Kuil (Farm No. 165 Portion 7) within the Emthanjeni Local Municipality and Renosterberg Local Municipality, approximately 20km east of De Aar, in the Northern Cape Province.

The original EA for the project (dated 1 March 2013) authorised the construction of approximately 103 wind turbines, and associated infrastructure, with an overall potential generation capacity of 155 – 258 MW, and associated infrastructure. A Part 2 EA amendment process was undertaken in 2015, which included a reduction in the number of turbines at the WEF (i.e. reduced from 103 turbines to a maximum of 61 turbines) and overall generation capacity of 140MW, as well as amendments to the turbine specifications.

The Applicant is now applying to DFFE for an Amendment to the EA, in terms of Part 1 of Chapter 5 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended, including:

- Amendment of Condition 7 of the EA, as amended, i.e. to extend the validity period of the EA;
- Amendments to the project description in the EA;
- The inclusion of an erroneously omitted Listed Activity into the EA (i.e. request for correction in terms of NEMA Section 47A(1)(b) and EIA Regulation (27(4)); and
- Amendment to the property description in the EA, to include an erroneously omitted property into the property description (i.e. request for correction in terms of NEMA Section 47A(1)(b) and EIA Regulation (27(4)).

Holland & Associates Environmental Consultants has been appointed by the Applicant to undertake the requisite Application for Amendment of the EA, in accordance with the NEMA EIA Regulations (2014), as amended.

2. Proposed amendments to the Environmental Authorisation

An outline of the proposed amendments is provided below:

1. Proposed extension of the EA validity period of the EA by 2 years, i.e. from the current expiry date of 01 March 2023, to 01 March 2025.
2. Proposed amendments to the project description in the EA:
 - 2.1 Reducing the number of turbines from the authorised “25 – 61” to “up to 26”.
 - 2.2 Internal roads (widths):
 - New roads: 6m width (i.e. change from the authorised 4m wide roads to 6m wide roads);
 - Upgrading sections of existing roads: 6m width (i.e. upgrading from 4m width to 6m width).
 - 2.3 Foundations: Change from the authorised “*18.4m in diameter that narrows up to 10.6m at the surface (the visible portion) with a depth of 3.5 once completed*”, to foundations up to maximum 24m diameter at lowest point and up to 12m diameter at surface.
 - 2.4 Hardstands: Change from the authorised “*A permanent hard standing made of compacted gravel and approximately 50 m x 40 m would be constructed adjacent to each turbine location for the crane*”, to hardstands with approximate footprint up to 0.47 ha per WTG adjacent to and surrounding each WTG.
 - 2.5 Co-ordinates of IPP Substation Control and O&M building: Amendment to the co-ordinates of the substation in the EA are proposed, and removal of references in EA to multiple substations (as only one substation is authorised).
 - 2.6 Temporary Laydown Areas: No changes to the development footprint are proposed, but

further detail to be included in the EA (i.e. WTG component laydown, concrete batching plant, office yard).

- 2.7 Internal reticulation: Change from the authorised “22 kV” to 33 kV.
- 2.8 Removing the specified MW generation capacity per turbine (currently stipulated as “2.3MW – 6.0MW”) to facilitate selection of the optimum wind turbine available at design phase.
- 2.9 Inclusion of the words “up to” in front of the currently authorised turbine specifications for hub height and rotor diameter.

3. Proposed inclusion of an erroneously omitted Listed Activity (Activity 15 of GN R. 545 (Listing Notice 2) into the EA (i.e. request for correction in terms of NEMA Section 47A(1)(b) and EIA Regulation (27(4)):

- The Applicant requests the inclusion of one 2010 EIA Regulations listed activity, i.e. Activity 15 of GN R. 545 (Listing Notice 2), into the EA, which was assessed in the EIA process for the project, however was erroneously omitted from the Application Form and EIA Report.

4. Amendment to the property description in the EA, to include an erroneously omitted property into the property description (i.e. request for correction in terms of NEMA Section 47A(1)(b) and EIA Regulation (27(4))

- Addition of Portion 7 of Farm Vendussie Kuil No. 165 into the EA (given that a section of a proposed road would cross the corner of Portion 7 of Farm No. 165, which is currently not included in the EA, but was included in the combined EIA process and reporting for the De Aar 2 South WEF and De Aar 2 North WEF projects).

4. Public Participation Process (Opportunity to Comment)

Notice is hereby given of the commencement of the public participation process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (2014), as amended.

Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) are invited to register as I&APs and to provide comment on the draft Amendment Motivation Report for the abovementioned project (which includes the updated Application Form for Amendment of the EA), during a **30 day I&AP comment period (excluding the period 15 December – 5 January)², i.e. 2 December 2022 – 23 January 2023.**

Die doel van hierdie brief is om Belanghebbende en Geaffekteerde Partye (B&GPe), insluitend relevante Staatsdepartemente en Staatsorgane, in kennis te stel dat Mulilo De Aar 2 Suid (Edms) Bpk, dit wil sê die houer van die Omgewingsmagtiging (OM) vir die Windenergie Fasiliteit (WEF) geleë op die Oostelike Plato (Suid) naby De Aar, in die Noord-Kaap Provinsie (ook na verwys as die De Aar 2 Suid-WEF), het 'n Aansoek om Wysiging van die Omgewingsmagtiging by die Departement van Bosbou ingedien, Visserye en die Omgewing (DFFE) ingevolge Deel 1 van Hoofstuk 5 van die Omgewingsimpakbepaling (OIB) Regulasies, 2014, soos gewysig. Die DFFE het op 14 November 2022 aan die Aansoeker geantwoord en bykomende inligting versoek ingevolge Regulasie 30(1)(a) van die OIB-regulasies, 2014 soos gewysig. 'n Konsep Wysigingsmotiveringsverslag wat die gevraagde inligting bevat, is saamgestel (insluitend spesialisinsette), en word beskikbaar gestel vir publieke deelname, soos deur DFFE versoek.

Hierdie brief dien om Belanghebbende en Geaffekteerde Partye (B&GPe) in kennis te stel dat die Konsepwysigingsmotiveringsverslag aan B&GPe beskikbaar gestel word vir 'n 30 dae kommentaarperiode (uitgesluit die tydperk 15 Desember – 5 Januarie), d.w.s. 2 Desember 2022 – 23 January 2023.

1. Agtergrond

Die projek het 'n Omgewingsmagtiging (OM) van die Departement van Omgewingsake (DEA) (nou bekend as die Departement van Bosbou, Visserye en Omgewing (DFFE)) op 1 Maart 2013, ingevolge die Wet op Nasionale Omgewingsbestuur (NEMA) Omgewingsimpakstudieregulasies (2010), soos gewysig. Verder, op 24 Julie 2014, is 'n verdere OM (DENC Verwysings No. NC/BA/14/PIX/EMT/DEA5/2014) vir die projek deur die Noord-Kaapse Departement van Omgewing en Natuurbewaring (DENC) toegestaan vir aktiwiteite wat nie in die oorspronklike Omgewingsimpakstudie (OIB) vir die projek aansoek gedoen is nie.

Die WEF sal op die volgende eiendomme geleë wees: Slingers Hoek (Plaas No. 2 Restant van Gedeelte 2 en Restant); Slingers Hoek (Plaas No. 2 Gedeelte 4); Knapdaar (Plaas No. 8 Gedeelte 1); Maatjes Fountain (Plaas No. 1 Gedeelte 5); Vendussie Kuil (Plaas No. 165 Restant van Gedeelte 2, en Gedeelte 7); Vendussie Kuil (Plaas No. 165 Gedeelte 11 en Restant), en Vendussie Kuil (Plaas No. 165 Gedeelte 7) binne die Emthanjeni Plaaslike Munisipaliteit en Renosterberg Plaaslike Munisipaliteit, ongeveer 20km oos van De Aar, in die Noord-Kaap Provinsie.

Die oorspronklike OM vir die projek (gedateer 1 Maart 2013) het die konstruksie van ongeveer 103 windturbines, en gepaardgaande infrastruktuur, met 'n algehele potensiële opwekkingskapasiteit van 155 – 258 MW, en gepaardgaande infrastruktuur gemagtig. 'n Deel 2 OM-wysigingsproses is in 2015 onderneem, wat 'n vermindering in die aantal turbines by die WEF ingesluit het (d.w.s. verminder van 103 turbines tot 'n maksimum van 61 turbines) en algehele opwekkingskapasiteit van 140MW, sowel as wysigings aan die turbine spesifikasies.

Die Aansoeker doen nou aansoek by DFFE vir 'n Wysiging aan die OM, ingevolge Deel 1 van Hoofstuk 5 van die NEMA OIB-regulasies, 2014, soos gewysig, insluitend:

- Wysiging van Voorwaarde 7 van die OM, soos gewysig, dit wil sê om die geldigheidstydperk van die OM te verleng;
- Wysigings aan die projekbeskrywing in die OM;
- Die insluiting van 'n verkeerdelik weggelaat Gelyste Aktiwiteit in die OM (d.w.s. versoek vir regstelling ingevolge NEMA Artikel 47A(1)(b) en OIB-regulasie (27(4))); en
- Wysiging aan die eiendomsbeskrywing in die OM, om 'n foutiewelik weggelaat eiendom by die eiendomsbeskrywing in te sluit (d.w.s. versoek vir regstelling ingevolge NEMA Artikel 47A(1)(b) en OIB-regulasie (27(4))).

2. Voorgestelde wysigings aan die Omgewingsmagtiging

1. Voorgestelde verlenging van die OM -geldigheidstydperk van die OM met 2 jaar, dit wil sê vanaf die huidige vervaldatum van 01 Maart 2023, tot 01 Maart 2025.
2. Voorgestelde wysigings aan die projekbeskrywing in die OM:
 - 2.1 Vermindering van die aantal turbines van die gemagtigde “25 – 61” tot “tot 26”.
 - 2.2 Interne paaie (wydtes):
Nuwe paaie: 6m wydte (d.w.s. verander van die gemagtigde 4m breë paaie na 6m breë paaie);
Opgradering van dele van bestaande paaie: 6m breedte (d.w.s. opgradering van 4m breedte na 6m breedte).
 - 2.3 Fondasies: Verander van die gemagtigde "18.4m in deursnee wat vernou tot 10.6m op die oppervlak (die sigbare gedeelte) met 'n diepte van 3.5 sodra dit voltooi is", na fondamente tot maksimum 24m deursnee by die laagste punt en tot 12m deursnee aan die oppervlak.
 - 2.4 Harde staanplekke: Verander van die gemagtigde "'n Permanente harde stand gemaak van gekompakteerde gruis en ongeveer 50 m x 40 m sal langs elke turbineplek vir die hyskraan gebou word", na harde staanplekke met benaderde voetspoor tot 0.47 ha per WTG langs en omringend elke WTG.
 - 2.5 Koördinate van IPP-substasiebeheer en O&M-bou: Wysiging aan die koördinate van die substasie in die OM word voorgestel, en die verwydering van verwysings in OM na veelvuldige substasies (aangesien slegs een substasie gemagtig is).

- 2.6 Tydelike neerleggingsgebiede: Geen veranderinge aan die ontwikkelingsvoetspoor word voorgestel nie, maar verdere besonderhede moet in die OM ingesluit word (d.w.s. WTG-komponent-uitleg, betonmengselaanleg, kantoorwerf).
- 2.7 Interne retikulاسie: Verander van die gemagtigde "22 kV" na 33 kV.
