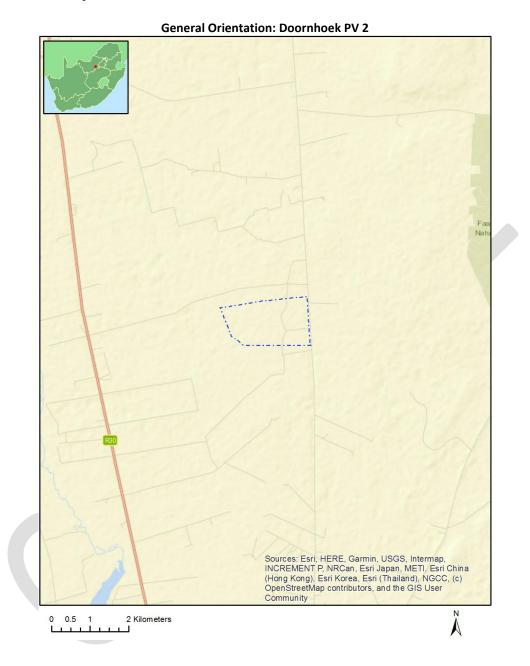

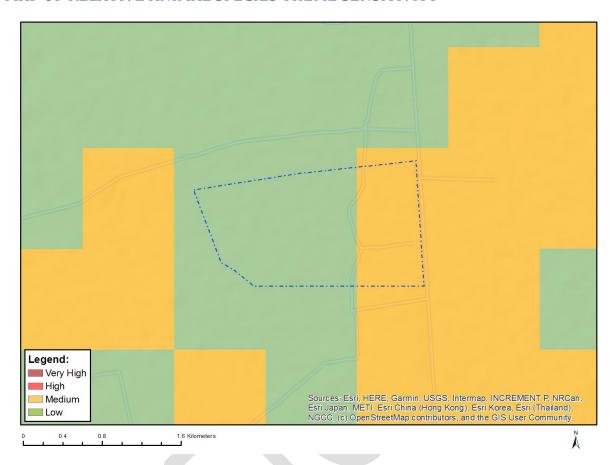
MAP OF RELATIVE AGRICULTURE THEME SENSITIVITY

MAP OF RELATIVE ANIMAL SPECIES THEME SENSITIVITY

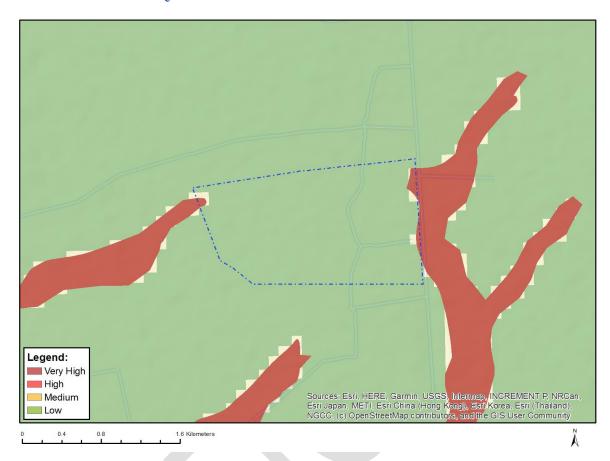

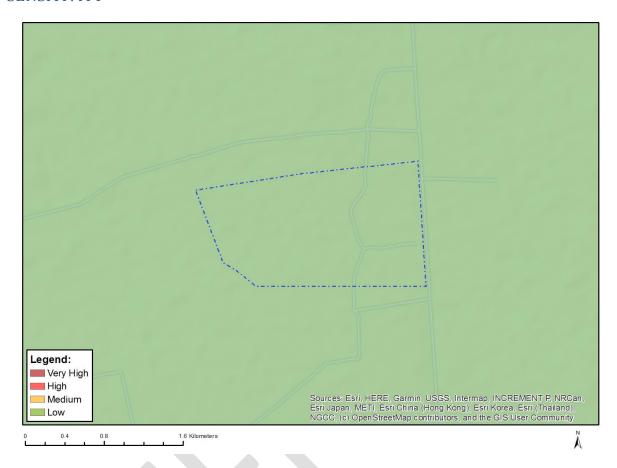
MAP OF RELATIVE AQUATIC BIODIVERSITY THEME SENSITIVITY

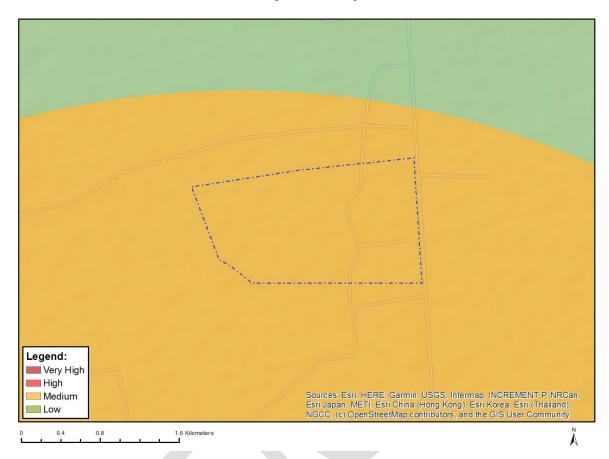
MAP OF RELATIVE AVIAN THEME SENSITIVITY

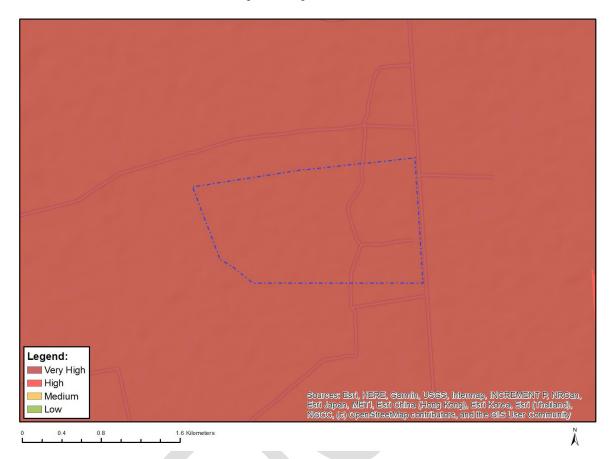
MAP OF RELATIVE DEFENCE THEME SENSITIVITY

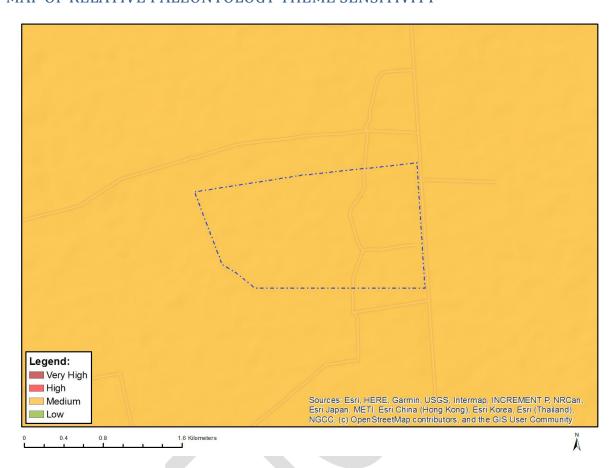
MAP OF RELATIVE LANDSCAPE (SOLAR) THEME SENSITIVITY

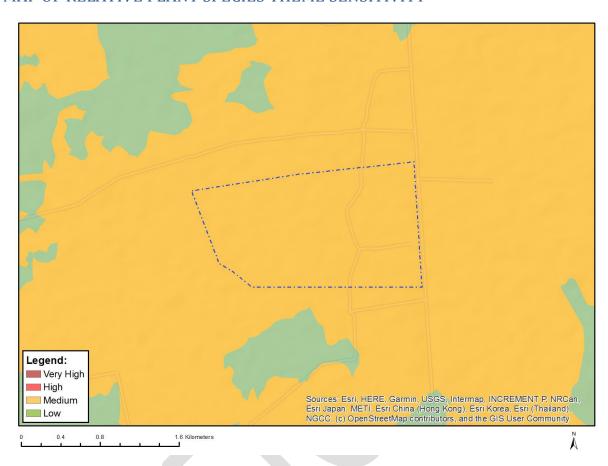
MAP OF RELATIVE PALEONTOLOGY THEME SENSITIVITY

MAP OF RELATIVE PLANT SPECIES THEME SENSITIVITY

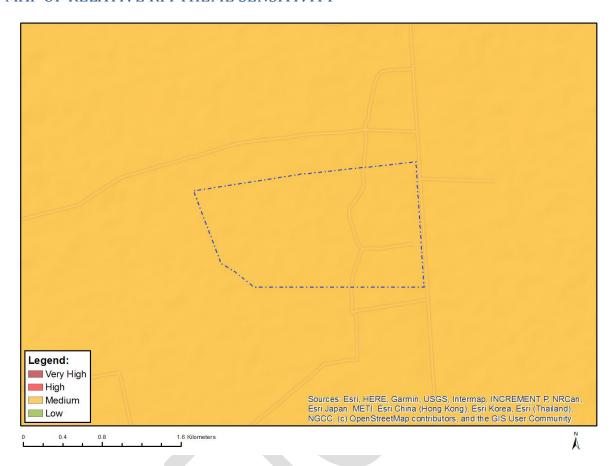
