There are other licenses/permits that may be required, which will be acquired in parallel to the

Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs and a Water Use License from the Department of Human Settlements, Water and Sanitation.

On behalf of Liquid Telecom, ACER will fulfil the role and responsibilities of Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to undertake the Environmental Impact Assessment and the associated public participation process, and to submit the required application and supporting documentation to DEFF and other relevant authorities for consideration and

environmental authorisation process, e.g. a Sea Shore Lease Permit from the KwaZulu-Natal
