Location of the Project

The proposed 2AFRICA (West) Cable System will make landfall at a northern section of Yzerfontein Main Beach and the cable will terminate at the existing West Africa Cable System (WACS) Cable Landing Station located outside of Yzerfontein and operated by Telkom SOC Limited.

In terms of the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) the proposed development of the 2AFRICA (West) Cable System landing at Yzerfontein potentially triggers several listed activities and requires environmental authorisation via the undertaking of an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA).
