# 1. Welcome and apologies

- Cllr Dludla opened the meeting and welcomed all in attendance
- Cllr Ntombela opened the meeting with prayer.

To obtain comments of meeting attendees and plan for community notification about the project

## 4. Discussions

- 4.1. Zanele Mthembu presented the proposed project scope and shared aerial images showing the proposed pipeline route and location of the proposed reservoir. She added that the project was at a feasibility stage and has a history of stoppages, the pipe is proposed to run from Kwahlokohloko to Mpehlela and then to K4. Stated that there would be different project team members with various roles, environmental and social (i.e. population counts and skills audits)
- 4.2. Based on the project location discussions, it was agreed that the project will not impact on Ward 14 which falls under the Mzimela Tribal Authority but will impact on all other wards
- 4.3. Cllr Ngema raised a concern about how the K4 was completed but is not working and it's possible that the condition of the current pipe is poor
- 4.4. Cllr T. Mdlalose mentioned the issue of a reservoir in Ward 27 that was constructed but is not operational and angers community members
- 4.5. Zanele Mthembu stated that for her scope of work, a project steering Committee (PSC) would need to be established and she proposes two(2) members per ward. She added that there will be fieldwork, by locals, that will be undertaken over a period of two months but the PSC will remain in effect up to the construction phase.
- 4.6. Zanele will ask the Developer , the King Cetshwayo District Municipality (KDCM) to set up a meeting with the Cllrs to respond to any possible queries. All attendees agreed of the following:
  - 4.6.1.the meeting with KDCM must present the full KwaHlokohloko scheme;
  - 4.6.2.there needs to be an introduction of the project Team to Traditional Council Leaders (Mpehlela and Zulu ) and the origin of the fieldworkers must be discussed in the meetings
