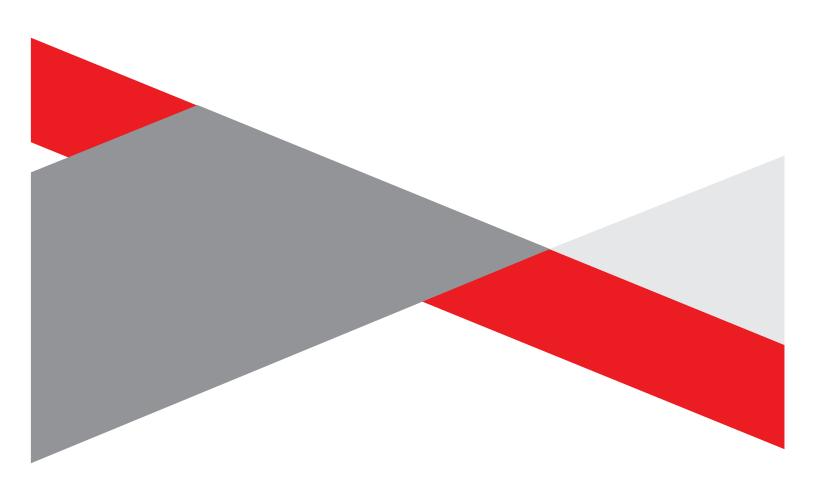



- NBO JN Veneter Beleggings Trusts is agricultural proposing development and associated infrastructure located on a site approximately 7km south-west of Luckhof within the Letsemeng Local Municipality of Xhariep District Municipality in the Free State Province.
- The proposed development will take an area of ~2690ha extent N across 3 properties owned by the Applicant and will be developed in phases.
- The development area will affect the following properties: Farm Diepdraai 754, Farm Weltevreden 755 and Farm Lemoen-spruit 667


### COMPONENTS OF THE JN VENTER BELEGGINGS AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT

### **Agricultural Development Components**

- » Development of centre pivot areas (cultivation and irrigation) which is planned to take approximately 2154ha or more within the project site.
- » Construction of two bulk water pipelines following the same pipeline route of approximately 5.93km from the canal to the proposed two irrigation dams.
- » Two irrigation water storage dams, each with a surface area ranging from 7ha to 46ha.
- » Establishment of an irrigation pipeline network from the irrigation dams to the centre pivot areas.
- » A new pump station taking a total surface area of 549m<sup>2</sup>.
- » A 5MW solar PV facility occupying an area of 9ha, and an associated overhead power line of ~6.9km in length.
- » A Battery Energy Storage System covering a surface area of 0.36ha.




# **Layout Map**


