**ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT AND WATER USE AUTHORISATION PROCESS FOR THE 60MWp PHOTOVOLTAIC PLANT ASSOCIATED WITH THE TUBATSE FERROCHROME SMELTER, STEELPOORT, FETAKGOMO TUBATSE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY**

This serves as an acknowledgement for comments received on 14 July 2021, which stated:  
*“The proposed development site falls within the Critical Biodiversity Area (CBA) 2 in terms of the Conservation Plan of 2013. Therefore, it must be noted that industrial infrastructure activity is an incompatible activity within CBA 2.”*

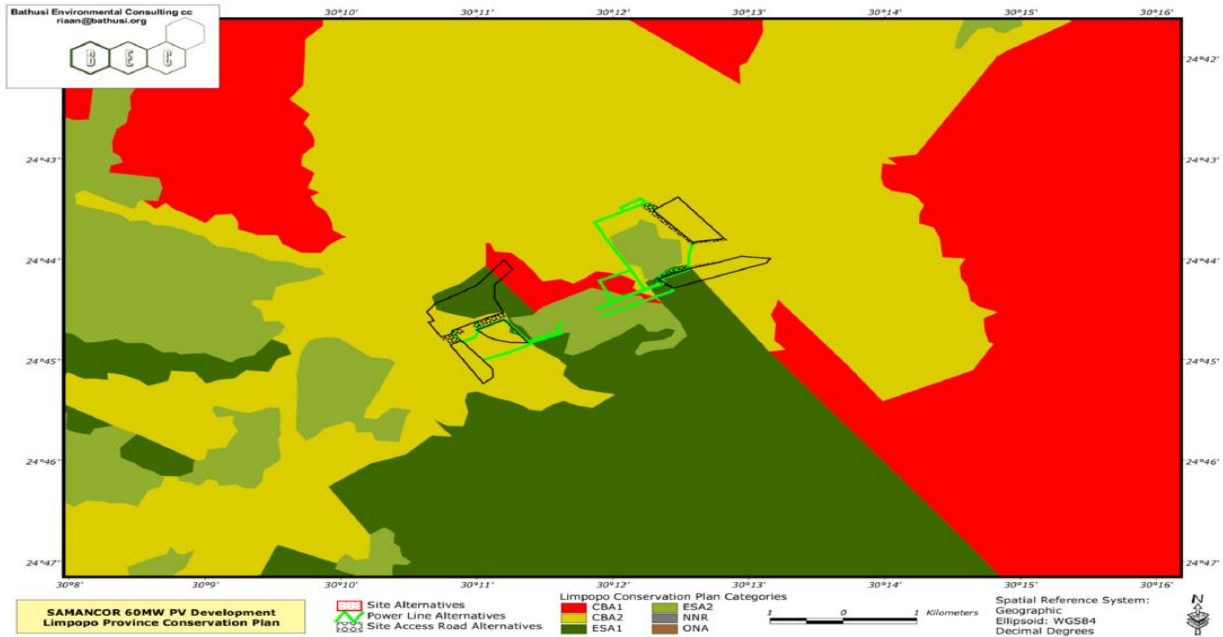


Figure 1: Conservation categories and importance according to the Limpopo C-Plan (2013)

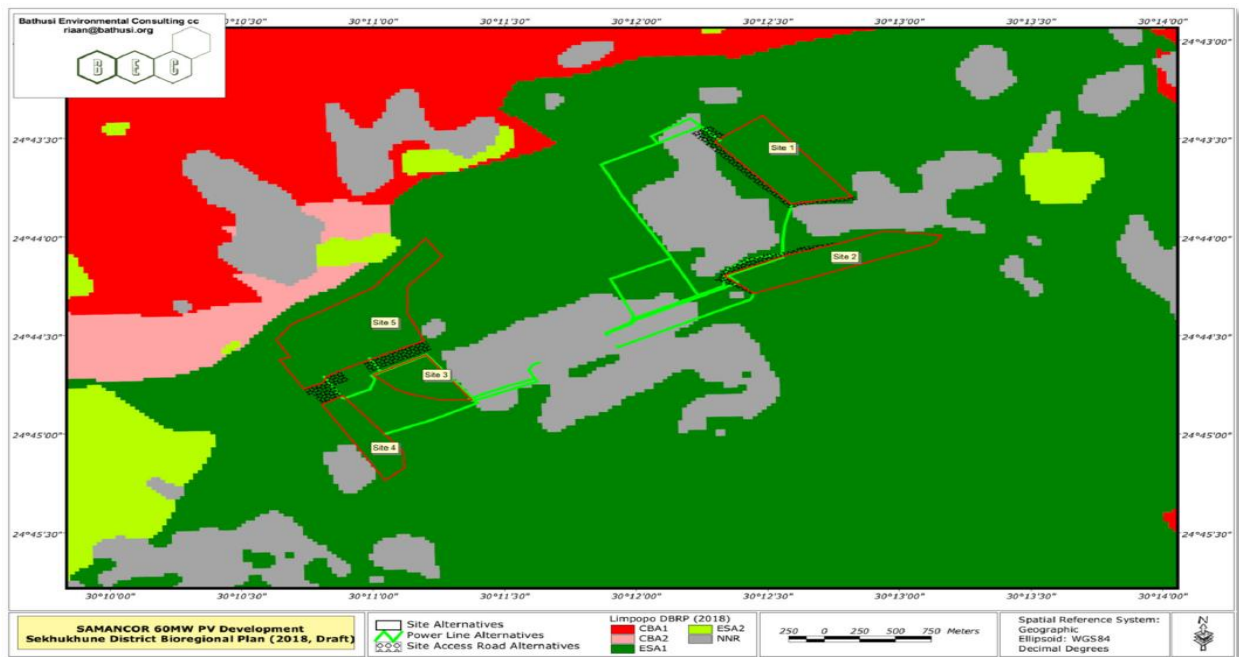


Figure 2: Conservation categories and importance according to the Sekhukhune District Municipality BRP (2020)

The Environmental Scoping Report and subsequent Biodiversity Assessment has considered the relevant legislation, the Limpopo Conservation Plan (C-Plan) 2013 and the Sekhukhune District Municipality Bioregional Plan (BRP) 2020 which was gazetted on the 27 March 2020 as per the Provincial Government Notice No. 3074. As indicated in the Environmental Scoping Report (page 73), *“An appraisal of the BRP categories, specifically in comparison with the Limpopo C-Plan, provides for a more accurate and appropriate categorisation of remaining areas of natural habitat within the development footprints. Where the Limpopo C-Plan (Figure 1) indicates elevated conservation contribution and status, the BRP more accurately describes land transformation and habitat deterioration that is associated with the fragmented and isolated portions of woodland habitat in the immediate surrounds of Steelpoort. The discrepancy between the 2 datasets is likely a result of refined and more recent interpretation of background layers. According to the BRP (Figure 2), all sites are within the Ecological Support Areas (ESA) 1 category.”*

Upon consultation with the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, it was advised that the Sekhukhune District Municipality BRP 2020 is the most relevant and information presented in the BRP supersedes what is presented in the Limpopo C-Plan (2013).

In light of the above, and in the view of the comments received from the Limpopo Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism, RHDHV would like to enquire whether the Limpopo C-Plan (2013) would still take precedent over the Sekhukhune BRP (2021), noting that the BRP has been subject to further refinement which can be considered more reflective of the present conditions within the Sekhukhune District Municipality. The Department's comment on this would be much appreciated.

**COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT SCOPING REPORT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A 60MWP PHOTOVOLTAIC(PV) PLANT ASSOCIATED WITH THE TUBATSE FERROCHROME(TFC) SMELTER, FETAKGOMO TUBATSE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, LIMPOPO PROVINCE.**

The Directorate: Biodiversity Conservation reviewed and evaluated the aforementioned draft report.

Based on the information provided in the report, all sites are within the Ecological Support Areas (ESA 1) category and development within those areas is acceptable as it supports and sustains the ecological functioning of CBAs. Therefore, approximately 25% of this area has already been transformed due to mining activities, cultivation and associated urbanization, notably around the Steelpoort area.

Notwithstanding the above, the following recommendations must be considered in the final Scoping report:

- Preconstruction walk-through of the approved development footprint must be conducted to ensure that sensitive habitats and species are avoided where possible.
- Rehabilitation Plan that guides planting and seeding with indigenous perennial shrubs and succulents from the local area must be developed to avoid erosion and alien invasion.



**COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT SCOPING REPORT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A 60MWP PHOTOVOLTAIC(PV) PLANT ASSOCIATED WITH THE TUBATSE FERROCHROME(TFC) SMELTER, FETAKGOMO TUBATSE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, LIMPOPO PROVINCE.**

- Search and rescue plan must be developed to excise the relocation/ removal for any TOPs or species of conservation concern that have the likelihood of occurring in the study area.
- Permits from relevant authorities must be obtained for the removal or disturbance of any TOPs, Red Data listed or provincially protected species.
- Sensitive habitats in close proximity to the development footprint must be avoided or demarcated as No-Go area (i.e. artificial wetlands or drainage lines).
- Pre and Post Construction Bird monitoring must be conducted under the guidance of an avifaunal specialist to assess collision rates.
- Suitable bird repelling structures and bird diverters must be considered to avoid collision of birds with the PV facility.

The final report must comply with all the requirements as outlined in the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) guideline for renewable energy projects and the Best Practice Guideline for Birds & Solar Energy for assessing and monitoring the impact of solar energy facilities on birds in Southern Africa.

Royal Haskoning DHV (Pty) Ltd has been appointed by Samancor (Pty) Ltd to undertake an environmental assessment as part of the Scoping and Environmental Impact Reporting process in support of an Environmental Authorisation (EA) in terms of the National Environment Management Act, Act 107 of 1998 (NEMA) for activities that trigger the NEMA EIA 2014 Regulations.

5-2, 5-3, 5-4 and 5-6), they are of medium significance. There are 9 historic structures (Sites 1-2, 1-3, 1-4, 1-5, 1-6, 2-4, 2-5, 5-5 and 5-7) and they vary in significance from medium to low. Site 5-8 is a locally significant memorial that is in disuse, it is rated as being of low significance.

Project alternatives 2, 3 and 5 will have the least impact on the archaeological sites.

The author recommends the following:

The mitigation work will be required for sites 3 ( 3-1, 3-2,) and 5 (5-1, 5-2, 5-3, 5-4 and 5-6) as all assessed alternatives will impact the sites.

Extensive mitigation work is required for site 4 (Site 4-1, 4-2).

A permit issued under s35 of the NHRA will be required to conduct such work. On completion of the mitigation work the developer can apply for a destruction permit with the backing of the mitigation report.

The burial ground and graves should be conserved *in situ* with a buffer zone of 30m.

The area is located in a region of low palaeontological significance in terms of the palaeosensitivity map on SAHRIS, and according to the SAHRIS palaeomap a fossil finds procedure must be developed and included in the EMPr.

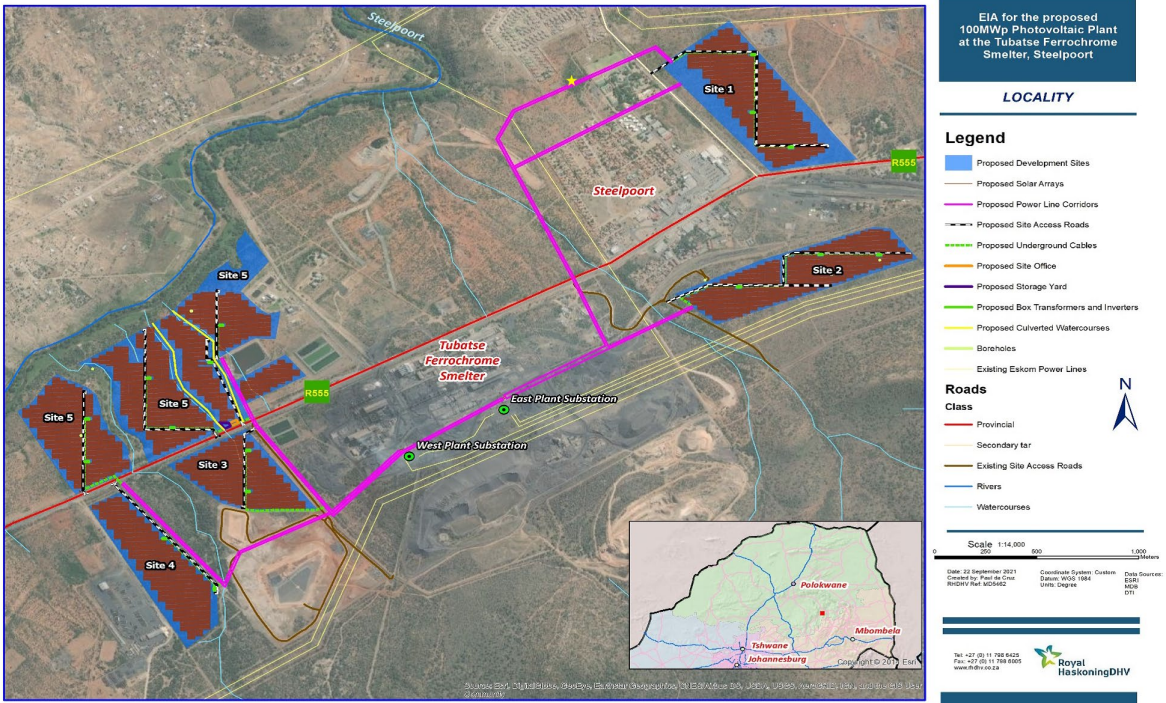

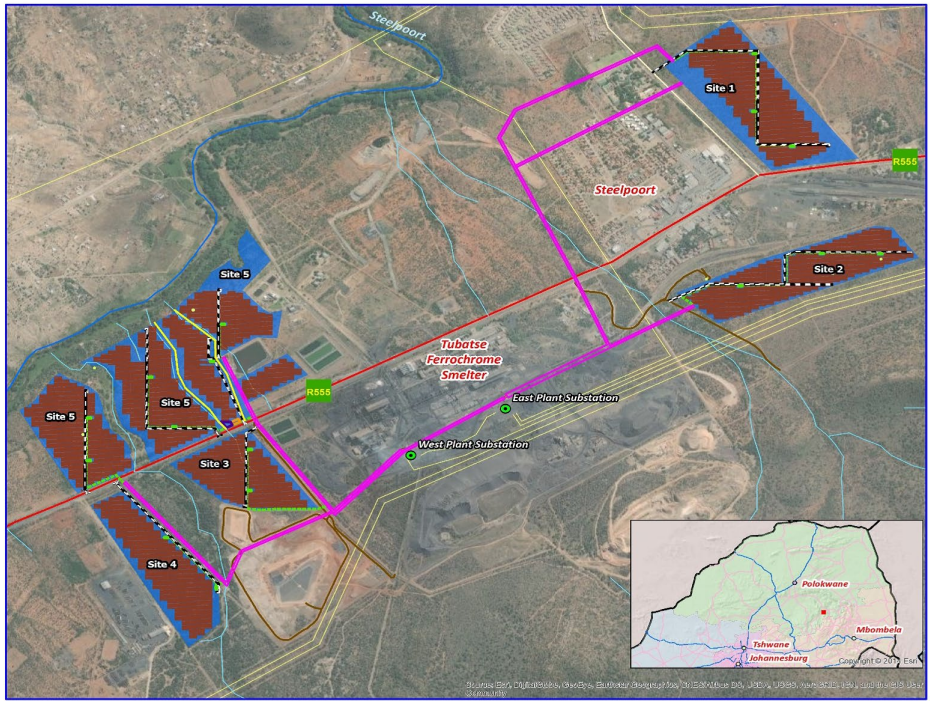
