# CHINUA ACHEBE 'Reus van skrywers in Afrika' oorlede

## Hy was tyd lank siek

KAAPSTAD. – Chinua Achebe (82) was een van die groot skrywers en gewetes van moderne Afrika.

Só het prof. Njabulo Ndebele, oudrektor van die Universiteit van Kaapstad, gereageer op die nuus dat dié beroemde Nigeriese skrywer oorlede is.

"Sy lewe het geëindig, maar die menslike waarde wat dit geskep het, duur voort".

Achebe is in Boston, Massachusetts, oorlede nadat hy gehospitaliseer is. Verskeie bronne het gemeld hy was 'n tyd lank siek.

Achebe se roman *Things Fall Apart* van 1958 beklee 'n sentrale plek in die post-koloniale letterkunde.

"Laat ons nie vergeet nie, die 'buitewêreld' was en is steeds grotendeels arrogant, oningelig en paternalisties wanneer dit na Afrika kyk," het Breyten Breytenbach gesê.

"Kan enigiets nuuts en goeds uit Afrika kom? Ja, beslis en natuurlik – want om selfs net die vraag te stel weerspieël 'n geskiedenis van kolonialisme, slawerny, onkunde en vooroordeel. Achebe was onder diegene wat die weg gebaan het en die oë om te help om die juiste waardigheid aan ons vasteland terug te besorg."

Op Twitter bestempel Achebe se uitgewer Penguin hom as "'n briljante skrywer en 'n reus van Afrika-letterkunde".

"Nelson Mandela het gesê hy het 'Afrika na die res van die wêreld gebring'."

In 1987 het Achebe die Booker-

prys vir sy roman *Anthills of the Savannah* ontvang en in 2007 die Man Booker-internasionale prys. *The Paris Review* meld hy was die stigterredakteur van die Heinemann-reeks van Afrika-letterkunde.

"Die ikoon van die vestigings-tyd van Afrika-letterkunde is dood en in die volgende paar dae en weke sal die gemeenskap van Afrika-letterkundiges met groot leedwyse afskeid neem," het prof. Hein Willemse van die Universiteit van Pretoria gesê.

"Sy heengaan was nie onverwags nie; hy was geruime tyd al siek, maar sy dood laat ons vir 'n oomblik stilstaan by een van die grotes van Afrika-letterkunde."

Achebe is in 1930 in Ogidi, Nigerië, gebore. *Things Fall Apart*, waarvan die titel 'n aanhaling is uit 'n gedig van die Ierse digter W.B. Yeats van wie se werk hy baie gehou het, is in tientalle tale vertaal. Meer as 12 miljoen eksemplare is verkoop.

Achebe was aan verskeie universiteite in Amerika verbonde.

"Ek het nou besef dis tyd om te konsentreer op wat vir my die heel belangrikste is, my gesin."

Arendt het 'n sleutelrol gespeel in die omdraaistrategie van Bay FM in 2007 toe krediteure die gemeenskapsradiostasie wou likwidateer. Arendt was raad, het Arendt geprys vir sy bydrae om die radiostasie destyds van gewisse ondergang te red.

Sy toekomsplanne behels om 'n dansplek in Uitenhage te open.

Die paartjie is sedertdien saam, en Mavis het gesê hulle is baie geënd met "die genade van God" in hul huwelik. "Die geheim van 'n gelukkige huwelik is om die Here in jou hart te hê, en om te leer hoe om te gee én te ontvang."
