The project aims at enhancing efficient movement and opportunities for economic development in the area. The proposed road is a major access and connector road traversing through Diepsloot, stretching from the north and south of the Diepsloot Township located within the jurisdiction of the City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality (CoJ), Gauteng Province.

In terms of Government Notice No. R.543 of NEMA, read with Government Notice No. R.544 (Listing Notice No. 1: Activities 9, 11 and 18) and Government Notice No. R.546 (Listing No. 3: Activity 16) of NEMA, a Basic Assessment (BA) Environmental Process is required in order to obtain an Environmental Authorisation (EA) from the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD) for the above mentioned project.

In terms of Section 21 (c), (f) and (i) of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998) (NWA), the proposed Ingonyama Road Link Extension and the associated 60m long bridge will also require a Water Use License (WUL) for impeding or diverting the flow of water in a watercourse; discharging waste or water containing waste into the water resource through a pipe, canal, sewer, sea outfall or other conduit; and altering the beds, banks, course or characteristics of a watercourse.
