Notice is hereby given in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of 2014 under Section 24 (5) of the National Environmental Management Act, (Act 107 of 1998) (NEMA), the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, (Act 28 of 2002) (MPRDA), the National Water Act, (Act 36 of 1998) that Makoko Management Solutions (MMS) submitted an application for Environmental Authorisation (EA) to prospect for Chrome-Ore to the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR), Limpopo Region, which was accepted on 24 July 2015. The prospecting activities were applied on portions 6, 17, 19, 20 and 24 of farm Grassvally 293 KR.

**Locality:** The targeted prospecting area is located approximately 20km south of Mokopane, Limpopo Province, Mogalakwena Local Municipality. The area required for prospecting is ±131 Hectares.

**The proposed development constitutes the following:** Proposed Prospecting Right area is ±131 Hectares. The project will involve the collecting, assimilating and processing of previous prospecting data and results for the area and continue with the search for the possibility of Chrome-Ore. The findings of this mineral will result to the grade being investigated probably by drilling. The project would also include preliminary economic, logistical, and environmental and community investigations.
