ANNEXURE 1: REASONS FOR THE DECISION

1. Background

Di Kwena Minerals (Pty) Ltd has submitted an application for EA for the activities listed in the NEMA: EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended:

Government Notice No. Regulation 327 of 07 April 2017

Any activity including the operation of that activity which requires a prospecting right in terms of section 16 as amended by section 12 of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (Act No. 28 of 2002), including-

- (a) associated infrastructure, structures and earthworks directly related to prospecting of a mineral resource, or
- (b) the primary processing of a mineral resource including winning, extraction, classifying, concentrating, crushing, screening or washing but excluding the secondary processing of a mineral resource, including the smelting, beneficiation, reduction, refining, calcining or gasification of the mineral resource in which case activity 6 in Listing Notice 2 applies [listed activity 20].

Di Kwena Minerals (Pty) Ltd has appointed Mr. Sedzani Mulaudzi of Mukhadakhomu Environmental Services (Pty) Ltd to undertake the Basic Assessment process as prescribed by Regulation 19 of the NEMA: EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended. The company later changed their EAP in writing to Mr. Oriel Nkabelane of Martilox Technical Consulting and Advisory Ltd.

2. Information considered in making the decision

In reaching its decision the Department took, inter alia, the following into consideration -

- a) The information contained in the application form received by the Department on the 22nd March 2019;
- b) The information contained in the BAR received by the Department on the 21st June 2019;
- c) The objectives and requirements of the applicable and relevant legislation, policies, guidelines and the NEMA:EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended;
- Public Participation Process (PPP) undertaken attached to the BAR including comments received from interested and affected parties attached to the BAR as Annexure B, C, D, E, F and G.
- e) Minutes and attendance registers of interested and affected parties (Ga-Rasai community and the landowner).



3. Key factors considered in making the decision

All the information presented to the Department was taken into account upon the Department's consideration of the application. A summary of the issues which in the Department's view, were of the most significance are set out below.

- a) The procedure that has been followed is in accordance with the NEMA and the EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended.
- b) The environmental impacts associated with the proposed prospecting activities will be addressed by the proposed mitigation measures outlined in the EMPr compiled by Mr. Sedzani Mulaudzi of Mukhadakhomu Environmental Services (Pty) Ltd.
- c) A sufficient Public Participation Process (PPP) was undertaken and the applicant has satisfied the minimum requirements as prescribed in Chapter 6 regulation 41 of the NEMA:EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended for public involvement;
- d) Consultation with South African Heritage Resources Agency (SAHRA) to determine if the applicant must conduct Phase 1 of Heritage Impact Assessment.
- e) The financial provision to the amount of R206 772. 00 was provided for rehabilitation which is available to this office.

4. Findings

After consideration of the information and factors listed above, the Department made the following findings -

- a) The potential impacts on the proposed site were clearly investigated and mitigation measures outlined.
- b) Public Participation Process complied with Chapter 6 of the NEMA: EIA Regulations R.982. The PPP included, inter-alia, the following:
 - Background Information Document sent to the Interested and affected parties;
 - The meetings were held with interested and affected parties including landowners on the 06th February 2019, 18th April 2019 and 01st August 2019;
 - A newspaper advertisement was placed in the local newspaper "Rustenburg Herald" dated the 24th May 2019;
 - Notification letters sent to the interested and affected parties including authorities
