## 1 ATTENDEES AND INTRODUCTION

## 2 OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the meeting were to:

- Review the content of the draft Scoping Report;
- Provide company and project information;
- Allow opportunity for comment and gather issues and concerns;
- Open communication channels;
- Use issues and comments to guide specialist studies and;
- Form constructive partnerships with relevant parties.

## 3 PRESENTATION

During the meeting, Digby Wells Environmental (Digby Wells) presented a summary of the information which is reflected in points 3.1 to 3.5. A summary of the presentations made by Mr Simon Choma senior and junior is reflected in Table 2. The presentation was conducted in English and Sepedi.

### 3.1 Environmental Impact Assessment Process

AL briefly explained that Digby Wells has been appointed as the independent environmental consultant by Sylvania Platinum (Sylvania) to compile the necessary documents and undertake the required environmental and public participation processes in support of the environmental authorisations which are required for a Mining Right for

the proposed Everest North platinum mine which will be located approximately 12.5 Km for the existing Everest South platinum mine in the Thaba Chweu Local Municipality near Lydenburg in the Mpumalanga Province.

### **3.2 Legislative requirements**

Sylvania Platinum in collaboration with Aquarius Platinum South Africa (AQPSA) is required to fulfil the following key environmental legislative requirements towards successfully obtaining a Mining Right:

- Mineral and Petroleum Resource Development Act, Act No.28 of 2002 (MPRDA);
- National Environmental Management Act, Act No. 107 of 1998 (NEMA);
- National Water Act, Act No. 36 of 1998 (NWA);
- National Environmental Management Waste Act, Act No. 59 of 2008 (NEMWA);
- Provincial and relevant by-laws

### **3.3 Specialist studies**

Digby Wells will undertake specialist studies in the area, starting in the next two to three weeks. The specialist studies will include (1) fauna and flora (2) groundwater and surface water (3) aquatic ecology and wetlands (4) air quality Assessment (5) noise assessment (6) visual assessment (7) & (8) heritage / archaeology assessment and (9) social assessment. The findings of the specialist studies will be incorporated into the draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report which will be available for public review and comments.

### **3.4 Public Participation Process**

Digby Wells commenced with the public participation process (PPP) in November 2011 which entailed distribution of the Background Information Document, publication of media advertisements, placement of site notices and undertaking one-on-one meetings with the interested and affected parties. It was stated that the purpose of this meeting was to obtain comments and concerns from stakeholders regarding the proposed project. Comments and questions will be incorporated in the final Scoping Report to be submitted to the Mpumalanga Department Economic Development, Environment and Tourism (MDEDET) for review. A public meeting will be held to review and report back on the findings (positive and negative impacts) of the specialist studies and to again obtain comments from stakeholders.

### **3.5 Regulatory Reports**

A draft Environmental Scoping Report was compiled in accordance with NEMA regulations and was also made available to the public for comment from **7 December 2011** until **3 February 2012**. The public review period was subsequently extended and stakeholders will be notified accordingly. A MPRDA compliant SR will be compiled and submitted with a Mining Right Application (MRA) to the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) in **March 2012**.

## **4 OPEN DISCUSSION FORUM**

Meeting attendees were provided with the opportunity to raise their issues, concerns and comments in their preferred language of choice to allow for equal access and understanding of the information distributed during the meeting. AL opened the floor for questions and discussions. The questions, issues of concern and comments made during the meeting are presented in Table 2 below.

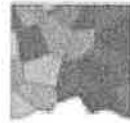
