

Scope of works:


- Rehabilitating the existing jetty structure by performing concrete repairs.

Site Plan:



Revetment progress and found object location:

Before the object was discovered on site, the contractor was in the process of preparing the area and removing some of the larger revetment material. More material is still to be removed in the area and new revetment material to be put in place. The areas in which the contractor removed material are indicated below in green.



The object was discovered at co-ordinates 29°15'26.9"S 16°52'04.0"E indicated on the map above.

General:

The object which was found is currently still on site. The object is very fragile with the gauge of the metal being approximately 0.5 mm.
