SAHRA hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced service providers to submit proposals to develop a Conservation Management Plan (CMP) for "Blackie", a steam engine train (Specifically Declared Heritage Object) declared by then National Monument Council (NMC), in terms of the National Monument Act of 1969. Blackie is currently housed at Figrove in Cape Town, Western Cape. Passenger, Rail Agency of South Africa (PRASA) is constructing the plinth which is not yet complete as Blackie is going to be relocated to Cape Town Station once the plinth is completed.
