MTPA COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT SCOPING REPORT FOR THE MINING RIGHT APPLICATION FOR NHLABATHI MINERALS (PTY) LTD AND THE IEAR FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION ON PORTIONS OF THE FARMS OLIFANTSFONTEIN 196 IR AND RIETKOL 237 IR , VICTOR KHANYE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY IN MPUMALANGA PROVINCE ,DMR REFERENCE

With reference to your D Scoping report, Jacana of February 2018, the following comments:

The MTPA has no objection to the proposed mining project, but has the following concerns:

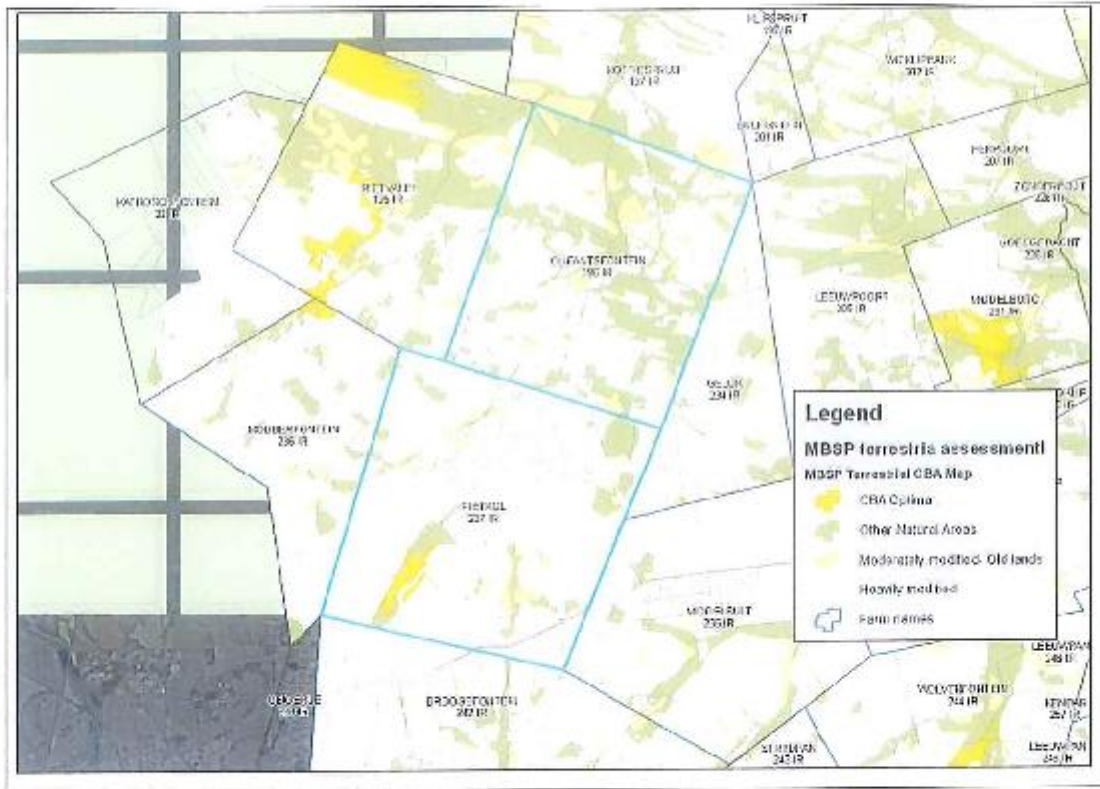


Fig. 1. MBSP Terrestrial biodiversity map of the two farms.

1. The MBSP (2014) Terrestrial assessment fig 1. and fig 3. attached indicate that there is a section of portion 9 of the farm Rietkol 237 IR that consists of a Critical Biodiversity Area Optimal. Although that the mining right area and mine plan lies in another portion of the farm, the MTPA is concerned that mining activities might impact on this natural area. The EMP should ensure that the natural state is maintained.

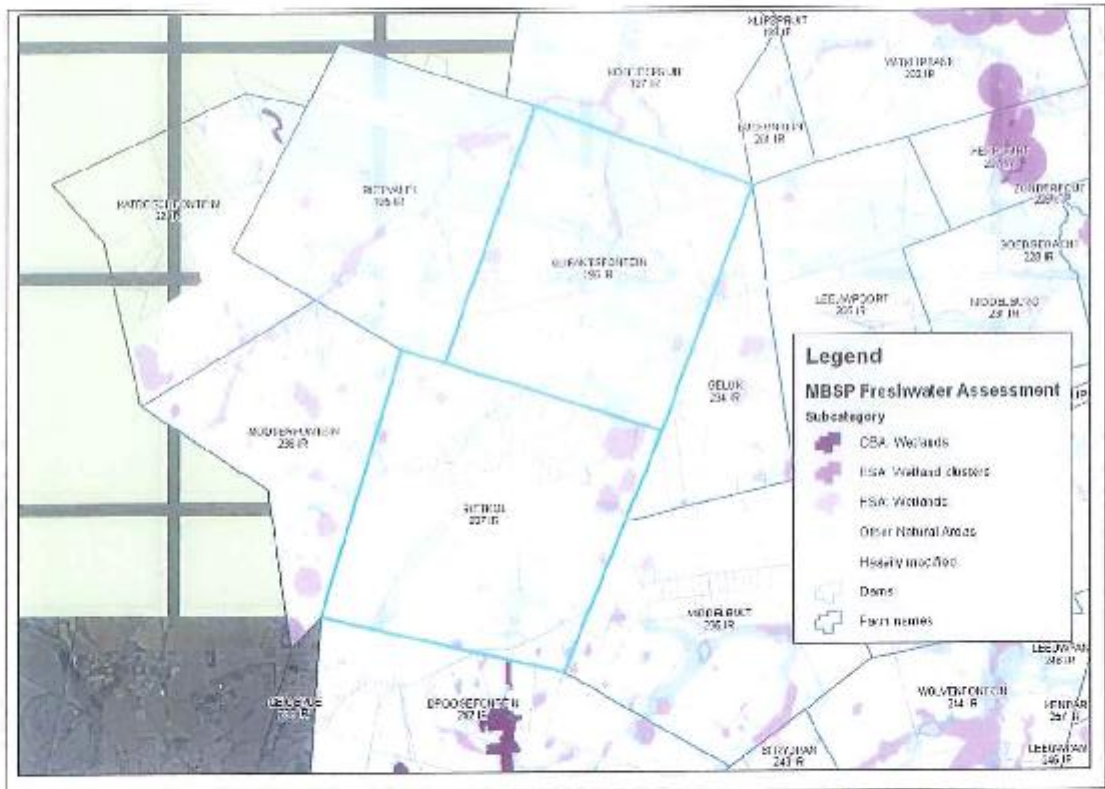


Fig. 2. MBSP freshwater map.

2. The Freshwater assessment fig 2. Attached indicate Ecological Support Area Wetlands (ESA). These areas should also be maintained in a natural state with no loss of ecosystem services. In the event that the mine plan is going to affect these wetlands, the company should invest in an offset strategy.
3. MTPA is further concerned that the critically endangered terrestrial orchid, Albertan Sisal orchid, *Brachycorythis conica subs.transvaalensis* (Johnson, Bytebier & Starker, 2015) which is restricted to SA might occur on this farm. It has been listed for this farm. (Flowers from January to February).

Recommendations:

1. The MTPA recommends that a thorough flora study is done during the growing season over the whole of both farms.
2. Wetland delineation is done in order to include the buffer zone of 100 metres as well as a determination of the size in hectares of these sensitive areas.
3. If the plant in question is found that the MTPA Scientific Services is notified.
4. That the flora study must include all exotic plants that need to be removed and a long term maintenance plan is included in the EMP.
5. Active water purification forms part of the EMP as well for the next 100 years after mining.

The Applicant is advised that an application for a prospecting right for coal and the applicable application for an environmental authorisation was some time ago been made from a company called Motau Mining Services (Pty) Ltd under DMRE Reference No.MP 30/5/1/1/2//16488 PR. The proposed prospecting area is within the proposed mining area of the Rietkol Silica Project. The Applicant is called upon to advised my client how it intends to mine for silica when coal will in future be mined in the same mining area. These propose environmental impacts and the mitigation methods associated therewith must be included in the DSR and further documentation as statutory required in terms of the provisions of the EIAR.

I will now deal with the contents of the DRS and supporting baseline studies applicable to the DSR relevant to the my client's, extensive business of the planting of flowers of various cultivars in hothouses (tunnels) and the marketing thereof ("the business") on the above properties which are in close proximity to the proposed mining area of the proposed Rietkol Silica Mine.

It must not be construed or implied that my client necessarily agree with the contents of the DSR which we do not specifically address in this letter, and my client's rights are reserved to comments in future on any of those issues if it deems it necessary, and once it is in receipt of the draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report and the necessary Environmental Specialist Reports which will follow the DSR, as well as the documents as listed and referred to above with regards to the application for the mining right by the Applicant.

You are advised, at this earlier stage of the proposed project that my client will suffer irreparable loss and damages should the proposed mine be established on properties adjacent or nearby to the affected properties. Environmental degradation associated with mining such as air pollution, dust pollution, water depletion and polluted water are not conducive to the business of my client as explained above.

The below mentioned studies should also focus particular on the business of my client also with regard to anti-pollution measures with regard to the accumulation of silica dust on the hothouses and the flowers, and the increased financial cost of the removal of excessive dust from the hothouses. In this regard it should be noted that the removal of dust on the hothouses will necessitate an increase in water consumption and the employment of more labour intensive methods.

Environmental and Scientific Studies should be undertaken to evaluate and to investigate the effect that silica dust emanating from the proposed mine may have on the inhabitants of the area.

The following statements made on page 13, paragraph 7.1.1 in the Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment Report, namely, *“During a survey conducted by AirCHECK at an existing mine in the Delmas area, it was establish that the crystalline silica contents of the dust was 26%.”*, and *“it has been estimated that there are at least 480 000 cases of silicosis and 226 000 cases of tuberculosis in former mineworkers attributable to work in South African mines”*, are of great concern and ,to say the least, shocking.

The environmental impact and degradation concerning the health risks and health threats associated with silicosis, and medical conditions associated with silicosis should be extensively research with regard to this new proposed silica mine, especially in the light of the Covid-19 Virus Pandemic, as persons with underlying medical conditions (such as lung deceases and respiratory illnesses) will be more a risk to contract the Covid-19 Virus. The studies should include, not only mineworkers and contractors who will work on the proposed mine, but also the general public residing adjacent and in close proximity of the mine.

The Plan of Study should include a comprehensive medical research and study report as referred to above, especially in the light of the crushing methods that will be used to crush and screen the silica sand to a very small size of -5mm.

The Applicant is alluded to the following provisions of Section 24(a) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, No.108 of 1996 which clearly provides that *“Everyone has the right to an environment that is not harmful to their health or well-being”*.

AIR POLLUTION

The Environmental Specialist should investigate and evaluate the effect that dust may have on the business of my client, especially silica dust and dust emanating from the proposed mine.

The statement on page 161, paragraph 8.2.7.1.6 of the DSR, namely, *“Opencast mining should control the generation of particulate matter on mine haul roads. Water spraying is a cheap and effective means of control and should be consistently applied across mines in the Highveld Priority Area ”* is a general statement and does not address mitigation methods for air pollution from the emission of dust generated by the crusher and screening plants,

especially in the light of the fact that those dust particles contain silica particles which is detrimental to the health of the affected and interested party and the community living in close proximity to the proposed mine.

The statement *“Fugitive dust emissions released during mining operations are generally only of concern within 3 - 5 km of the mine boundary”* on the same page of the DSR is a clear indication that dust will have a effect on my client’s business operations, as its property falls within this range.

The statement on page 195, paragraph 9.7.1 of the DSR, namely *“Fine particles can be dispersed over much greater distances. Fugitive dust may have significant adverse impacts such as reduced visibility, soiling of buildings and materials, reduced growth and production in vegetation and may affect sensitive areas and aesthetics. Fugitive dust can also adversely affect human health.”* Is a clear indication that the Air Pollution Impact Assessment Studies should be amplified to show clearly the mitigation measures which will be implemented by the mine, and that such studies should specifically include mitigating measures concerning fugitive dust emissions which will certainly affect my client’s business.

The reference to studies that were conducted in 2017 by Eskom on a Chicken Farm Site situated approximately 30km north-east of the Rietkol mining area in the DSR is, with respect irrelevant, and has no bearing on the air environment in the Rietkol study area. It is not clear if that dust emissions were generated by a coal mine or by a silica mine

Dust monitoring points must be installed at the business site of my client and must be regularly monitor as was requested previously.

SOCIO- ECONOMICAL IMPACT

It is noted on page 214, paragraph 10.1 of the DSR that *“A macro-economic study is aimed at determining the economic and socio-economic indicators and assist in identifying the best alternative land use option.”*

The social and financial impact of the employees of the business should be investigated and in the event that the business has to close down due to the negative impact that the proposed mine would have on the business as explained above.

The financial impact on the business must be investigated as well.

In this regard you are referred to the provisions of Chapter 5, Section 23(2)(b) of the National Environmental Management Act, No. 107 of 1998 (NEMA) which provides that the Applicant must identify, predict and evaluate the actual and potential impact on, inter alia, the socio-economic conditions of the area, in this case, specifically to the business of my client.

It is inadequate, and in contradiction to the provisions of Section 23(2) (b) of NEMAS if the proposed study as referred in the DSR, as referred to, and quoted above, is only based on “*a broad level, investigating impacts on overall welfare requires considering the efficiency, equity, and sustainability of the project*” as stated on page 215 of the DSR. The Socio-Economic Impact Report must be conducted at individual businesses, such as that of my client, and cannot be generalised.

CUMULATIVE IMPACT.

It is placed on record that the proposed development of this project together with new coal mines adjacent and nearby to the business that are currently planned will have a cumulative impact on the business operations of my client specifically, and to the flower and roses producing industry in the region in general. This cumulative impact from an economic, social and environmental perspective should be investigated and included as part of the specialized environmental studies.

The new coal mine projects which will affect the business of my clients are: Palmietkuilen, Eloff Mining (Exxaro), and Kangala Colliery Extension (Universal Coal). Information on all these projects is in the public domain and can be researched by the Applicant.

WATER QUALITY AND QUANTITY

We reserve the right to comment on the above subjects once the required Environmental Specialist Study, as part of the Draft EIA, has been submitted to my client for comments in the light of the undertaking on page 219, paragraph 10.3.2, namely that the following environmental specialist study will be conducted, namely, “*Updating of the groundwater numerical model (pollution plume) and impact assessment based on the preferred layout for the project.*”

The proposed investigation should be amplified to include an investigation and study to determine the effect that water usages at its proposed mine will have on the available water sources for the area, as future water demands is likely to cause a decrease in water





It is also recorded that the comments, objections and concerns raised at the time when the first application for a mining right and environmental authorisation was made by the Applicant during march 2018 must be read in conjunction with the comments to the now applicable DSR, *mutatis mutandis*. The contents of the responses of my client to the then Draft Scoping Report, the Environmental Specialised Studies and the Draft Environmental Management Programme Report must be included in respective Reports as applicable.

It must not be construed or implied that my client necessarily agree with the contents of the DSR which we do not specifically address in this letter, and my client's rights are reserved to comments in future on any of those issues if it deems it necessary, and once it is in receipt of the draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report and the necessary Environmental Specialist Reports which will follow the DSR, as well as the environmental studies as listed and referred to below.

The Applicant is advised that an application for a prospecting right for coal and the applicable application for an environmental authorisation was some time ago been made from a company called Motau Mining Services (Pty) Ltd under DMRE Reference No.MP 30/5/1/1/2//16488 PR. The proposed prospecting area is within the proposed mining area of the Rietkol Silica Project. The Applicant is called upon to advised my client how it intends to mine for silica when coal will in future be mined in the same mining area. These propose environmental impacts and the mitigation methods associated therewith must be included in the DSR and further documentation as statutory required in terms of the provisions of the EIAR. The above fact was brought under your attention in our letter dated 24 February 2021 but we have had no reply from you in this regard.

I will now deal with the contents of the DRS and supporting baseline studies applicable to the DSR relevant to the my client's, chicken broilers, egg production facilities, egg packing and storage facilities and its fodder, feed stock facilities, and associated infrastructure (hereinafter jointly and severally referred to as "the business") on the above properties which are situated within and adjacent to the proposed mining area of the proposed Rietkol Silica Mine (see properties descriptions in the preamble of the letter).

You are advised, at this earlier stage of the proposed project that my client will suffer irreparable loss and damages should the proposed mine be established on the property within the mining area or on properties adjacent and nearby to the affected properties.

Special attention should be paid to the fact that the facilities primary functions are the production of food, for humans and animals, and if these produced food (especially eggs) are contaminated with silica dust in particular, and dust in general, my client will not be able to sell these food products to retailers and consumers, as very specific and stringent rules and regulations, as well as retailer's specific requirements concerning health cannot be met by my client in the above circumstances. Packing of eggs and packing material will be contaminated by dust.

The effect on the egg laying hens and broiler chickens will be dealt with below.

Environmental degradation associated with mining such as noise, ground vibration, air pollution, dust pollution, water depletion and polluted water are not conducive to the business of my client.

The below mentioned studies should also focus particular on the business of my client, also with regard to anti-pollution measures with regard to the accumulation of silica dust in the atmosphere, and consequently, silica dust, and dust in general, which will gather on the various facilities associated with the business of my client.

PROPERTY OF MY CLIENT WHICH FALLS WITHIN THE MINING AREA

Portion 71 of the Farm Rietkol 237 IR owned by my client falls within the mining right area. The egg packing facility is situated on this property. From the mine layout plan it is noticed that the proposed opencast mining area is in close proximity thereof.

The egg packing facility is very statically located for logistic and cost effective purposes, and is an integral part of the business of my client.

It therefore stands to reason that my client will suffer financial loss if this facility must be relocated.

EFFECT OF SILICOSIS ON HUMAN BEINGS

Environmental, Medical and Scientific Studies should be undertaken to evaluate and to investigate the effect that silica dust emanating from the proposed mine may have on the inhabitants of the area.

The following statements made on page 13, paragraph 7.1.1 in the Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment Report, namely, *"During a survey conducted by AirCHECK at an existing*

mine in the Delmas area, it was establish that the crystalline silica contents of the dust was 26%.” , and “it has been estimated that there are at least 480 000 cases of silicosis and 226 000 cases of tuberculosis in former mineworkers attributable to work in South African mines” , are of great concern and ,to say the least, shocking.

The environmental impact and degradation concerning the health risks and health threats associated with silicosis, and medical conditions associated with silicosis should be extensively research with regard to this new proposed silica mine, especially in the light of the Covid-19 Virus Pandemic, as persons with underlying medical conditions (such as lung deceases and respiratory illnesses) will be more a risk to contract the Covid-19 Virus. The studies should include, not only mineworkers and contractors who will work on the proposed mine, but also the general public residing adjacent and in close proximity of the mine.

The Plan of Study should include a comprehensive medical research and study report as referred to above, especially in the light of the crushing methods that will be used to crush and screen the silica sand to a very small size of -5mm.

The Applicant is alluded to the following provisions of Section 24(a) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, No.108 of 1996 which clearly provides that *“Everyone has the right to an environment that is not harmful to their health or well-being”*.

THE EFFECT OF SILICOSIS ON CHICKENS

The effect of silicosis on chickens should be research by veterinarians, as this possible health risk could have a detrimental effect on the business of my client due to mortalities of chicken and egg laying hens. The production rate of egg laying hens may also be affected.

AIR POLLUTION

The Environmental Specialist should investigate and evaluate the effect that dust may have on the business of my client, especially silica dust and dust emanating from the proposed mine.

The statement on page 161, paragraph 8.2.7.1.6 of the DSR, namely, *“Opencast mining should control the generation of particulate matter on mine haul roads. Water spraying is a cheap and effective means of control and should be consistently applied across mines in the Highveld Priority Area ”* is a general statement and does not address mitigation methods for air pollution from the emission of dust generated by the crusher and screening plants,

especially in the light of the fact that those dust particles contain silica particles which is detrimental to the health of the affected and interested party and the community living in close proximity to the proposed mine.

Of paramount importance is that the environmental specialised study on Air Pollution should be extended, particular with regard to the effect that silica dust in particular, and dust in general, will have on the chickens and egg laying hens.

The statement *“Fugitive dust emissions released during mining operations are generally only of concern within 3 - 5 km of the mine boundary”* on the same page of the DSR is a clear indication that dust will have an effect on my client’s business operations, as its property falls within this range, as a matter of fact it is by far nearer than the indicated range.

The statement on page 195, paragraph 9.7.1 of the DSR, namely *“Fine particles can be dispersed over much greater distances. Fugitive dust may have significant adverse impacts such as reduced visibility, soiling of buildings and materials, reduced growth and production in vegetation and may affect sensitive areas and aesthetics. Fugitive dust can also adversely affect human health.”* is a clear indication that the Air Pollution Impact Assessment Studies should be amplified to show clearly the mitigation measures which will be implemented by the mine, and that such studies should specifically include mitigating measures concerning fugitive dust emissions which will certainly affect my client’s business.

The reference to studies that were conducted in 2017 by Eskom on a Chicken Farm Site situated approximately 30km north-east of the Rietkol mining area in the DSR is, with respect irrelevant, and has no bearing on the air environment in the Rietkol study area. It is not clear if that dust emissions were generated by a coal mine or by a silica mine.

If the intention of the Applicant was that the Eskom study should be used to apply to the business of my client, then such assumptions, due to irrelevance, are incorrect and are rejected as such.

Dust monitoring points must be installed at the business sites of my client and must be regularly monitor.

NOISE

On page 149, paragraph 8.2.8.2.2 the following statement is made, namely *“Mining activities (calculated noise levels) should not change these proposed acceptable rating levels with more than 7 dBA (disturbing noise) and ideally with no more than 3 dBA.”*

“ideally” is only a statement and is not conclusive, and fails to indicate any specifics and realities which noise generated by mining operations and associated activities will have on the environment. According to the above statement the dBa could be as high as 7 dBa. It appears if all of the above statement is purely speculation and has not been properly modelled in a an environmental study.

It should be noted that the acceptable dBA (disturbing noise) as defined in SANS 10103:2008 is applicable to human beings. The effect of noise to animals, in this particular instance, chickens and egg laying hens, should be investigated and the Noise Specialised Studies should be amplified to determine the effect which the increase in the dBA due to mining will have on chickens and egg laying hens, and the mitigating measures which the mine must implement to lessen such impact.

BLASTING AND GROUND VIBRATION

The Section in the DSR (Section 9.9) concerning blasting and ground vibration is merely a summary in general terms what normally occurs when a mine undertakes blasting operations. It lacks any specifics as to what the environmental effect of blasting and ground vibration will be in the case of this particular mining operation. No blasting and ground vibration modelling has been undertaken to determine the degradation to the environment due to blasting and ground vibration, and the mitigating measures that the mine will implement to prevent such environmental harm.

A Blasting and Ground Vibration Impact Study should be undertaken by an environmental specialist.

The above study should be amplified and should also study the effect which blasting and ground vibration will have on the well-being of chickens and egg laying hens, as such noise and vibration will in all probability have an impact on egg production and life span of the chickens and egg laying hens of my client.

WATER QUALITY AND QUANTITY

We reserve the right to comment on the above subjects once the required Environmental Specialist Study, as part of the Draft EIA, has been submitted to my client for comments in the light of the undertaking on page 219, paragraph 10.3.2, namely that the following environmental specialist study will be conducted, namely, *“Updating of the groundwater numerical model (pollution plume) and impact assessment based on the preferred layout for the project.”*

The proposed investigation should be amplified to include an investigation and study to determine the effect that water usages at its proposed mine will have on the available water sources for the area, as future water demands is likely to cause a decrease in water availability in the area with the result that my client's business, and the agricultural activities in the area in general, will suffer loss and damage.

It is recorded that water quality and quantity is of high importance to my client with regard to the continuous availability of clean water for the watering of its chickens and egg laying hens. Depletion of water, or dirty water will cause damage to its business and will result in a decrease in egg production and even mortality among its chicken and hen stock.

POULTRY IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT

It is necessary, in the light of the aforesaid with regards to the various impacts which the proposed mine will have on the chicken and egg laying hens of my client, and the business at large, that a specialised environmental poultry impact assessment study be undertaken to identify, predict and evaluate the actual and potential impact on the aforesaid, particular with regards to the following:

- Relocation of the Packing Facility;
- Dust (Silica Dust and Dust in general)
- Noise;
- Blasting and Ground Vibration
- Surface and Ground Water
- Water Contamination

SOCIO- ECONOMICAL IMPACT

It is noted on page 214, paragraph 10.1 of the DSR that *"A macro-economic study is aimed at determining the economic and socio-economic indicators and assist in identifying the best alternative land use option."*

The social and financial impact of the employees of the business should be investigated and in the event that the packing facilities has to relocate due to the negative impact that the proposed mine would have on the business as explained above.

The financial impact on the business must be investigated as well, especially in the case where the packing facility must be relocated.

Information on all these projects is in the public domain and can be researched by the Applicant.

Report, the Environmental Specialised Studies and the Draft Environmental Management Programme Report must be included in respective Reports as applicable.

The Applicant is advised that an application for a prospecting right for coal and the applicable application for an environmental authorisation was some time ago been made from a company called Motau Mining Services (Pty) Ltd under DMRE Reference No.MP 30/5/1/1/2//16488 PR. The proposed prospecting area is within the proposed mining area of the Rietkol Silica Project.

The Applicant is called upon to advised my client how it intends to mine for silica when coal will in future be mined in the same mining area. These propose environmental impacts and the mitigation methods associated therewith must be included in the DSR and further documentation as statutory required in terms of the provisions of the EIAR.

My client's commercial farming business comprises the farming with prickly pears and roses and the harvesting of arable grazing ("tef") on the affected properties.

The prickly pears and roses are produced for the export market. These produce is planted in hothouses (tunnels) and on cultivated lands.

(the above commercial farming activities and business are hereinafter referred to jointly and severally as "the business")

It must not be construed or implied that my client necessarily agree with the contents of the DSR which we do not specifically address in this letter, and my client's rights are reserved to comments in future on any of those issues if it deems it necessary, and once it is in receipt of the draft Environmental Impact Assessment Report and the necessary Environmental Specialist Reports which will follow the DSR, as well as the documents as listed and referred to above with regards to the application for the mining right by the Applicant.

I will now deal with the contents of the DRS and supporting baseline studies applicable to the DSR relevant to the my client's, business on the above properties which are situated adjacent and in close proximity to the proposed mining area of the proposed Rietkol Silica Mine (see properties descriptions in the preamble of the letter).

Special attention should be paid to the fact that the commercial farming business is, *inter alia*, the production of food, for humans and animals, and if these produced food (especially prickly pears) are contaminated with silica dust in particular, and dust in general, my client will not be able to sell the food product to retailers and consumers, as very specific and

stringent rules and regulations, as well as retailer's specific requirements concerning health cannot be met by my client in the above circumstances. Packing material will be contaminated by dust. The same applies to the selling and marketing of roses (and maize if applicable to my client's business) *mutatis mutandis*.

You are advised, in the light of the aforesaid, at this earlier stage of the proposed project that my client will suffer irreparable loss and damages should the proposed mine be established on properties adjacent or nearby to the affected properties. Environmental degradation associated with mining such as air pollution, dust pollution, water depletion and polluted water are not conducive to the business of my client as explained above.

The below mentioned studies should also focus particular on the business of my client also with regard to anti-pollution measures with regard to the accumulation of silica dust on the hothouses, the prickly pears and the roses, and the increased financial cost of the removal of excessive dust from the hothouses. In this regard it should be noted that the removal of dust on the hothouses will necessitate an increase in water consumption and the employment of more labour intensive methods.

EFFECT OF SILICOSIS ON HUMAN BEINGS

Environmental and Scientific Studies should be undertaken to evaluate and to investigate the effect that silica dust emanating from the proposed mine may have on the inhabitants of the area.

The following statements made on page 13, paragraph 7.1.1 in the Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment Report, namely, *"During a survey conducted by AirCHECK at an existing mine in the Delmas area, it was established that the crystalline silica contents of the dust was 26%."*, and *"it has been estimated that there are at least 480 000 cases of silicosis and 226 000 cases of tuberculosis in former mineworkers attributable to work in South African mines"*, are of great concern and, to say the least, shocking.

The environmental impact and degradation concerning the health risks and health threats associated with silicosis, and medical conditions associated with silicosis should be extensively researched with regard to this new proposed silica mine, especially in the light of the Covid-19 Virus Pandemic, as persons with underlying medical conditions (such as lung diseases and respiratory illnesses) will be more at risk to contract the Covid-19 Virus. The studies should include, not only mineworkers and contractors who will work on the proposed mine, but also the general public residing adjacent and in close proximity of the mine.

The Plan of Study should include a comprehensive medical research and study report as referred to above, especially in the light of the crushing methods that will be used to crush and screen the silica sand to a very small size of -5mm.

The Applicant is alluded to the following provisions of Section 24(a) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, No.108 of 1996 which clearly provides that *“Everyone has the right to an environment that is not harmful to their health or well-being”*.

AIR POLLUTION

The Environmental Specialist should investigate and evaluate the effect that dust may have on the business of my client, especially silica dust and dust emanating from the proposed mine.

The statement on page 161, paragraph 8.2.7.1.6 of the DSR, namely, *“Opencast mining should control the generation of particulate matter on mine haul roads. Water spraying is a cheap and effective means of control and should be consistently applied across mines in the Highveld Priority Area ”* is a general statement and does not address mitigation methods for air pollution from the emission of dust generated by the crusher and screening plants, especially in the light of the fact that those dust particles contain silica particles which is detrimental to the health of the affected and interested party and the community living in close proximity to the proposed mine.

The statement *“Fugitive dust emissions released during mining operations are generally only of concern within 3 - 5 km of the mine boundary”* on the same page of the DSR is a clear indication that dust will have an effect on my client’s business operations, as its property falls within this range.

The statement on page 195, paragraph 9.7.1 of the DSR, namely *“Fine particles can be dispersed over much greater distances. Fugitive dust may have significant adverse impacts such as reduced visibility, soiling of buildings and materials, reduced growth and production in vegetation and may affect sensitive areas and aesthetics. Fugitive dust can also adversely affect human health.”* Is a clear indication that the Air Pollution Impact Assessment Studies should be amplified to show clearly the mitigation measures which will be implemented by the mine, and that such studies should specifically include mitigating measures concerning fugitive dust emissions which will certainly affect my client’s business.

The reference to studies that were conducted in 2017 by Eskom on a Chicken Farm Site situated approximately 30km north-east of the Rietkol mining area in the DSR is, with respect irrelevant, and has no bearing on the air environment in the Rietkol study area. It is not clear if that dust emissions were generated by a coal mine or by a silica mine

Dust monitoring points must be installed at the business site of my client and must be regularly monitor.

NOISE

On page 149, paragraph 8.2.8.2.2 the following statement is made, namely *“Mining activities (calculated noise levels) should not change these proposed acceptable rating levels with more than 7 dBA (disturbing noise) and ideally with no more than 3 dBA.”*

“ideally” is only a statement and is not conclusive, and fails to indicate any specifics and realities which noise generated by mining operations and associated activities will have on the environment. According to the above statement the dBa could be as high as 7 dBa. It appears if all of the above statement is purely speculation and has not been properly modelled in a an environmental study.

BLASTING AND GROUND VIBRATION

The Section in the DSR (Section 9.9) concerning blasting and ground vibration is merely a summary in general terms what normally occurs when a mine undertakes blasting operations. It lacks any specifics as to what the environmental effect of blasting and ground vibration will be in the case of this particular mining operation. No blasting and ground vibration modelling has been undertaken to determine the degradation to the environment due to blasting and ground vibration, and the mitigating measures that the mine will implement to prevent such environmental harm.

A Blasting and Ground Vibration Impact Study should be undertaken by an environmental specialist.

SOCIO- ECONOMICAL IMPACT

It is noted on page 214, paragraph 10.1 of the DSR that *“A macro-economic study is aimed at determining the economic and socio-economic indicators and assist in identifying the best alternative land use option.”*

The social and financial impact of the employees of the business should be investigated and in the event that the business has to close down due to the negative impact that the proposed mine would have on the business as explained above.

The financial impact on the business must be investigated as well.

In this regard you are referred to the provisions of Chapter 5, Section 23(2)(b) of the National Environmental Management Act, No. 107 of 1998 (NEMA) which provides that the Applicant must identify, predict and evaluate the actual and potential impact on, inter alia, the socio-economic conditions of the area, in this case, specifically to the business of my client.

It is inadequate, and in contradiction to the provisions of Section 23(2) (b) of NEMA if the proposed study as referred in the DSR, as referred to, and quoted above, is only based on “*a broad level, investigating impacts on overall welfare requires considering the efficiency, equity, and sustainability of the project*” as stated on page 215 of the DSR. The Socio-Economic Impact Report must be conducted at individual businesses, such as that of my client, and cannot be generalised.

CUMULATIVE IMPACT.

It is placed on record that the proposed development of this project together with new coal mines adjacent and nearby to the business that are currently planned will have a cumulative impact on the business operations of my client specifically, and to the flower, roses, chicken, maize and egg producing industry in the region in general. This cumulative impact from an economic, social and environmental perspective should be investigated and included as part of the specialized environmental studies.

The new coal mine projects which will affect, cumulatively with the new proposed silica mine, the environment are: Palmietkuilen, Eloff Mining (Exxaro), and Kangala Colliery Extension (Universal Coal). Information on all these projects is in the public domain and can be researched by the Applicant.

WATER QUALITY AND QUANTITY

We reserve the right to comment on the above subjects once the required Environmental Specialist Study, as part of the Draft EIA, has been submitted to my client for comments in the light of the undertaking on page 219, paragraph 10.3.2, namely that the following

environmental specialist study will be conducted, namely, *“Updating of the groundwater numerical model (pollution plume) and impact assessment based on the preferred layout for the project.”*

The proposed investigation should be amplified to include an investigation and study to determine the effect that water usages at its proposed mine will have on the available water sources for the area, as future water demands is likely to cause a decrease in water availability in the area with the result that my client’s business, and the agricultural activities in the area in general, will suffer loss and damage.





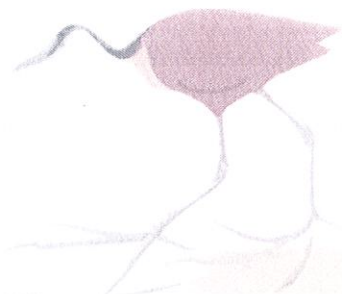

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Kindly note that:

1. As from 8 December 2014, this document serves as the application form, and incorporates the requisite documents that are to be submitted together with the application for the necessary environmental authorisations in terms of the said Acts.
2. This application form is applicable while the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Amendment Act of 2008 is in effect, as the form may require amendment should the Act be further amended.
3. Applicants are required to apply for the necessary water use licence and any other authorisations or licences to the relevant competent authorities as required by the relevant legislation. Upon acceptance of an application for a right or permit in terms of the MPRDA, applicants will be required to provide evidence to the Regional Manager that a noting of intent to apply for a water use licence has been lodged with the Department of Water and Sanitation
4. The Regional Manager will respond to the application and provide the reference and correspondence details of the Competent Authority, and in the event that the application for a right or permit is accepted, together with the date by which the relevant environmental reports must be submitted. Notwithstanding anything that may appear to be stated to the contrary in the acceptance letter, the timeframes are in fact aligned and the prescribed timeframes for the submission of documents as regulated by the NEMA regulations must be strictly adhered to.
5. The application must be typed within the spaces provided in the form. The sizes of the spaces provided are not necessarily indicative of the amount of information to be provided. Spaces are provided in tabular format and will extend automatically when each space is filled with typing.
6. The failure to submit complete information as required in this application form may result in the refusal of the application for an environmental authorisation and consequently of the right or permit applied for.
7. This application must be submitted through the SAMRAD online application system of the Department of Mineral Resources under "Other documents to upload".
8. Unless protected by law, all information filled in on this application form will become public information on receipt by the competent authority. Any interested and affected party should and shall be provided with the information contained in this application on request, during any stage of the application process.
9. Please note that an application fee is payable in terms of the National Environmental Management Act and the National Waste Management Act, which fees must be paid upon lodgement of the application. Should the said application fees not be paid as prescribed the application for a right or permit in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act cannot be considered to have been made in the prescribed manner and the said application for a right or permit will have to be rejected. In this regard the type of applications must be identified in the table below.
