NOTICE OF BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESSES

The development of two separate 100MW solar photovoltaic (PV) facilities and associated infrastructure is proposed on the Remaining Extent of the Farm Bloemhoek 61, located approximately 11km south-east of Aggeneys in the Northern Cape Province. The two solar PV facilities are to be known as Aggeneys 1 and Aggeneys 2, and are situated within the Khâi-Ma Local Municipality, of the greater Namakwa District Municipality.

The project site is located within Zone 8 of the Renewable Energy Development Zones (REDZ) (also known as the Springbok REDZ), and within the Northern Transmission Corridor. The procedure to be followed in applying for environmental authorisation for a large-scale project in a REDZ was formally gazetted on 16 February 2018 (in GN113 and GN114). As Aggeneys 1 and Aggeneys 2 are located within one of the eight REDZ areas, the projects are subject to a Basic Assessment and not a full EIA process, as well as a shortened timeframe of 57 days for the processing of an Application for Environmental Authorisation.

Each PV development will also include a grid connection solution and the required grid connection infrastructure which consists of a collector substation and a single-circuit power line up to 220kV to connect the facility to the national grid – these will be known as Bloemhoek 1 and Bloemhoek 2. The construction of the collector substation and the overhead power line will be assessed as part of two separate Basic Assessment processes, which will consider feasible alternatives for the power line routes.

The assessment of the grid connection infrastructure will be undertaken within a corridor with a width of up to 1.5km and a length of up to 17km. Seven properties may be traversed by the development of Bloemhoek 1 and Bloemhoek 2, and these include:

- » Remaining Extent of the Farm Bloemhoek 61
- » Portion 1 of Bloemhoek 61
- » Portion 2 of Bloemhoek 61
- » Portion 3 of Bloemhoek 61
- » Portion 1 of the Farm Aggeneys 56
- » Portion 2 of the Farm Aggeneys 56
- » Remaining Extent of the Farm Aggeneys 56

Infrastructure associated with each solar PV facility will include:

- » Arrays of PV panels with a contracted capacity of up to 100MW.
- » Mounting structures to support the PV panels.
- » Cabling between the project components, to be laid underground where practical.
- » On-site inverters to convert the power from a direct current (DC) to an alternating current (AC).
- » An on-site substation to facilitate the connection between the solar PV facility and the Eskom electricity grid.
- » Site offices and maintenance buildings, including workshop areas for maintenance and storage.
- » Temporary laydown areas.
- » Internal access roads and fencing around the project site.

A collector substation and an overhead single-circuit power line with a transmission capacity of up to 220kV connecting each facility to the Aggeneis Main Transmission Substation (MTS) is assessed separately.

Each of the solar PV facility projects will be constructed as a separate stand-alone project, with a separate project development company (or Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV)) as the Applicant for each project. The details are:

Site-specific studies and assessments will be undertaken through the BA process in order to delineate areas of potential sensitivity within the broader areas and the identified study area.

It is the Developer's intention to bid each solar PV facility under the Department of Energy's (DoE) Renewable Energy Independent Power Producer Procurement Programme (REIPPPP). The power generated from each solar PV facility is intended to be sold to Eskom and fed into the national electricity grid. The development of the facilities and grid connection infrastructure will also assist with achieving the energy mix as set out in the Integrated Resources Plan (IRP).

BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS

As per the EIA Regulations published in terms of Section 24(5) of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, Act No 107 of 1998), the applicant will require authorisation from the National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) (in consultation with Northern Cape Department

of Environment and Nature Conservation (DENC)) for the undertaking of the projects. Due to the location of the project site within the REDZ and within the northern corridor of the Strategic Transmission Corridors, a Basic Assessment (BA) process is required to be undertaken for the Aggeneys 1, Aggeneys 2, Bloemhoek 1 and Bloemhoek 2 projects in accordance with GN113 and GN114, as formally gazetted on 16 February 2018. An application will be submitted for each project.

The applications are required to be supported by comprehensive, independent environmental studies undertaken in accordance with the EIA Regulations, 2014, as amended.

ABO Wind Aggeneys 1 PV (Pty) Ltd and ABO Wind Aggeneys 2 PV (Pty) Ltd appointed Savannah Environmental, as the independent environmental consultant, to undertake the four Basic Assessments to identify and assess all potential environmental impacts associated with the projects and recommend appropriate mitigation measures in the Environmental Management Programmes (EMPRs). The public participation processes for the projects will be undertaken concurrently, providing the public with an opportunity to understand and comment on all four (4) projects.
