- 1.6 The KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute shall not be liable for any loss, damage or injuries to any person/s or property caused by any of the activities conducted by the applicant;
- 1.7 That any salvageable items not required for re-use in the project must be offered to The Institute and all identified elements must be delivered to the Conservation Materials Bank, Howick, at the Applicant's cost;
- 1.8 That, if <u>archaeological material or human remains</u> are uncovered during excavations, The Institute must be contacted immediately in order to determine the significance of the find and mitigation required (a professional archaeologist may need to be employed).
- 1.9 All archaeological and paleontological Material becomes, on discovery, the property of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal and must be lodged at the repository the KwaZulu-Natal Amafa and Research Institute;
- 1.10 It is the responsibility of the Applicant to ensure that artefacts are preserved in their original state while in his/her possession;
