1 INTRODUCTION

This report outlines the Public Participation Process (PPP) that has and will be followed for the application made by Tumelo Coal Mines (Pty) Ltd, hereinafter referred to as "Tumelo".

Tumelo submitted an application to amend the existing Environmental Authorisation in terms of Regulation 31 of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014 (as amended), also known a Part 2 Amendment, on 11th December 2019. The application relates to a change in mine plan, to include the partial pillar extraction of the #2 seam at the existing underground mine.

The PPP aims to involve the authorities and Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) in the Amendment process; and determine their needs, expectations and perceptions. An open and transparent process was and will be followed at all times and is based on the reciprocal dissemination of information.

The PPP was designed to provide sufficient and accessible information to I&APs in an objective manner to assist them to:

- Raise issues of concern and suggestions for enhanced benefits;
- Contribute local knowledge and experience; and
- Verify that their issues have been captured.

2 PPP UNDERTAKEN TO DATE

2.1 Identification of Authorities

2.1.1 Competent Authority

As per NEMA and its Regulations, the Competent Authority for the Part Two Amendment was identified as the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR).

2.1.2 Regulatory Authorities

Local and Regional authorities were identified from similar projects in the past and included in the I&AP register (**Appendix A**).

The Authorities contacted with regards to this project include:

- Department of Human Settlements, Water and Sanitation;
- Steve Tshwete Local Municipality;
- Nkangala District Municipality;
- Department of Environmental Affairs; and
- Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Land and Environmental Affairs.

2.2 Affected Parties

2.2.1 Land Owners

Landowners of the directly affected properties were identified and included in the I&AP register (see **Appendix A**). Directly affected landowners are summarised in Table 1 overleaf.

2.2.2 Communities

2.2.3 Adjacent Land Owners / Users:

2.3 Notification of Stakeholders

2.3.1 Background Information Documents

Background Information Documents (BIDs) were compiled in English, Zulu and Afrikaans and were distributed via e-mail and post to all the identified stakeholders for whom contact information could be obtained.

Hard Copies were hand delivered on 07 February 2020 to affected parties (land owners and users) where possible. In some cases no one could be located on the property; in such a case the BID was attached to the property gate or left in a post box (when available).

The purpose of the BID was to:

- Invite them to register as an I&AP;
- Inform them of the proposed project changes and associated regulatory processes; and
- Initiate a process of public consultation to record perceptions and issues.

A copy of the BID has been included in **Appendix B** for reference and proof of notification has been included in **Appendix C**.

2.3.2 Advertisements

Advertisements, informing people of the proposed activities and requesting readers to register as I&APs, was placed in one (1) local newspaper (in both English and Zulu):

- Witbank News, publication date 7th February 2020.

The Witbank News circulates 26,000 copies to areas including Arnot, Belfast, Bronkhorstspruit, Groblersdal, Hendrina, Kriel, Loskop, Marble Hall, Middelburg, Ogies, Pullens Hope, Rietspruit, Stoffberg, Van Dyksdrift, Witbank, Phola and Wonderfontein.

2.3.3 Notices / Posters

A2 posters, written in English and Zulu, informing people of the proposed activities and requesting readers to register as I&APs, were placed on the site boundary fence and at other public locations; including:

- Nkangala District Municipality, Middelburg; and
- Pullenshope Public Library, Pullenshope.

1. INLEIDING

Tumelo Steenkoolmyn is 'n bestaande, operasionele myn in die Nkangala Distrik Munisipaliteit en Steve Tshwete plaaslike Munisipaliteit, Mpumalanga. Die myn het 'n goedgekeurde Mynreg (MP30/5/1/2/2/10115MR) en omgewingsbestuursplan (EMPr) in terme van die Wet op die Ontwikkeling van Minerale en Petroleumhulpbronne, Wet 28 van 2002 (MPRDA).

Die goedgekeurde EMPr het die ondergrondse mynbou (bord-en-pilaar) van die steenkool hulpbron in the #2-Steenkoollaag ingesluit. Na verdere beoordeling van die hulpbron, wil Tumelo Coal Mines (Edms) Bpk ("Tumelo") hulle myn plan wysig om die gedeeltelike onttrekking van die oorblywende pilare van die #2-laag in te sluit (hoë-ekstraksie).

Dit behels 'n wysiging van die goedgekeurde EMPr en Myn-Werkprogram en dus moet Tumelo die Minister se toestemming kry kragtens Afdeling 102 van die MPRDA alvorens die wysiging mag plaasvind.

Geen addisionele infrastruktuur gaan met die voorgestelde wysiging gepaard nie, and geen nuwe Gelysde Aktiwiteite in terme van die Nasionale Wet op Omgewingsbestuur, Wet No 107 van 1998 (NEMA), die omgewings impak (EIA) regulasies, 2014 (soos gewysig); en/of die Wet op Nasionale Omgewingsbestuur: Afval, Wet No 59 van 2008 (NEMWA) sal plaasvind nie.

Aangesien die gedeeltelike hoë-ekstraksie van die #2-laag 'n verandering in die omvang en moontlik die aard van omgewings-impakte tot gevolg sal hê, moet die EMPr gewysig word volgens Regulasie 31 van die EIA-Regulasies, 2014 (soos gewysig). 'n "Deel 2" wysigings proses is dus van toepassing op die projek.

Die wysigingsproses sal fokus op die impakte van die hoë-ekstraksie terwyl die gevolge van die huidige en voltooide mynbou aktiwiteite van die #2-laag informatief sal wees rakende die huidige omstandighede van die terrein en kumulatiewe aard van sommige van die potensiële impakte.

'n Aansoek in terme van die Nasionale Water Wet (Wet 36 van 1998) (NWA) sal ook ingedien word om die huidige waterlisensie (IWUL) te hersien en te wysig.

2. OPSOMMING VAN REGSVEREISTES

Om die voorgestelde projekwysigings te implementer, moet Tumelo ingevolge die volgende wetgewing om magtiging aansoek doen:

- Wysiging van die Myn-Werkprogram en EMPr in terme van Afdeling 102 van die MPRDA;
- Deel 2 Wysiging van die omgewings-magtiging in terme van Regulasie 31 van die NEMA EIA Regulasies, 2014 (soos gewysig); en
- Aansoek om die waterlisensie te hersien en te wysig kragtens Afdeling 41 en 52 van die NWA.

3. PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

Cabanga Environmental is aangestel as die onafhanklike omgewingsasseserings-praktisyen (EAP) om 'n EMPr-wysiging proses te onderneem in terme van die voorgestelde projek.

Die ontvangers van hierdie dokument is geïdentifiseer as moontlike belanghebbende en geaffekteerde partye (I&AP). Hierdie dokument (die agtergrond-inligting-dokument of "BID") is saamgestel om I&APs met inligting rakende die voorgestelde projek wysigings en omgewings-magtigings aansoek proses te verskaf

Die leser word hiermee uitgenooi om vrylik deel te neem in die Wysigingsproses en enige vrae of inligting wat u voel tot die proses kan bydra met ons te deel. Alle kommentaar wat ontvang word, sal aangeteken en aangespreek word as deel van die EMPr en IWUL Wysigings Proses.

4. PROJEK BESKRYWING

Tumelo Steenkoolmyn is 'n bestaande, operasionele myn geleë op die plaas Boschmanskop 154 IS, ongeveer 5.5 kilometer suid-suid-oos van die dorp Pullenshope en 15 kilometer noord-wes van die dorp Hendrina. Die myn is in die Steve Tshwete Plaaslike Munisipaliteit van die Nkangala Distrik Munisipaliteit, in die Mpumalanga Provinse van Suid Afrika (Plan 1).

Mynbou van die Nommer 2-laag is onderweg deur middel van ondergrondse bord-en-pilaar metodes met behulp van deurlopende-mynwerkmasjiene.

In gemeganiseerde bord-en-pilaar mynbou is ontginning word ontginning van die hulpbron bereik deur die ontwikkeling van 'n reeks ondergrondse paaie (borde) in die kool-laag. Tussen die "paaie" word pilare agter gelaat as deel van die primêre dak-ondersteunings-siteem.

Steenkool word dan na die oppervlak Vervoer alvorens ertsbreek en sif op die terrein plaasvind. Van hier af word die steenkoolproduk per trok na die mark vervoer.

Aangesien die oorblywende steenkool uitgemyn sal wees teen Desember 2021, wil Tumelo hulle Mynplan wysig om die gedeeltelike pilaar-ontginning (ook genoem "hoë ekstraksie") in te sluit, sodende die myn se lewesduur te verleng (Plan 2).

Die myn sal aanhou om bestaande infrastruktuur te gebruik en geen veranderinge aan die oppervlak-infrastruktuur word beoog nie (Plan 3).

Een-honderd vyf en twintig (125) mense is tans werkzaam by Tumelo Steenkoolmyn. Die voorgestelde projek wysigings sal nie bydra tot werkskepping nie, maar eerder focus op die behoud van bestaande werkgeleenthede deur die lewesduur van die myn te verleng.

Mynreg: MP30/5/1/2/2/10115 MR

Mineraal: Steenkool

Mynbou Metode: Ondergrondse bord-en-pilaar metode, met gedeeltelike pilaar-ontginning met teruggang.

Diepte van die Mineraal: Die gemiddelde diepte van die #2-laag is ongeveer 50 meter onder grondoppervlak.

Produksietempo: 35 000 tot 44,000 RoM ton / maand.

Produk Mark: Plaaslik (Eskom) en uitvoermark.

Myn se lewesduur: Vier (4) jaar (insluitend die pilaar-ontginning).

Terrein Koordinate: 26° 4'16.29"Suid; 29°37'7.96"Oos

Geaffekteerde Eiendom: Gedeelte 10 (Restant), Gedeelte 6, Gedeelte 21 ('n Gedeelte van Gedeelte 6), Gedeelte 14 (Restant), Gedeelte 23 ('n Gedeelte van Gedeelte 14), en Gedeelte 26 ('n Gedeelte van Gedeelte 14) van die plaas Boschmanskop 154 IS.

5. WYSIGINGS AANSOEKE

Tumelo het 'n goedgekeurde Mynreg en EMPragtigings die MPRDA, uitgereik in December 2006 (MP30/5/1/2/2/10115MR).

Die MPRDA en gepaardgaande regulasies is die oorheersende wetgewing rakende die verkryging van regte om Minerale Hulpbronne in Suid Afrika te soek, te ontwikkel en te proseseer. Die MPRDA stel dal Minerale bronne in Suid Afrika aan die land behoort end at die staat die bewaker daarvan is.

Afdeling 102 van die MPRDA bepaal dat die houer van 'n reg nie hul gemagtigde aktiwiteite mag verander sonder die toestemming van die Minister van Minerale Hulpbronne nie. Tumelo moet aansoek doen vir goedkeuring om hulle Mynwerkprogram en EMPR te wysig, soos hierin bespreek.

Die NEMA het op 2 September 2014 die oorheersende omgewings-wetgewing geword, en die "een omgewingsisteem" vir mynbou het ingetree.

Afdeling 12(4) van die NEMA wysigings-wet (Wet 62 van 2008) stel sat 'n EMPR wat goedgekeur is in terme van die MPRDA, alvorens die "een omgewingsisteem" ingetree het, gereken word as goedgekeur in terme van die NEMA.

Dus het Tumelo ook 'n geldige omgewingsmagtiging vir die myn.

Waar 'n omgewingsmagtiging toegestaan is, mag die houer daarvan aansoek doen om die magtiging te wysig. As die wysiging substansiël is, maar nie 'n nuwe gelysde of gespesifieerde aktiwiteit behels nie, moet 'n "Deel 2" wysigings proses gevolg word.

'n "Deel 2" wysigings proses vereis dat 'n verslag saamgestel word en ingedien word by die relevant owerheid. Die verslag moet die volgende inligting bevat:

- 'n Evaluering van alle impakte wat met die voorgestelde wysigings verband hou (omgewings impak verslag);
- Die voor- en nadele van die voorgestelde wysigings;
- Maatreëls om te verseker dat die impakte van die voorgestelde wysiging vermy, bestuur en/of versag sal word; en
- Enige wysigings aan die EMPR;

Die verslag moet blootgestel word aan 'n publieke deelname proses en publieke kommentaar aanspreek. Die relevante owerheid is die Departement van Minerale Hulpbronne (DMR).

6. DOEL VAN DIE EIA/EMP PROSES

Alle suid Afrikaners het 'n grondwetlike reg op 'n omgewing wat nie skadelik is tot ons gesondheid of welstand nie, end at die omgewing beskerm sal word tot voordeel van huidige en toekomstige generasies.

Die EIA-proses is 'n wetlike vereise in terme van NEMA om te verseker dat besoedeling en ekologiese agteruitgang wat deur 'n projekvoorstel veroorsaak kan word, aangespreek en verstaan word alvorens 'n ontwikkeling mag plaasvind. Mits ontwikkelaars moontlike impakte van 'n ontwikkeling verstaan, is hulle in staat om maatreëls in plek te sit om impakte te voorkom, of om die impakte te verminder. Die benadering word gevvolg in die belang van die versekering van ekologies volhoubare ontwikkeling en gebruik van natuurlike hulpbronne, terwyl ekonomiese en sosiale ontwikkeling bevorder word, in ooreenstemming met die Grondwet.

7. WATER GERUIK LISENSIE AANSOEK

Die Department van Water en Sanitasie (DWS) het Tumelo se geïntegreerde water gebruik lisensie (IWUL) uitgereik op 1 Oktober 2010 in terme van die NWA. Die Licensie is aangepas op 4 September 2017. Die Licensie is geldig vir tien (10) jaar en verval op 1 Oktober 2020.

'n Licensiehouer mag, voordat die licensie verval, aansoek aan die relevante owerheid doen om die licensie te hernu en/of aan te pas.

Aangesien die voorgestelde projek wysigings kan lei tot addisionele water gebruik en/of veranderinge in die waterbalans, sal 'n aansoek om wysiging van die IWUL gemaak word. Kragtens Afdeling 52 van die NWA, behalwe as wysigings vir regstellings is, moet die wysigingsproses behandel word volgens die procedures beskryf in Afdeling 41 (Aansoek vir Licensie).

Die relevante aansoek prosesse is op die volgende bladsy geïllustreer.

8. MOONTLIKE OMGEWINGSIMPAKTE EN SPESIALIS STUDIES

Geen nuwe oppervlak-infrastruktuur gaan met die voorgestelde projek gepaard nie en dus is die moontlike impakte slegs verwag om geassosieer te wees met grondwater vloei en die moontlikheid van oppervlak insakking.

Die volgende spesialisstudies is geïdentifiseer:

- Grondwater;
- Oppervlakwater hidrologie;
- Varswater Ekologies (en vleiland afbakening); en
- Lug Kwaliteit Impak Studie.

9. PUBLIEKE DEELNAME PROSES

Die betrokkenheid van die publiek is 'n noodsaklike deel van die EIA proses. Dit addresseer die regte van I&APs om ingelig te word oor die voorgestelde ontwikkeling en om betrokke te wees by besluite wat hul kan affekteer. Dit bied ook die EAP geleentheid om I&AP kwessies en bekommernisse aan te spreek sodende al die moontlike impakte van 'n voorgestelde projek te assesseer.

As 'n geregistreerde I&AP sal u op hoogte gehou word rakende die wysiging- en IWUL aansoekproses. U sal uitgenooi word na Opedag vergaderings en ook geleentheid gebied word om verslae rakende die projek te hersien. Verder sal alle kommentaar wat vanaf geregistreerde I&APs ontvang word deurgans geaddresseer word en ingesluit word by die verslae.

HOE OM TE REGISTREER

Registreer asseblief as 'n I&AP om inligting rakende die beskikbaarheid van dokumente vir openbare hersiening en die besonderhede (plek, datum en tyd) van die Opedag vergadering te ontvang.







1. INTRODUCTION

Tumelo Colliery is an existing, operational mine located within the Nkangala District Municipality and Steve Tshwete Local Municipality, Mpumalanga. The Mine has an approved Mining Right (MP30/5/1/2/2/10115MR) and Environmental Management Programme report (EMPr) in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, Act 28 of 2002 (MPRDA).

The approved EMPr addressed the underground mining (bord-and-pillar) of the reserves associated with the #2 Seam. Upon further assessment of the resource, Tumelo Coal Mines (Pty) Ltd ("Tumelo") now wish to amend the mine plan to include the partial pillar extraction of the #2 Seam (stooping).

This constitutes a change in the approved EMPr and Mine Work Programme and Tumelo therefore has to obtain the Minister's consent in terms of Section 102 of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, Act No. 28 of 2002 (MPRDA) prior to effecting the change.

No additional infrastructure is associated with the proposed project change; and thus no new Listed Activities in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, Act No. 107 of 1998 (NEMA); the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014 (as amended); and/or the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, Act No 59 of 2008 (NEMWA) will be triggered.

However, as the partial pillar extraction of the #2 Seam will result in a change of Scope and possibly the nature of the environmental impacts, the EMPr will need to be amended as per Regulation 31 of the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended). A Part 2 Amendment Process is therefore relevant to the project.

The Amendment Process will focus on the impacts associated with the pillar extraction, while the impacts from the current and past mining activities of the #2 Seam will be informative of the baseline conditions of the site and the cumulative nature of some of the potential impacts.

An application will also be made in terms of the National Water Act, Act 36 of 1998 (NWA) to review and amend the existing Integrated Water Use License (IWUL).

2. SUMMARY OF LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

To implement the proposed project changes, Tumelo is required to apply for authorisation in terms of the following legislation:

- Amendment of the Mine Works Programme and EMPr in terms of Section 102 of the MPRDA;
- Part 2 Amendment of the Environmental Authorisation in term of Regulation 31 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended); and
- An application to review and Amend the Water Use License in terms of Sections 41 and 52 of the NWA.

3. PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

Cabanga Environmental has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to undertake an Environmental Management Plan report (EMPr) Amendment in terms of the proposed Project.

The Recipients of this document have been identified as potential Interested and Affected Parties (I&AP). This document (the Background Information Document or "BID") has been compiled to provide I&APs with information on the proposed project changes and the environmental application processes.

4. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Tumelo Colliery is an existing, operational mine located on the Farm Boschmanskop 154 IS, approximately 5.5 kilometres south-south-east of the town of Pullenshoek and 15 kilometres north-west of the town of Hendrina. The site falls within the Steve Tshwete Local Municipality of the Nkangala District Municipality, in the Mpumalanga Province of South Africa (Plan 1).

Mining of the No. 2 Seam is currently underway by means of underground bord-and-pillar methods, using continuous miners. In mechanized bord-and-pillar mining, extraction is achieved by developing a series of roadways (bords) in the coal seam and connecting them by splits (cut-through) to form pillars. These pillars are left behind as part of a primary roof support system.

Coal is then conveyed to surface before being crushed and screened on site, from here the coal is trucked to market.

As the remaining reserves will be depleted in December 2021, Tumelo wishes to amend their mine plan to include the partial pillar extraction (also known as stooping) so as to extend the remaining life of mine (Plan 2).

Existing infrastructure will continue to be utilised, and no changes to the surface infrastructure is anticipated (Plan 3).

Currently one hundred and twenty five (125) people are employed at Tumelo Colliery. The proposed project changes will not contribute to job creation but rather focus on the retention of jobs by prolonging the remaining life of mine.

Mining Right: MP30/5/1/2/2/10115 MR

Mineral: Coal

Mining Method: Underground bord-and-pillar method, with partial pillar extraction on retreat.

Depth of Mineral: The average depth of the 2 Seam is approximately 50 metres below surface.

Production Rate: 35 000 to 44,000 RoM tons / month.

Product Market: Domestic (Eskom) and export.

Life of Mine (LoM): Four (4) years (including pillar extraction).

Site Co-ordinates: 26° 4'16.29"S; 29°37'7.96"E

Affected Properties: Portion 10 (RE), Portion 6, Portion 21 (a Portion of Portion 6), Portion 14 (RE), Portion 23 (a Portion of Portion 14), and Portion 26 (a Portion of Portion 14) of the Farm Boschmanskop 154 IS.

5. AMENDMENT APPLICATIONS

Tumelo has an approved Mining Right and EMPr in terms of the MPRDA (MP30/5/1/2/2/10115MR), issued in December 2006.

The MPRDA and its Regulations is the predominant legislation dealing with the acquisition of rights to search for, extract and process mineral resources in South Africa. The MPRDA holds that mineral resources in South Africa belong to the nation and that the State is the custodian thereof.

Section 102 of the MPRDA states that the Holder of a Right may not change their authorised activities without the consent of the Minister of Mineral Resources. Tumelo has to apply for consent to amend their Mine Works Programme and EMPr as discussed herein.

On the 2nd September 2014 the NEMA became the overarching environmental legislation and the One Environmental System for mining came into effect.

Section 12 (4) of the NEMA Amendment Act, Act 62 of 2008, states that an EMPr approved in terms of the MPRDA, prior to the One Environmental System coming into effect, is regarded as having been approved in terms of NEMA.

As such, Tumelo is deemed to have a valid Environmental Authorisation for its mining operations.

Where an Environmental Authorisation has been issued an Applicant may apply to have this amended. If the Amendment is considered substantive, but does not constitute a Listed or Specified Activity, a Part 2 Amendment process must be followed.

A Part 2 Amendment process requires that a report be compiled and submitted to the Competent Authority reflecting: -

- An assessment of all impacts related to the proposed changes (EIA);
- Advantages and disadvantages associated with the proposed changes;
- Measures to ensure avoidance, management and mitigation of impacts associated with such proposed change; and
- any changes to the EMPr;

which report has been subjected to a public participation process and reflects the incorporation of comments received.

The Competent Authority is the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR).

6. PURPOSE OF THE EIA/EMP PROCESS

All South African's have a Constitutional Right to an Environment that is not harmful to our health or well-being and to have the environment protected for the benefit of present and future generations.

The EIA process is a legal requirement in terms of NEMA, to ensure that pollution and ecological degradation that may be caused by a development proposal are assessed and understood prior to a development taking place. Understanding potential impacts enables developers to implement appropriate measures to avoid or reduce environmental impacts associated with a proposed development. Such an approach is followed in the interest of ensuring ecologically sustainable development and use of natural resources, while promoting justifiable economic and social development, in line with the Constitution.

7. WATER USE LICENSE APPLICATION

Tumelo was issued with an Integrated Water Use License (IWUL) (Licence No.24090831) by the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) on 1 October 2010, in terms of the NWA. This was subsequently amended on 4 September 2017. The IWUL was issued for a period of ten (10) years, expiring on 1 October 2020.

A licensee may, before the expiry date of a licence, apply to the responsible authority for the renewal or amendment of the licence.

As the proposed project changes may result in additional water uses and/or a changes to the water balance an application to Amend the IWUL will be made. In accordance with Section 52 of the NWA, unless an Amendment of an IWUL is for minor corrections, it must be dealt with as per the procedures set out in Section 41 (Application for License).

The relevant application processes are illustrated overleaf.

8. POTENTIAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS AND SPECIALIST ASSESSMENTS

No new surface infrastructure is associated with the proposed project changes and thus impacts are expected to be limited to those associated with groundwater flow and the potential for surface subsidence.

The following Specialist Studies have been identified:

- Groundwater;
- Surface water hydrology;
- Freshwater Ecology (incl. Wetland Delineation); and
- Air Quality Impact Assessment.

9. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

Public involvement is an essential component of the EIA process. It addresses the right of I&APs to be informed of the proposed developments and to be involved in decisions that may affect them. It also affords the EAP an opportunity to assess and address the issues and concerns raised by I&APs thus allowing the EAP to assess all the potential impacts of the proposed project.

As a Registered I&AP you will be kept informed of the Amendment and IWUL application process, invited to Open Day meetings and review draft reports compiled in terms of the abovementioned applications. Furthermore, all comments that registered I&APs submit in terms of the Application(s) will be included in the relevant reports, and addressed throughout the process.






Figure 1: Summary of Application Process (Green indicates the current status of the relevant applications)





Figure 1: Isifushaniso Senqubo Yesicelo (Okuluhlaza satshani kubonisa isimo samanje sezicelo ezifanele)



- Portion 41 of the farm Boschmanskop 154 IS R/E Ptn 10, 6, Ptn 21 (Ptn of Ptn 6), R/E Ptn 14, Ptn 23 (Ptn of Ptn 14) and Ptn 26

We refer to the land claim enquiry on the **18 February 2020** on land claims lodged with the Department.

Note that the lodgement of land claim is based on the Restitution of Land Rights Act, Act no 22 of 1994 and the Restitution of Land Rights Amendment Act, (Act not 15 of 2014).

Please note that there are no land claims lodged before 1998 re-lodgement period, however there are new claims lodged. The Commission is empowered to investigate all land claims and where applicable issues a Government Gazette to interested and affected parties if such land claims has been approved as valid claims.

The above claim was lodged in terms of the Restitution of Land Rights Amendment Act, 2014 (Act No 15 of 2014) ("the Amendment Act") which, amongst others, reopened the lodgement of claims for a period of five years.



The validity of the Amendment Act was challenged in the Constitutional Court. The Constitutional Court found the Amendment Act to be invalid because of the failure of Parliament to facilitate public involvement as required by the Constitution. The Amendment Act ceased to be law on 28 July 2016 and the Commission is no longer allowed to accept lodgement of new claims from that date.

The Constitutional Court ordered that the claims that were lodged between 1 July 2014 and 27 July 2016 are validly lodged, but it interdicted the Commission from processing those claims until the Commission has finalised the claims lodged by 31 December 1998 or until Parliament passes a new law providing for the re-opening of lodgement of land claims. Parliament was given until 27 July 2018 to pass such a law.

The Commission will therefore not be processing these new claims until it finishes claims lodged by 31 December 1998 or until Parliament passes a new law providing for re-opening of lodgement of claims.

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
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
