

This project is in the province of the Eastern Cape and in the district municipalities of OR TAMBO and ALFRED NZO.

Preferences are offered to prospective tenderers from the targeted area, namely the Alfred Nzo and OR Tambo District Municipalities and the Ingquza Hill Local Municipality, as well possession of a Mining Permit and Parent Rock Results for each sub-contract package. This tender will be evaluated in terms of functionality as a criterion and the price and preference points system. Tenderers who satisfy the following criteria are eligible to submit tenders:

- Valid B-BBEE Certification.
- Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME) or Qualifying Small Enterprise (QSE).
- Registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database (CSD).
- Mining Permit and Parent Rock Results

- Compliant with the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act (COID); and
- Tax Compliant.
