Khayelitsha tavern owners set for GBV dialogue

TAVERN owners in Khayelitsha are set to meet to discuss how they can contribute to ending the scourge of GBV. The Liquor Traders Association, Distell and Police Minister Bheki Cele held a dialogue with residents yesterday on the role men needed to play in ending violence against women. Local businessman Simo Vananda said traders would meet and discuss ways of educating their consumers about GBV. "Such events which deal with the abuse of women and children are very important and it includes the whole community. "Most of the time women are being abused by drunk people and that is where we come in as traders, because this affects us too.

"As traders we need to work together with anti-GBV NGOs and also with the government. Our role is to engage our customers and we need to have strict rules and regulations and also abide by the rules of the Liquor Board. Our customers need to be educated about the responsibilities and how to behave when or after consuming alcohol," said Vananda. Liquor Traders Association spokesperson Lucky Mtshane urged residents, local traders and SAPS to work closely together. "We will keep fighting to make sure that they are part of the conversations so that we can be able to make difference in our society," said Mtshane. Cele said: "We have met the leadership of the alcohol industry and there are a few things that we believe can be done rather than spending time fighting.

"One thing that we call for is the proper education on how to use alcohol socially. Tavern owners should use at least 30 minutes of their time to educate people and tell them about the danger of illegal weapons at taverns. "Women are human beings and they too have human rights. This thing of men thinking that it is their responsibility to protect women must come to an end. "(This is) because once you think that you need to protect her, you end up regarding her as your pet; and women are not pets. Women need to be allowed to grow and fly high and most of them fly high better than men when it comes to leadership. "Women are not commodities. Men should stop the mentality of thinking that because you bought her something to drink, she must go and sleep with you," said Cele.

Two more join city's 'most wanted' man

TWO more people have been included in cases involving the Western Cape's most wanted man, Yanga "Bara" Nyalara. Nyalara returned to the Cape Town Magistrate's Court yesterday, this time along with co-accused Wandile Tofile. Initially Nyalara was charged alone with 12 counts of murder, four counts of attempted murder, a count of illegal possession of a firearm and illegal possession of ammunition. The State alleged Nyalara and Tofile went on a shooting spree in May 2021 in Site B, Khayelitsha. The court heard that Tofile was also abandoning his bail bid. National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) spokesperson Eric Ntabazalila said: "Nyalara and Tofile are also charged under the Prevention of Organised Crime Act (Poca), as they were prominent members of a gang that engaged in a range of criminal activities which include extortion of informal businesses around Khayelitsha and committing violent criminal acts, by instilling fear among the owners of the informal businesses to induce them to pay money to the gang. "They also eliminated competing gangs who are also engaging in extortion in the area." Their case was postponed until October 4. State advocate Mervyn Menigo said the investigation was extensive, comprising forensic reports, fingerprint

comparison, cellphone analysis, drug analysis and ballistic reports. Then the court heard there was another co-accused, Manelisi Ngumla, who later also appeared in relation to some of the charges. Nyalara and Ngumla are charged with attempted murder and six counts of murder that happened this year on May 8 in Site C, Khayelitsha. Ntabazalila said the two were also charged with illegal possession of firearms and illegal possession of ammunition and dealing in drugs. Nyalara's family, joined by some Khayelitsha residents, yesterday staged a protest outside the court calling for him to be released, claiming he was "innocent and crime is out of control now that he has been unlawfully arrested."

EDUCATION

Cops watch as teaching resumes at volatile Heathfield High School

WHILE teaching has resumed at Heathfield High School, it has not returned to normal as law enforcement continues to keep watch following volatile disruptions. The school has also halted the traditional attendance model and reintroduced the rotational system, which is expected to be in place for about two weeks with the exception of matrics.

Teaching and learning had to be suspended on Wednesday following alarming scenes on Tuesday when pupils who disrupted classes allegedly stoned law enforcement vehicles. The officers conducted searches which the pupils were unhappy about, with illegal substances and weapons allegedly confiscated. The school has been unstable after former principal Wesley Neumann was dismissed by the Western Cape Education Department (WCED) in May.

This resulted from his refusal to reopen the school amid the Covid-19 infection peak in 2020. According to Education MEC David Maynier grades 9, 11 and 12 returned to class without incident yesterday. "The safety of our learners and staff at school is a priority, and teaching and learning must be allowed to continue without disruption. "Parents at the school are rightfully concerned about the situation and want their children to be able to learn

in a peaceful, safe environment, which is why all stakeholders are working together to stabilise the situation at the school, and ensure that discipline and order are instilled. We appeal to parents to play their role in ensuring that their children take their education and safety seriously, and that they do not engage in the disruption we saw earlier this week." The South African Human Rights Education Commission's education commissioner André Gaum said:

"People can voice their grievances in a peaceful manner. The right to protest cannot be exercised by violating the right to basic education of other learners or threatening the safety of other people. The commissioner is very concerned about the quality of education that might be impacted and the loss of teaching time because learners have already been impacted by Covid-19 learning disruptions. The department needs to take all necessary steps to urgently resolve this."

Mixed response to mayor's metro cop idea

CAPE Flats activists have rejected Cape Town Mayor Geordin Hill-Lewis' formal request for metro officers to have full crime-fighting powers, saying "City police treat our people like the dirt under their soles."

During a full Council meeting yesterday, Hill-Lewis confirmed he submitted the request to Police Minister Bheki Cele, saying the Municipality wanted its metro force to have more powers. "This problem is compounded by the current shortage of more than 500 SAPS detectives in the province... Minister Cele has previously said that he cannot devolve power in the absence of a constitutional amendment. "This is nonsense. Section 99 of the Constitution provides that 'a Cabinet member may assign any power or function...to a Municipal Council'," said Hill-Lewis. However, with more than 15 years experience in advocating for peace and justice on the Cape Flats, Manenberg Safety Forum founder Roegshanda Pascoe disagreed with the request. "Under different circumstances I would have really complimented the mayor. I will draw reference to an incident where Kashief Jacobus was beaten to death by Metro Police in Manenberg. Until today, there is no justice for his death. In the crime-related case that I testified in, the special operative team of the City came around the corner while a victim was brutally beaten and stabbed. What they did was reverse out of the road where they could have saved the victim's life that day. These are things that I have experienced. "Both parties are deeply rooted with corruption. Both parties are not people-centred but politically-driven, wanting to score points, but it's not for the people on the Cape Flats who live in the violence 24/7 every day of our lives. City police treat our people like the dirt under their soles. They also swear at and mistreat our people. This while Saps officers watch dead buildings which parliament more than the people in communities who really need their service," said Pascoe. Regional co-ordinator for the United Public Safety Front, Imraahn Mukaddam, said: "What the mayor should be doing is insisting on the capacitation of SAPS and continue to offer a supportive role in combating crime through joint operations between SAPS, Law Enforcement and Metro Police. What the mayor should be focussing on is the hotspots where crime is being perpetrated, such as illegal shebeens, City rental stock being used as gang bases and drug houses. Furthermore, the City must ensure that there are adequate amenities for youth to partake in alternative activities instead of crime." Non-profit company, Action Society's director for Community Safety, Ian Cameron, voiced his support for the request by Hill-Lewis. "Detectives in poorer communities are completely overworked and under-resourced. And on top of that they have no capacity to combat organised crime," said Cameron.
