On 22 September 2015 Samancor Chrome submitted an application to the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) for a mining right on portions 0, 1 and 2 of the farm Varkensvlei 403 KQ. In terms of the new EIA Regulations GN R.982/983/984/985 that commenced on 8 December 2014, an application for a mining right triggers an application for environmental authorisation, which must be supported by a scoping and impact assessment process and which must also be submitted to the DMR. In terms of changes in the legislation on waste management (GN R.632/633) that commenced on 24 July 2015, Samancor Chrome will also apply for a waste and water management licence.

Samancor Chrome will be undertaking several listed activities applicable to the proposed project that require environmental authorisation via the EIA process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended and the EIA Regulations. In terms of the recent changes in legislation, the DMR is the competent authority for the consideration of the applications for a mining right, environmental authorisation and a waste management licence.
