

apologies, i have just found your correspondence in spam folder.

Thanks for the information you have provided here. It does not sound like there will be issues with the survey equipment itself or any radio communication as you have indicated that the bands falls outside the regulated bands.

A little concern is with the unintentional electromagnetic emissions from the equipment itself, the CISPR value normally given in dBuV/m. In our previous assessment this has shown that it will be a high risk to the SKA at certain lower survey heights and even bigger risk to MeerKAT at higher survey levels.

If you are seeking a formal response from SARAO, please submit a formal letter requesting risk assessment, this should included a brief description of the project, time schedule as well as planned survey heights. Because you have not submitted the EMI limits of your equipment, I will use the worst case CISPR values. Then we will provide the feedback with priority.

It is understood that all electrical an electromagnetic (EM) geophysical techniques that will be employed for mineral exploration fall well below the frequencies stated in the Regulations on the Protection of the Karoo Central Astronomy Advantage Areas in Terms of the Astronomy Geographic Advantage Act (Act No. 21 of 2007). Higher frequencies don't penetrate the earth and is not used in EM induction or electrical techniques.

For time-domain EM the proposal is to inject current in a transmitter loop (either in the air or on the ground). The current will then be switched off and the secondary EM fields induced in the nearby subsurface will be measured. These fields can take up to 1 second to decay. Attempts are made to switch the current off quickly to generate higher frequency content to image the near surface well. The highest frequencies, however, are well below the MHz Range, as detailed above.

For electrical techniques it is propped to effectively transmit a DC current between 2 electrodes. The corresponding voltage deference measured with electrodes at the surface of the earth is then used to calculate an apparent resistivity of the subsurface.

In the Induced polarisation method the DC current is switched off. The presence of polarisable and conductive material is mapped if the current doesn't directly decay to zero.

In the Magnetotelluric method, measurements of the passive (natural) EM fields generated by telluric and lightning activity are made. Occasionally a source / transmitter is used, but typically transmit below 1 kHz.

REQUEST FOR A RISK ASSESSMENT FOR PLANNED EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE KAROO CENTRAL ASTRONOMY ADVANTAGE AREAS




FIGURE 1. MAP OF PROSPECTING RIGHTS APPLICATION IN RELATION THE KAROO CENTRAL ASTRONOMY ADVANTAGE AREAS.

Black Mountain Mining (Pty) Ltd is currently applying for a number of prospecting rights (PR) located between the towns of Kenhardt in the East and Springbok in the West (Figure 1). A number of exploration activities are proposed for the duration of the PR validity. These would include:

- 1. **Airborne Geophysical Surveys**, utilising either a fixed-wing or helicopter-borne time-domain electromagnetic system. Systems under consideration are: Geotech's VTEMMax, Spectrem's SpectremPlus and Skytem's SkyTEM312HP
- 2. **Ground Based Geophysical Surveys**. Active techniques could include Time-Domain Electromagnetics, Resistivity / Induced Polarisation and Controlled-Source Audio Magnetotellurics.
- 3. **Drilling** and;
- 4. Communication

Below is a general description of each of the proposed geophysical techniques.

## **Time-domain Electromagnetics**

In time-domain EM a current pulse is injected in a loop (either in the air or on the ground). The current is then switched off and the secondary EM fields induced in the nearby subsurface measured. These fields can take up to 1 second to decay. Attempts are made to switch the current off quickly to generate higher frequency content to image the near surface well. The highest frequencies, however, are well below the MHz Range.

### **Resistivity and Induced Polarisation (IP)**

In resistivity surveys a direct current flows between 2 electrodes in the ground. The corresponding voltage difference, measured with electrodes at the surface of the earth, is then used to calculate an apparent resistivity of the subsurface.

In the Induced polarisation method the DC is switched off. The presence of polarisable and conductive material is mapped if the current doesn't instantly decay to zero.

## **Controlled-Source Audio Magnetotellurics**

In the Magnetotelluric method, measurements of the passive (natural) EM fields generated by telluric and lightning activity are made. Occasionally a source / transmitter is used, that typically transmit below 1 kHz.

## **Request for assessment**

In terms of our planned activities, permission is requested to proceed with the following:

## 1. Airborne Geophysical Surveys

It is planned to fly the airborne time-domain electromagnetic surveys during 2020/2021. Sortie times will be between 5:00 am in the morning and 19:00pm in the evenings. We can provide firm survey schedules once the PR's have been executed and survey contracts finalised. The chosen airborne contractor will obtain the necessary CAA approvals and can make daily detailed flight plans available.

It is our understanding that, in terms of the Astronomy Geographic Advantage Act of 2007 (Act No. 21 of 2007, Schedule D, 3(5)), all electrical installations < 100 kVA are exempt from requiring a permit and that the only concern would be unintended electromagnetic emissions from these electrical installation.

# 2. Ground based Geophysical Surveys

The ground geophysical surveys will mainly consist of time-domain electrometric surveys but could be supplemented with resistivity / IP and magnetotelluric surveys. The surveys will commence in 2020 and continue throughout the PR validity over the next 5 years, as surveys are often conducted in conjunction with exploration drilling.
