### Mr Hendrik Nicolaas Schrijvershof

Mr Schrijvershof confirmed that they farm with sheep and that there was a house, 2 stores, 3 boreholes, livestock watering and electrical fences on the property. He mentioned that there were graves from an old tribal conflict that may be on historical value. he provided a letter detailing the receiving environment and raised concern regarding the groundwater, pollution, and removal of vegetation. He mentioned that he was not in favour of disturbance due to the long time it takes for the veld to recover. He mentioned the clean air and was concerned regarding crime. He did not have a problem with mining in principle, but could not allow his farm to be negatively affected by mining after working so hard for it. Especially given his past experieneces with mining Manganese. He stated that they should first fly with the aeroplanes and then buy him out.

EIMS confirmed that the majority of the prospecting will be done with non-invasive methods and only then will there be more invasive drilling done once these areas have been identified. It was mentioned that the EMPR would contain conditions to ensure protection of the environment from pollution and dust and that landowner agreements and access arrangement would have to be made prior to commencing.

Weiding in die Boesmanland moet baie goed bestuur word, want daar is nie om mee te dobbel nie. Versteuring en oorbeweiding kom op dieselfde neer. Daar is net eenvoudig sekere plant spesies wat nooit weer terugkom nie. Net suurgras, wat geen voedingsware het nie. My plaas het gemengde veld, gras en harde veld met baie gannabos in, wat ek nie graag versteur wil hê nie.

Die Boesmanland is seker een van die plekke in ons land met die skoonste lug. Dit is ook een van die plekke waar jy rus vir jou siel kry. Geen geraas, net jy en die natuur. Dit is waar jy baie naby aan jou skepper leure. 'n Lekker ontvlugting, maar 'n harde wêreld.

Ons plase in die omgewing is almal binneplase, geen toegang vir niemand. Net die eienaars wat daar boer. Alle plase in my omgewing is gesluit. Die serwetietpad stop by my. Dus is daar geen deurgang en geen diefstal. Ons wil dit baie graag so hou. Die punt wat ek wil maak is dat as daar kontrakteurs op die perseel is, die diefstal sal begin. Ons weet almal hoe werk wat.

Ek het in beginsel geen probleem met mynbou nie. Ek kan ongelukkig nie toelaat dat my plaas waarvoor ek so hard gewerk het en soveel geld spandeer het, omgedolwe word en verniel word en dan aan my terug besorg word nie.

Ek praat van ondervinding. EK het op my vorige plaas ook Mangaan laat myn. Hulle sou die plek weer rehabiliteer, wat nooit gebeur het nie. Dit sal nie weer gebeur nie.

Met vandag se tegnologie is daar baie gesofistikeerde toerusting wat kan optel watter grondstowwe daar is. So maak seker dat julle weet waarna julle soek met die vliegtuig en toerusting.
