

Breedvoerig sal dit behels dat die maatskappy 'n kombinasie van nie-indringende en indringende prospekterings tegnieke gebruik om onderliggende gesteentes te identifiseer, soos aangedui in die aangehegte Agtergrond Inligtingsdokument. Die aansoek sal 'n gefasseerde benadering volg, en die projek sal verdeel word in verskeie opeenvolgende fases. Die verskillende fases en tydskedules van die voorgestelde prospekteerreg sal, volgens aard, afhanklik wees van die resultate wat tydens die voorafgaande fase ingesamel is. Die voorgestelde indringende prospektering sal verder 'n baie klein oppervlakte opneem – 0.3 hektaar – wat oor 10 boorgat areas versprei sal word binne die 9234 hektaar aansoek area.

EIMS het verder ook as deel van ons impak studie sensitiewe areas geïdentifiseer en voorgestel dat sensitiewe areas vermy word sover moontlik vir die indringende prospektering. Ons verslag het oor die impakte van sal ook 'n lug-, grond-, water- en geraasbesoedeling, asook die grondgebruik en toerisme in ag geneem en gevind dat die impakte tipies gering en plaaslik van aard is. Ons verslag het verder streng maatreëls in plek gestel wat beskryf hoe die aktiwiteite uitgevoer moet word om die omgewing te beskerm ten alle tye, insluitend vir rehabilitasie na die prospektering afgehandel is. Ons wil verder ook daarop wys dat sou daar lewensvatbare minerale hulpbronne geïdentifiseer word as deel van hierdie projek, sal Black Mountain Mining eers 'n verdere en baie meer gedetailleerde aansoek om 'n Mynreg moet doen, wat 'n volle omgewings impak assessering sal moet insluit, en weer aan die publiek sal geleentheid gee om deel te vorm van die proses.
