LOCAL artists Viwe "Brikzit" Mabodla, Luthando "T-doz" Siketo and Mzomhle Ngada will perform at the second annual GKM DJ Festival in Kokstad on October 28.

The festival will start with a pre-party at Colors Café on October 27, followed by the main event at the Oval Cricket Grounds on October 28 and the Sunday Chill event at Kweenoa Lounge & Grill on October 29.

The festival will promote local and national musicians and to grow the economy of Kokstad.

Speaking to *Fever*, Mabodla said he is happy to be chosen to perform at the pre-party and said his new tracks – *Sugar*, *Albany* and *Khakhi* – are

his repertoire.

"Rehearsals are under way for the event and I thank organisers who selected me to perform there," said Mabodla.

Siketo has prepared three tracks, *Turn-it-up*, *Move* and *Brazo* for the pre-party. DJ Ngada will also play.

### NOTICE OF A BASIC ASSESSMENT PROCESS FOR THE PROPOSED DECOMMISSIONING (CLOSURE) OF THE UMZIMKHULU LANDFILL, UMZIMKHULU LOCAL MUNICIPALITY, KWAZULU NATAL PROVINCE

Notice is hereby given in terms of Chapter 5 of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) and Waste Management Activities listed in terms of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (NEM:WA) (Act No. 59 of 2008) as amended, that the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) is assisting the uMzimkhulu Local Municipality to apply for a Decommissioning Licence for the existing uMzimkhulu landfill. DEA has appointed GA Environment (Pty) Ltd as independent Environmental Consultants, to undertake the Basic Assessment and Waste Management Licence Application for the landfill.

The uMzimkhulu landfill occupies an area of approximately 43 000m<sup>2</sup> (±4 Ha) and is located on Erf 152 uMzimkhulu within the jurisdiction of uMzimkhulu Local Municipality and Harry Gwala District Municipality. The landfill is approximately 5km west of the uMzimkhulu CBD. Direct access to the site can be gained from the P601 Road to Franklin. The site centre coordinates are 30°15'44.90"S; 29° 54' 17.00"E.

According to the NEM: WA, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008) as amended, the decommissioning of a landfill requires a Waste Management License as per Category A (Activity No. 14) of Government Notice 921 of 2013, and a Basic Assessment process, as stipulated in the NEMA EIA Regulations (2014) as amended, made under section 24(5) and 44 of the NEMA, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) as amended.

In terms of the NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, as amended all Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) must be provided with an opportunity to participate in the Basic Assessment process for the uMzimkhulu Landfill.
