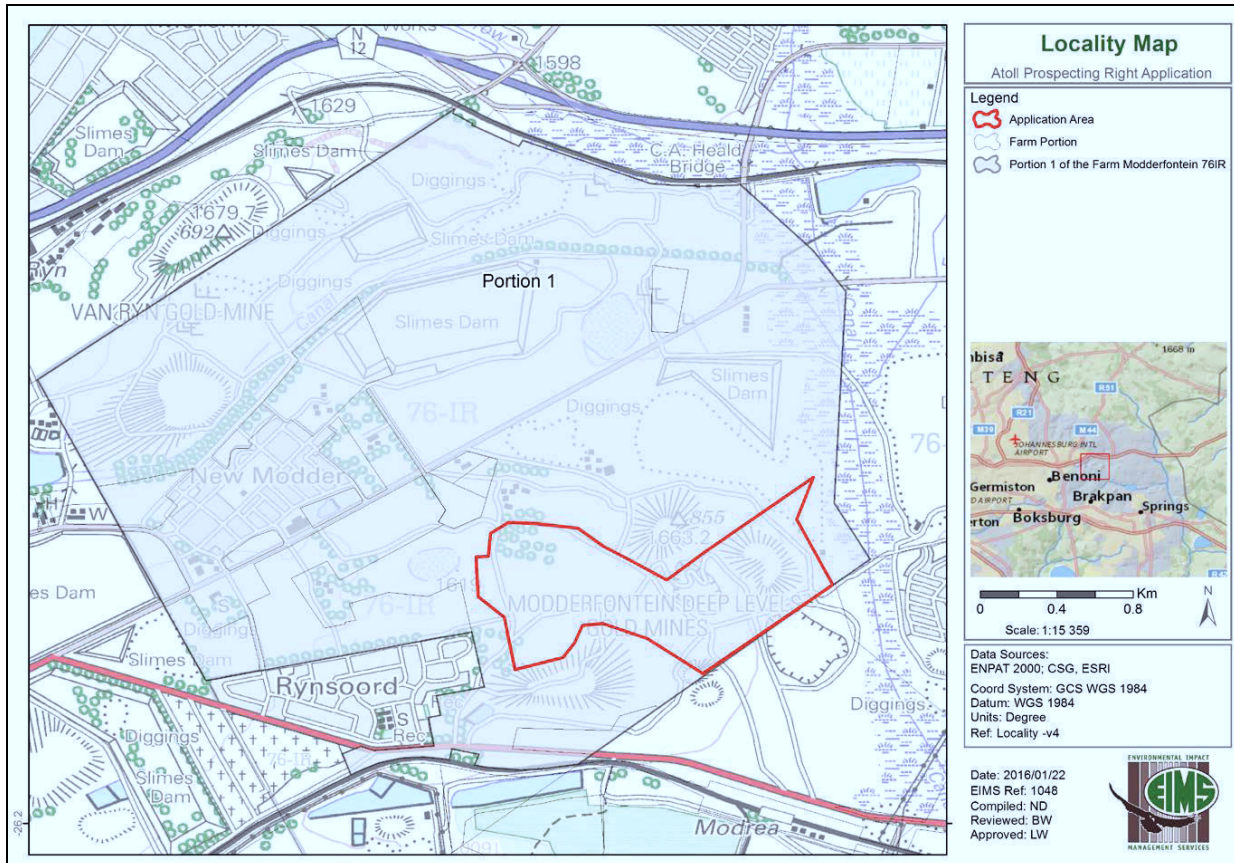

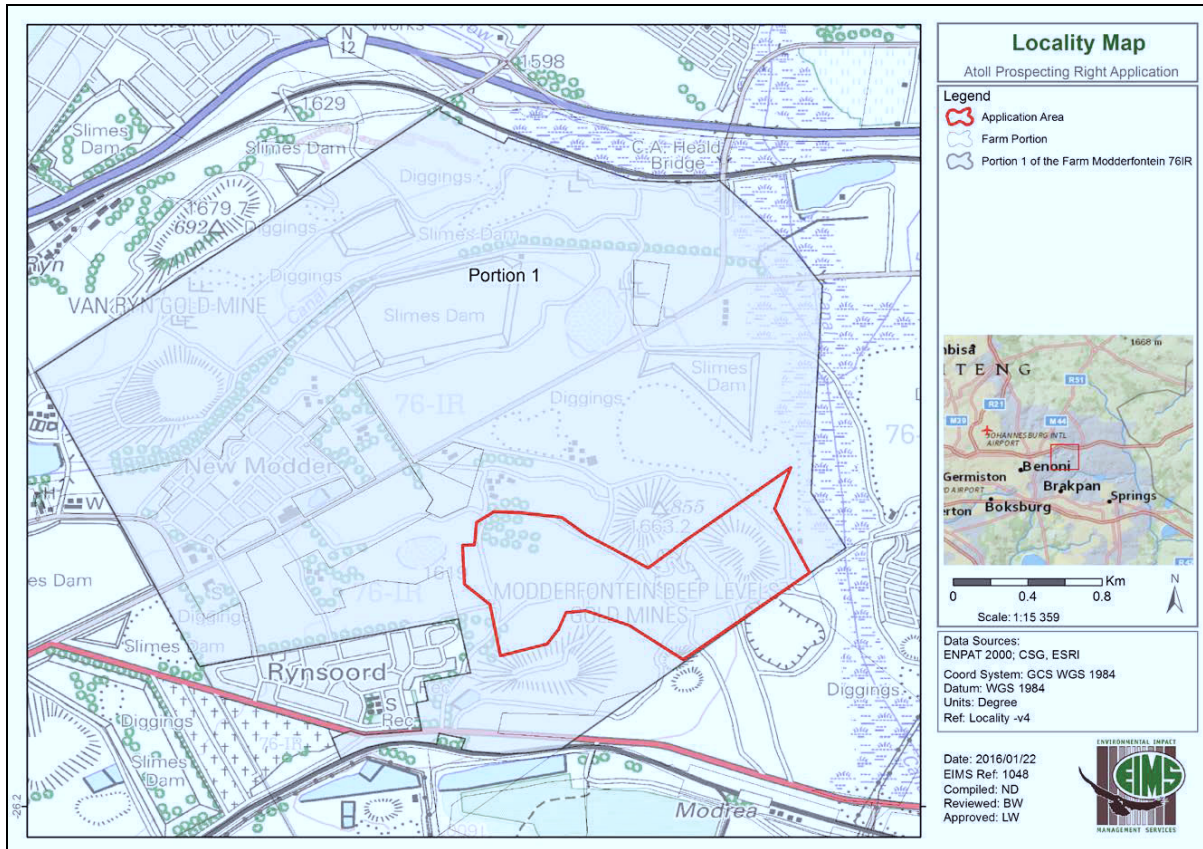

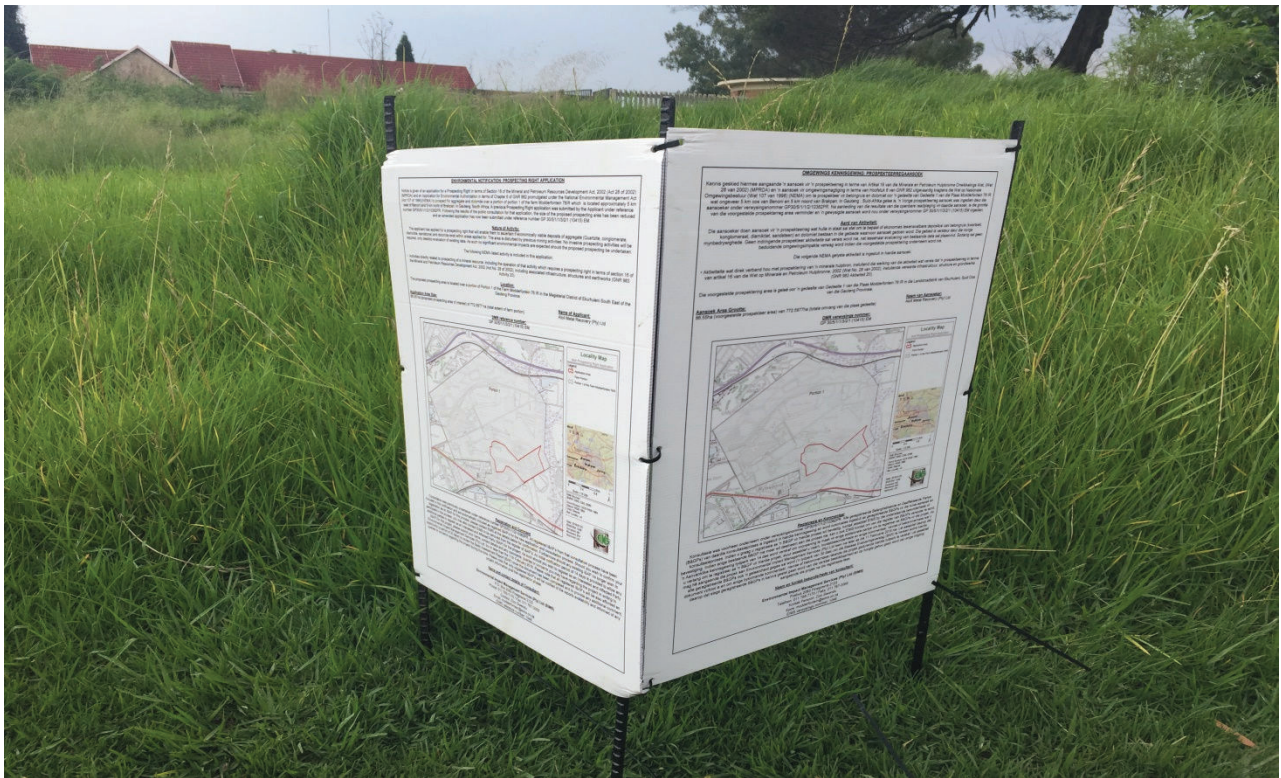


Figure 4: Site notice placement 4
