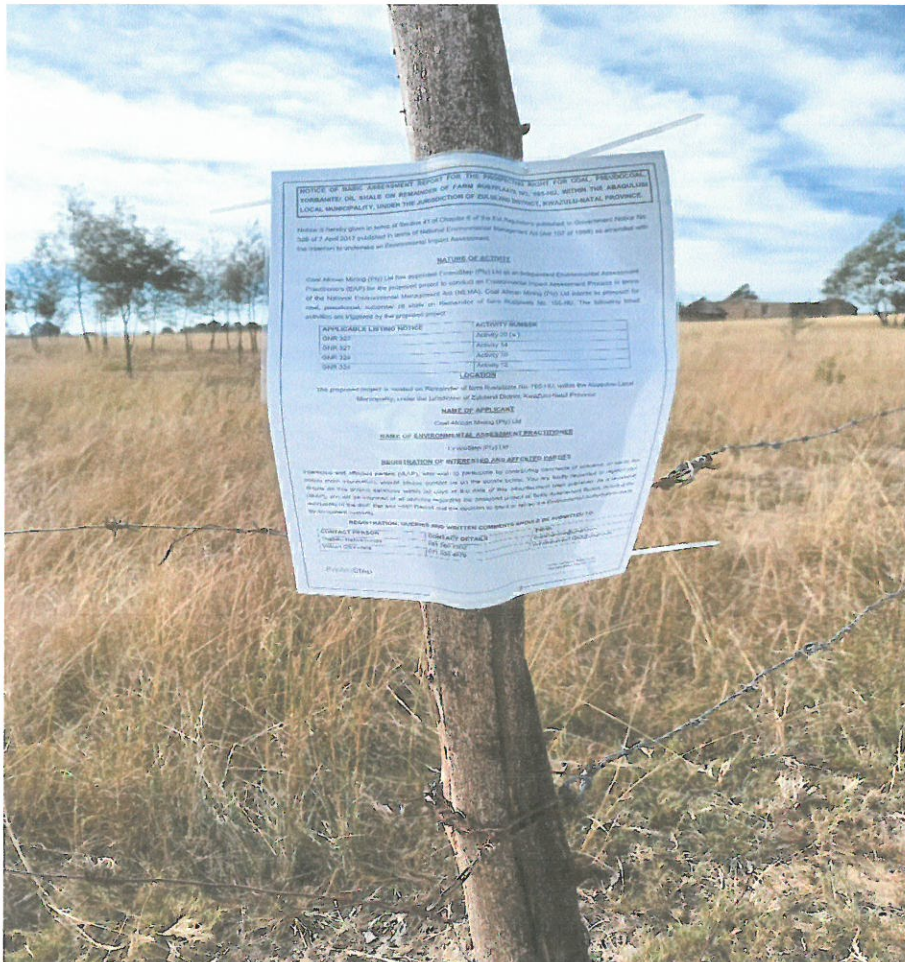

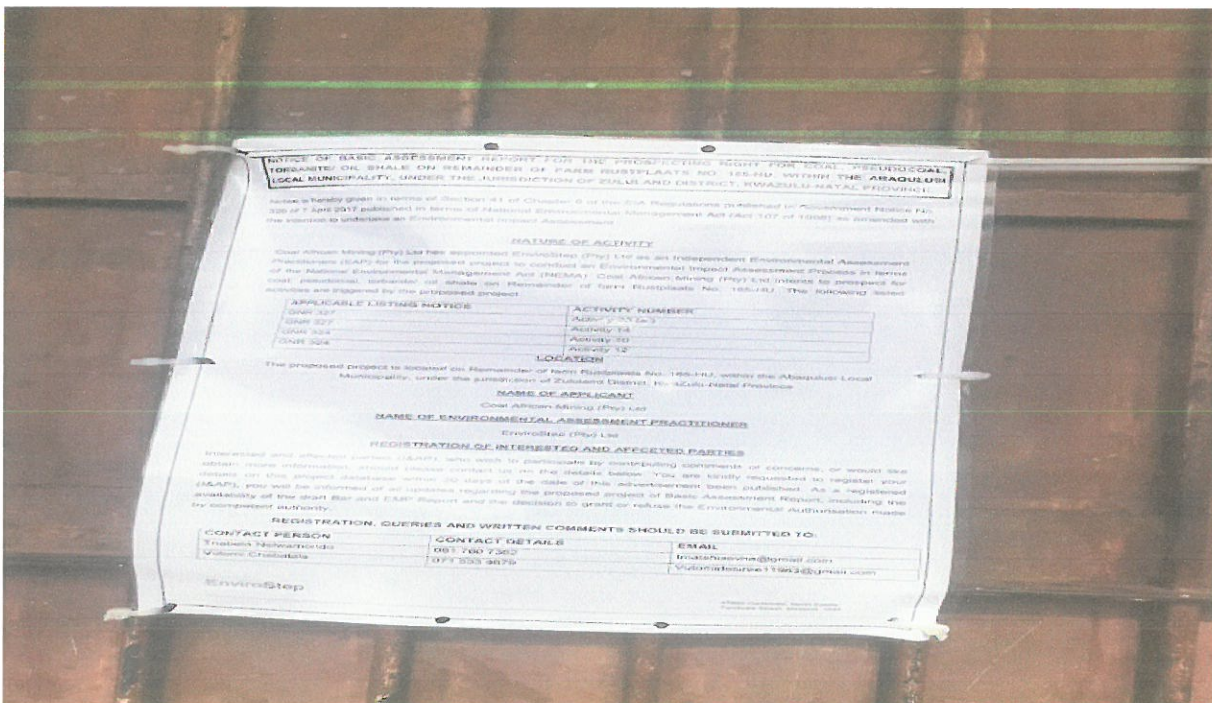

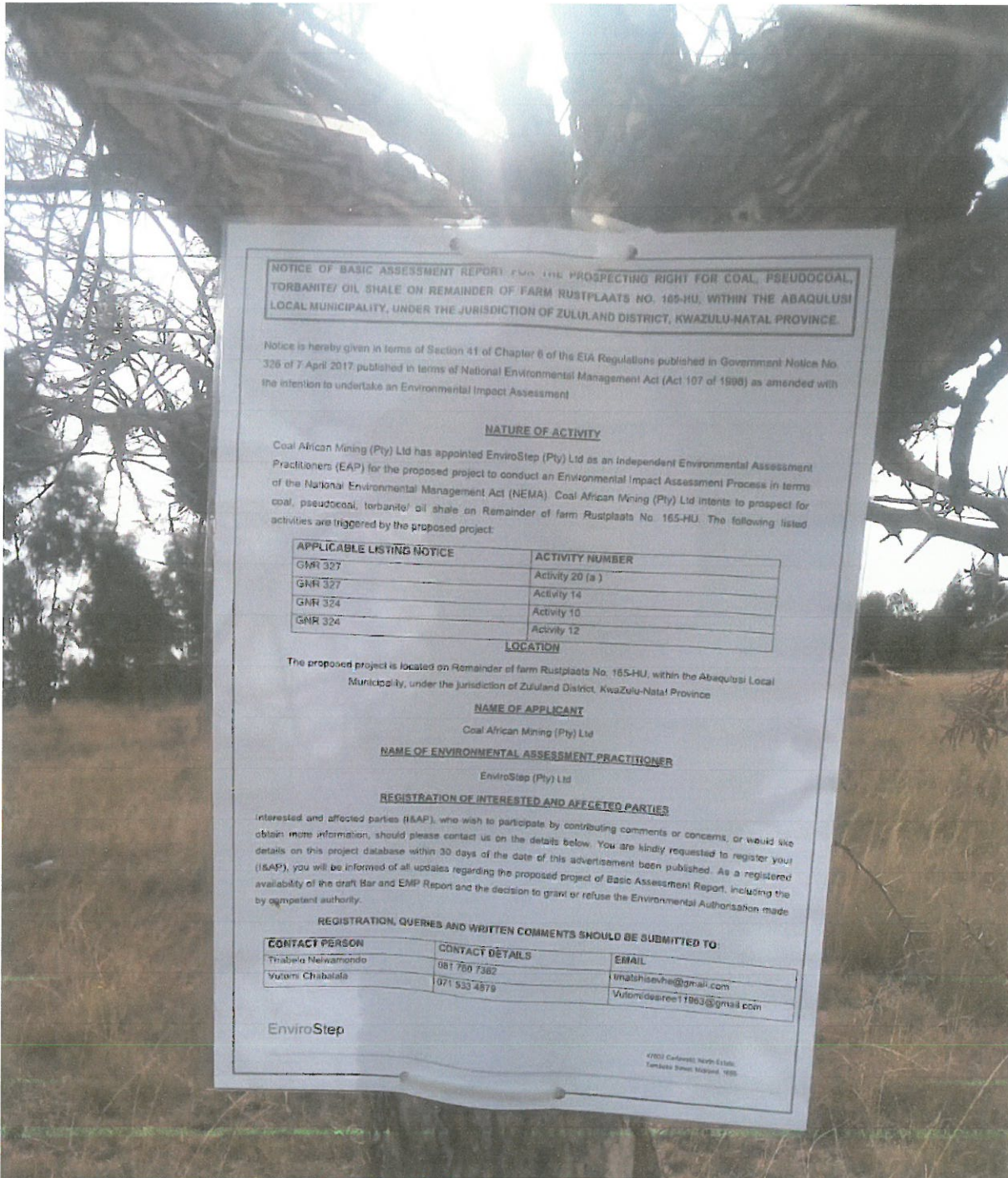

1. Opening and welcome

The ward Councillor of ward 5 Mr Ntombela, Welcomed EnviroStep, The community members and chief Buthelezi. The ward councillor gave permission that everyone present to sign the attendance register. Furthermore, Mr Ntombela, gave the platform to the chief Buthelezi committee to welcome everyone, then he handed the platform to Envirostep to begin the presentation for the proposed project.

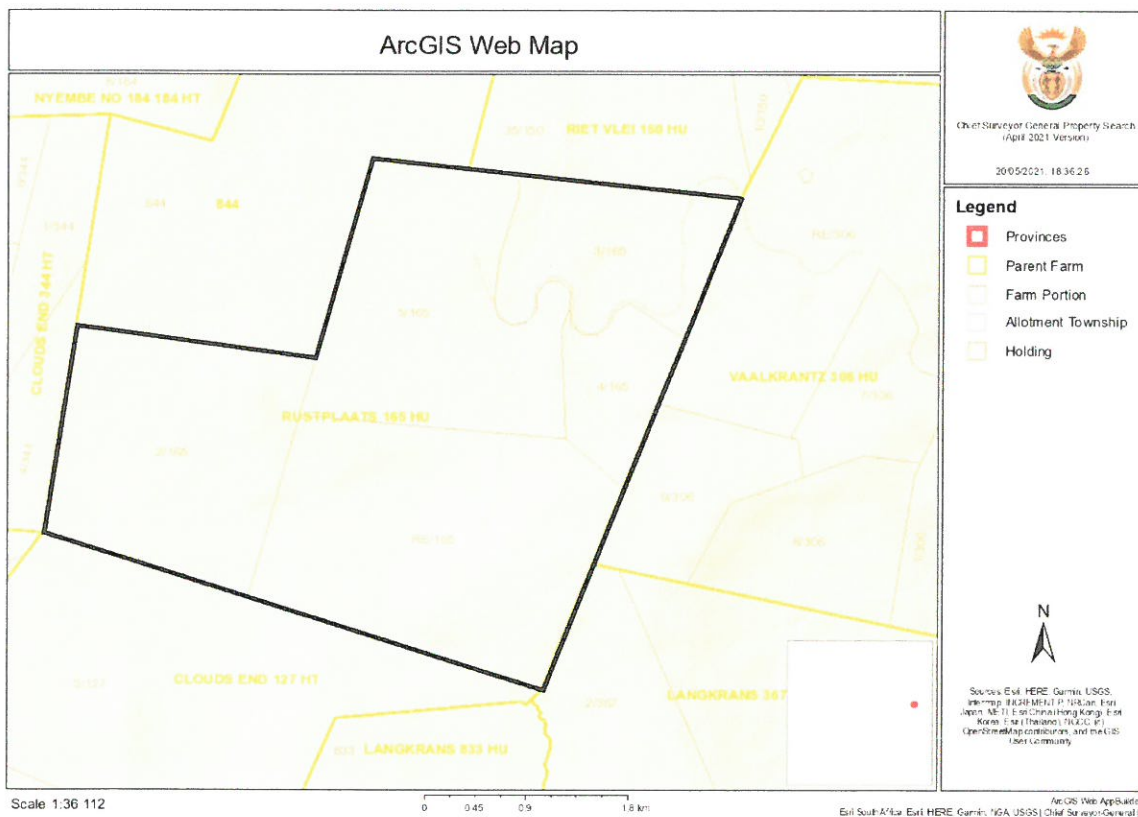
