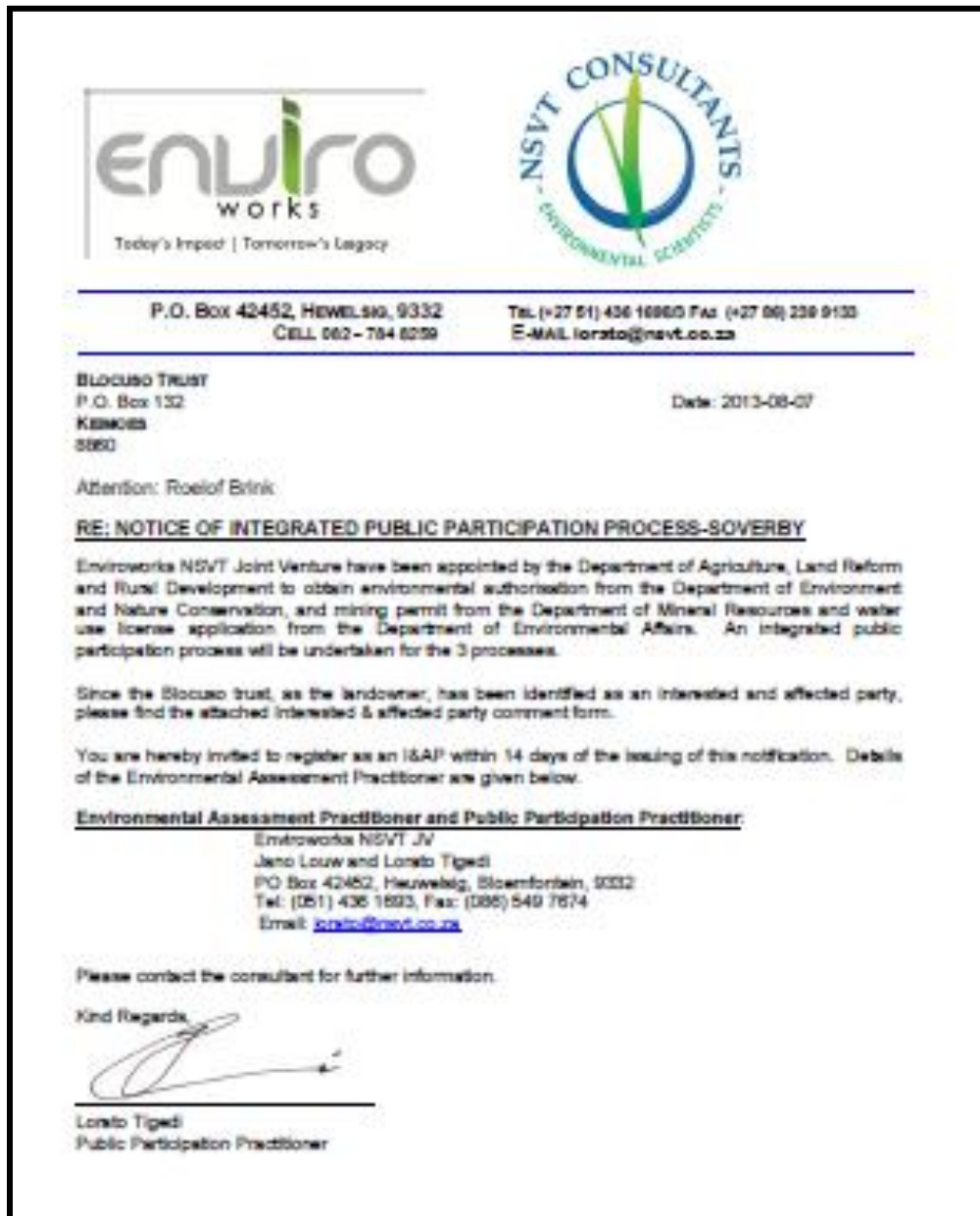
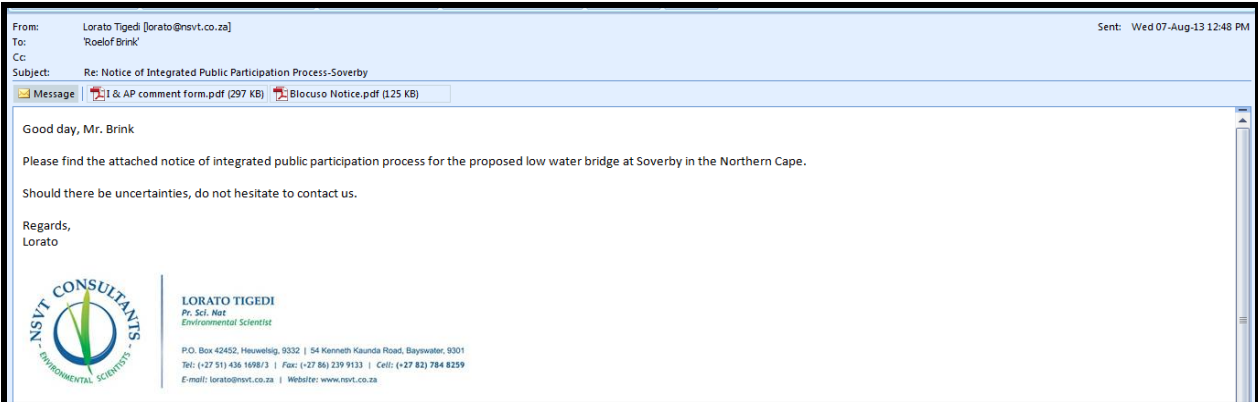


Figure 2: Notification sent to the landowners

Notice is given in terms of the 2010 Amended Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations of the National Environmental Management Act (Act No.107 of 1998) published in the Government Gazette, 18 June 2010 of intent to carry out the following activity:

Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development proposes to construct a *low water bridge* of approximately 137m over a stream flowing into the Orange river, to replace the existing wooden surface bridge.

The activities are given in Government Notice 544, Listing Notice 1 of 18 June 2010, –

- *Activity 18 - The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 5 m³ into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock from*
 - (i) *a watercourse.*

- *Activity 39 - The expansion of*
 - (ii) *bridges**within a watercourse or within 32 metres of a watercourse, measured from the edge of a watercourse.*

Location: Zoovoorby 458, Soverby in the Kai IGarib Local Municipality

An application for Environmental Authorization has been submitted to the Northern Cape Department of Environment and Nature Conservation: NC/BA/26/ZFM/KAI/2013 (NCP/EIA/00002362/2013).

Applications for mining permits for the 3 borrow pits that to be used to source material will be submitted to the Northern Cape Department of Mineral Resources in terms of the Minerals and Petroleum Resource Development Act, 2002 (Act No. 28 of 2002). The borrow pits are located on Remaining extent of Bloccao No. 644.

In addition to the environmental authorisation to be obtained for the proposed low water bridge and mining permit for the borrow pits, a water use license application will be submitted to the Northern Cape Department of Water Affairs for activities that will require a license or general authorization in terms of Section 21 of the National Water Act (Act No. 36 of 1998).
