

Introduction Notice is given in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998), as amended and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, that Homes 2000 (Pty) Limited, is applying for Environmental Authorisation from the North West Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism (DEDECT), with a Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment process for the proposed development of Portions RE/16, 57, 58, RE/194, RE/195, 198, 199, 200, 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, 206 and 207 of the Farm Bookcopies, 297-JQ., within the Rustenburg Local Municipality. Activities 9, 10, 12, 13, 19, 25, 26, 27 and 28 of GNR 983 of 4 December 2014, Activity 15 of GNR984 and Activities 12 and 14 GNR 985 of 4 December 2014 will be triggered by the proposed development.

The Site, Location and Purpose of the Project

The site is ±119 hectares in extent, located to the east and south east of the village of Marikana, west and north of the Tharisa Chrome Mine. The centre of the site is at 25°42′41″S and 27°29′57″E. Please refer to the attached Locality Plan. The site is currently mostly used for agricultural purposes and has been partly subject to open cast mining.

It is proposed that the site be developed as a predominantly residential area, but with associated community facilities and amenities, which would include community centres, churches, educational and other institutional facilities, business opportunities for local shopping and retail, parks and open spaces. The envisaged residential uses would be for the low and middle income levels of the community with a mix of diverse affordable housing types and densities. All bulk and internal services will be provided, including roads, water, power and stormwater. A sewerage treatment plant (Activity 25) will need to be provided to manage sewage effluent and a water reservoir to store potable water (Activity 13).

The purposes of the establishment of this new housing area is because the applicant wishes to relocate and resettle the existing MMmaditblokwa informal settlement and part of the Lacologang informal settlements, that are currently located on the <u>Tharisa</u> Mine footprint, to an area of formal housing, services, amenities and facilities



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5. Minutes of any public and/or stakeholder meetings

23 November 2020 – Site visit with various officials from the **Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation & Tourism, Directorate: Environmental Services (DEDECT).**

Various issues that were raised, identified and addressed are summarised below, as provided by Thato Loeto.

- Discussion of Site Alternatives or information considered in determining the preferred site, also include previously identified/ considered site alternatives
- Clarity on government involvement in relocating community for furtherance of private mining activities, information on agreement between the mine and government regarding donation of the land to government for housing beneficiaries it was said that the purpose of the development is to relocate a community off land which has to be mined.
- If development is to relocate existing settlement then there can be possible justification for the choice of site if beneficiaries are consulted on the impacts but if development is for beneficiaries not currently residing at existing settlements discussed in the report but are from elsewhere on the government housing beneficiaries database then there is no justification of government expenditure on an unsuitable site - Significant Negative Social Impacts.
- Clarity on the relation between land owner, the applicant, the mine and government for the intended purpose of this particular housing project.
- Information of rehabilitated mined land discussion of the extent of the mining activities on the site, how mine rehabilitation was done and specific geological study to report on the effectiveness/ success of the rehabilitated land and it's suitability for housing purposes as proposed. TLB excavation is not sufficient to determine effectiveness of rehabilitation of deep mining excavations – core drill type of technology will determine ground stability at greater depths
- Air Quality impact assessment on the site given proximity of mine slimedams and the mitigation which are relevant to high density housing development. Findings of the baseline study were not set on onsite sampling.
- Illustration of type of foundation designs (part of facility illustrations) in line with findings and recommendations of the geotechnical report –RDP house foundation designs on this site must be according to the recommendations.





- RDP high density units- approximately 4 to 5 hectares at a density of 80 units per hectare, about 295 units- Total RDP units would be approximately 975-1000 units.
- Freehold bonded housing units- within an area of ±27 hectares, at 280m²-300m² sized stands, approximately 880 Erven
- Freehold high density units- within an area of ±5 hectares at 80 units per hectare, approximately 380 Erven. Total bonded units would be 1260 units. All residential units would be ±2800 accommodation units.
- Infrastructure will include roads, electricity, water reservoir and sewerage treatment plant to be built.

Tharisa Mine would like to relocate and resettle the existing Mmaditlhokwa community village and part of the Lapologang community village, that are currently located on land that is scheduled to be used for mining purpose. The land was bought and transferred to the mine, for development of formal housing.

The proposed development is listed in terms of National Environmental Management Act, (NEMA, Act 107 of 1998), 07 April 2017, as amended. The development triggers Regulation GNR. 983, Listing Notice 1 (GN R 327) Activity 9, 10, 12, 13, 19, 25, 26, 27 and 28; GNR.984, Listing Notice 2 (GN R 325) Activity 15 and GNR 985, Listing Notice 3 (GNR 324) Activity 12 and 14.

During the site inspection undertaken by the Unit: Integrated Environmental Management, provincial North West Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism (NW DEDECT), the following were noted:

- The proposed site is largely disturbed, comprising mostly of farmed/ agricultural land (i.e. cultivated lands/fields).
- There is also an occupied farmstead/ house with garden and some remains of recent farming related structures (i.e. store rooms, dwellings and outbuildings no longer in use)
- Mining activity was undertaken on site, in an area of approximately 20 hectares, of which the operation has impacted on the watercourse. The mined area seemed to be rehabilitated, covered only with topsoil.
- There is a small stream or river channel that runs through the central part of the site, part of
 which is encompassed in a riparian area.
- · A grave site was identified on site, close to the perennial stream.
- Rocky outcrops identified on site
- · There are powerlines traversing the southern corner of the site.

According to the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality's Environmental Management Framework (BPDM EMF, June 2020), the site is situated in Zone A: Development Zone I, Zone B: Development Zone II, Zone C: Development Zone D: Agriculture Zone I, Zone E: Agriculture Zone II, Zone F: Biodiversity Zone and Zone G: Sensitive Topography Zone.

- i. Zone A: Development Zone I (Residential, business and other). 'Development Zone I' is a refinement of areas identified for future urban development in local municipal SDFs. These development uses include, amongst others, residential land uses, commercial land uses and land uses related to government functions, but specifically excludes industrial land uses and mining related land uses.
- Zone B: Development Zone II (Industrial) is a refinement of areas identified for future industrial development in local municipal SDFs.
- iii.Zone C: Development Zone III (Mining) is a refinement of areas identified in local municipal SDFs as areas with potential for mining development. If developed in a sustainable manner, these areas have the potential to stimulate economic growth in the area.
- iv. Zone D: Agriculture Zone I. The "Agriculture Zone" represents existing high potential agricultural land in the area (i.e. cultivated fields) that should be preserved for crop production and other agricultural purposes.
- v. Zone E: Agricultural Zone II. The "Agriculture Zone" represents areas deemed suitable for further agricultural development for both grazing and cultivation purposes. The land may also be utilised for other types of development.

- vi. The "Biodiversity Zone" represents areas of high and significant biodiversity in the Bojanala District Municipality. Areas of high biodiversity was identified from the North West Province Biodiversity Sector Plan and includes, among others, critical biodiversity areas (CBAs) and Ecological Support areas (ESAs).
- vii. Zone G: Sensitive Topography Zone. The "Sensitive Topography Zone" represents the sensitive topographical features, such as hills and ridges, which are deemed sensitive to development.

According to Zone A: Development Zone I, Zone B: Development Zone II, Zone C: Development Zone D: Agriculture Zone I, Zone E: Agriculture Zone II, Zone F: Biodiversity Zone and Zone G: Sensitive Topography, the land use listed above is compatible, partially compatible and incompatible, as per the above-mentioned Zones, however, the proposed site has been disturbed and impacted by previous historical activities (i.e. cultivated lands, existing dwelling house and infrastructure).

In reviewing this information, the Unit: Integrated Environmental Management made the following findings:

- Taken in the regional context, surrounding areas are dominated by mining, agriculture and rural/urban settlements.
- A watercourse crosses through the central part of the site. The necessary mitigation measures will ensure that the water bodies are protected from soil erosion and the possible siltation. Large parts of the site surface have been disturbed by previous activities (i.e. cultivation, major earthworks associated with mining, harvesting of wood, grazing by domestic livestock and surrounded by alien tree species with few natural vegetation.

The Unit: IEM does not support the proposed development, based on the following reasons:

- An approved letter or Closure certificate obtained from the Department of Mineral Resources (DMR) stating that the site has been properly closed and rehabilitated must be submitted to the Municipality prior to any development, is not included in the Report and this may pose serious housing problems in future.
- Recommendations included in the Air Quality and Health Risk Assessment Report that the proposed residential development be either relocated to an alternative area greater than 5 KM away from Tharisa Mine and other mines, or that the proposed land use for development foot print be re-assessed and other possible land uses such as industrial/manufacturing use be assessed due to severe Air Quality Impacts.

by specialists however a report is contained in the EIAR, please clarify the statement as this can be confusing to the reader.

2. The term "Refer Error! Reference source not found" appears continually in the report, please rectify on Final EIAR.

3. For Linear Listed Activities of bulk services provision please provide coordinates for start, middle and end point, Page

15 of the Application form must be amended to include this information and forwarded to the case officer to update records.

Please provide coordinates for location of proposed reservoir as activities applied for and the sewage treatment pl

Together we move North West forward.

- The Geotechnical investigation identified several ground challenges which must be addressed by suitable foundation and building designs, Please attach technical drawings of the envisaged foundation and building design for the record as part of facility illustration.
- 6. The Department has noted; with significant concern; in the "Baseline assessment and Health Risk Assessment Report" attached in Appendix 12 of the Draft EIAR that the site is not suitable for residential purposes as proposed and that the development site must be relocated more than 5 km away from the mining activities due to air quality concerns associated with the mining activities; however the "Comparative Assessment on Alternatives" as captured in Section 3.7 of the Draft EIAR has found that there are constraints and limitations in exploring other site alternatives due to land ownership being under a private party and that no other site alternatives were investigated. It is noted that the site of the proposed development is directly adjacent to active mining activities and slime dams. It is also noted in Housing Development Survey attached in Appendix 13 of the Draft EIAR that approximately 64.4% of directly affected survey respondents indicated that mining waste poses a threat to the community.
- 7. Please attach proof of correspondences with Department of Mineral Resources regarding the mine closure certificate of the previously mined and rehabilitated portion of the site; and that Department's comments on suitability of proposed site for dense residential development within close proximity to active mining activities as proposed.


A draft Scoping Report has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 107 of 1998 (NEMA) and NEMA Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations. The proposed development will include RDP housing units and freehold bonded housing units, with all bulk and internal services and infrastructure such as roads, water, sewage, power and stormwater management. The proposed development will cover 116 ha.

A Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) has been conducted as per section 38(3) and 38(8) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA) as required by section 24(4)b(iii) of NEMA.

Pelser, A. 2019. Phase 1 HIA Report for the proposed development of affordable housing and related activities on various portions of the farm Rooikoppies 297JQ in Marikana, North West Province.

One burial ground of indeterminate age consisting of approximately 20 graves was identified within the proposed development boundary. The site was rated with a high significance rating. The developer has indicated with the burial ground will be excluded from the development and will be preserved in situ.

Recommendations provided in the report include the following:



- The burial ground should be managed through a Heritage Management Plan, be properly cleaned, the graves be recorded in detail, a Graves register be drafted and the site fenced-in properly to allow family members access to visit;
- If not possible to avoid impact to the graves, a social consultation process must be undertaken to locate the descendants of the deceased, and permits to be applied for should consent be given;
- A Chance Finds Procedure is recommended to be followed.

In an Interim Comment issued on the 26/06/2020, SAHRA requested that the draft EIA and all appendices be submitted before further comments will be issued.

These documents were submitted to the SAHRIS application on the 30/10/2020. It is noted that the grave site has been retained as per the sensitivity plan on page 37 of the DEIA and the site will be preserved in-situ as stated on page 59 of the DEIA.

Final Comment

The following comments are made as a requirement in terms of section 3(4) of the NEMA Regulations and section 38(8) of the NHRA in the format provided in section 38(4) of the NHRA and must be included in the Final EIA and EMPr:

- 38(4)a The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit and Burial Grounds and Graves (BGG) Unit has no objections to the proposed development;
- 38(4)b The recommendations provided by the heritage specialists are supported and must be adhered to. Additional further specific conditions are provided for the development as follows:
- A buffer-zone of at-least 30m must be maintained around the identified graves. Should it prove
 impossible to maintain the required buffer, a grave relocation process which includes a FULL 60 days
 consultation must be initiated to obtain a SAHRA permit for the graves to be relocated.
- 38(4)c(i) If any evidence of archaeological sites or remains (e.g. remnants of stone-made structures, indigenous ceramics, bones, stone artefacts, ostrich eggshell fragments, charcoal and ash concentrations), fossils or other categories of heritage resources are found during the proposed development, SAHRA APM Unit (Natasha Higgitt/Phillip Hine 021 462 5402) must be alerted as per section 35(3) of the NHRA. Non-compliance with section of the NHRA is an offense in terms of section 51(1)e of the NHRA and item 5 of the Schedule;
- 38(4)c(ii) If unmarked human burials are uncovered, the SAHRA Burial Grounds and Graves (BGG) Unit (Thingahangwi Tshivhase/Mimi Seetelo 012 320 8490), must be alerted immediately as per
