### Notice of Environmental Impact Assessment Process for the proposed upgrade of the South African Police Training Facility Verdrag, near Thabazimbi NEAS REF: DEA/EIA/0001130/2012 & 14/12/16/3/3/38 Competent Authority: National Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) INVITATION TO REGISTER

Notice is given in terms of National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998)(NEMA), as amended and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2010, as published in the Government Notice R543 as well as the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008)(NEMWA) and Government Notice R718 of 2009, that the **Department of Public Works (the Applicant) is applying for certain upgrades to the existing Verdrag South African Police Training Facility**. The Verdrag training facility comprises three farms, namely Buffelskloof 452 KQ, Buffelskloof 459 KQ and Groenfontein 458KQ. The facility is located roughly 37km directly east of Thabazimbi.

**NEMA**  
In terms of Listing Notices 1 and 3, published in Government Gazette Numbers R544 and R546 respectively, authorisation is required for the following activities (Basic Assessment):

• GNR 544 18 June 2010	18(i)	The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 5 cubic metres into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 5 cubic metres from (i) a watercourse.
• GNR 544 18 June 2010	37(a)	The expansion of facilities or infrastructure for the bulk transportation of water, sewerage or stormwater where (a) the facility or infrastructure is expanded by more than 1000 metres in length.
• GNR 544 18 June 2010	39(ii),(iii),(v)	The expansion of (ii) channels, (iii) bridges, (v) bulk stormwater outlet structures within a watercourse or within 32m of a watercourse, measured from the edge of a watercourse, where such expansion will result in an increased development footprint but excluding where such expansion will occur behind the development setback line.
• GNR 546 18 June 2010	4(a)(i)(cc)	The construction of a road wider than 4 metres with a reserve less than 13,5 metres in (a) Limpopo (ii) outside urban areas, in (cc) Sensitive areas as identified in an environmental management framework as contemplated in Chapter 5 of the Act and as adopted by the Competent Authority.
• GNR 546 18 June 2010	8(a)(ii)(dd)	The construction of aircraft landing strips and runways 1,4 kilometres and shorter in (a) Limpopo (ii) outside urban areas in (dd) Sensitive areas as identified in an environmental management framework as contemplated in chapter 5 of the Act and as adopted by the competent authority.
• GNR 546 18 June 2010	13(c)(ii)(cc)	The clearance of an area of 1 hectare or more of vegetation where 75% or more of the vegetative cover constitutes indigenous vegetation in (c) Limpopo (ii) outside urban areas in (cc) sensitive areas as identified in an environmental management framework as contemplated in Chapter 5 of the Act and as adopted by the Competent Authority.
• GNR 546 18 June 2010	26	Phased activities for all activities listed in this Schedule and as it applies to a specific geographical area, which commenced on or after the effective date of this Schedule, where any phase of the activity may be below a threshold but where a combination of the phases, including expansions or extensions, will exceed a specified threshold.

**NEMWA**  
In terms of GNR 718 (Category A) and (Category B) the following activities require authorisation (Basic Assessment and Environmental Impact Assessment):

• No 718 3 July 2009	Category A (Item 3)	The storage including the temporary storage of general waste in lagoons.
• No 718 3 July 2009	Category B (Item 7)	The treatment of effluent, wastewater or sewage with an annual throughput capacity of 15 000 cubic metres or more.

**NOTE**  
The applicant will submit an application for a Water Use Licence (WULA) for activities requiring authorisation in terms of Section 21 of the National Water Act, Act 36 of 1998. Details regarding the Water Uses will be confirmed in the Scoping and EIA Reports.

An integrated application process will be followed through a full Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA).
