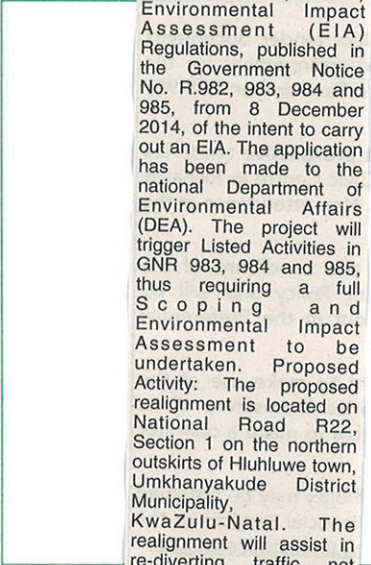

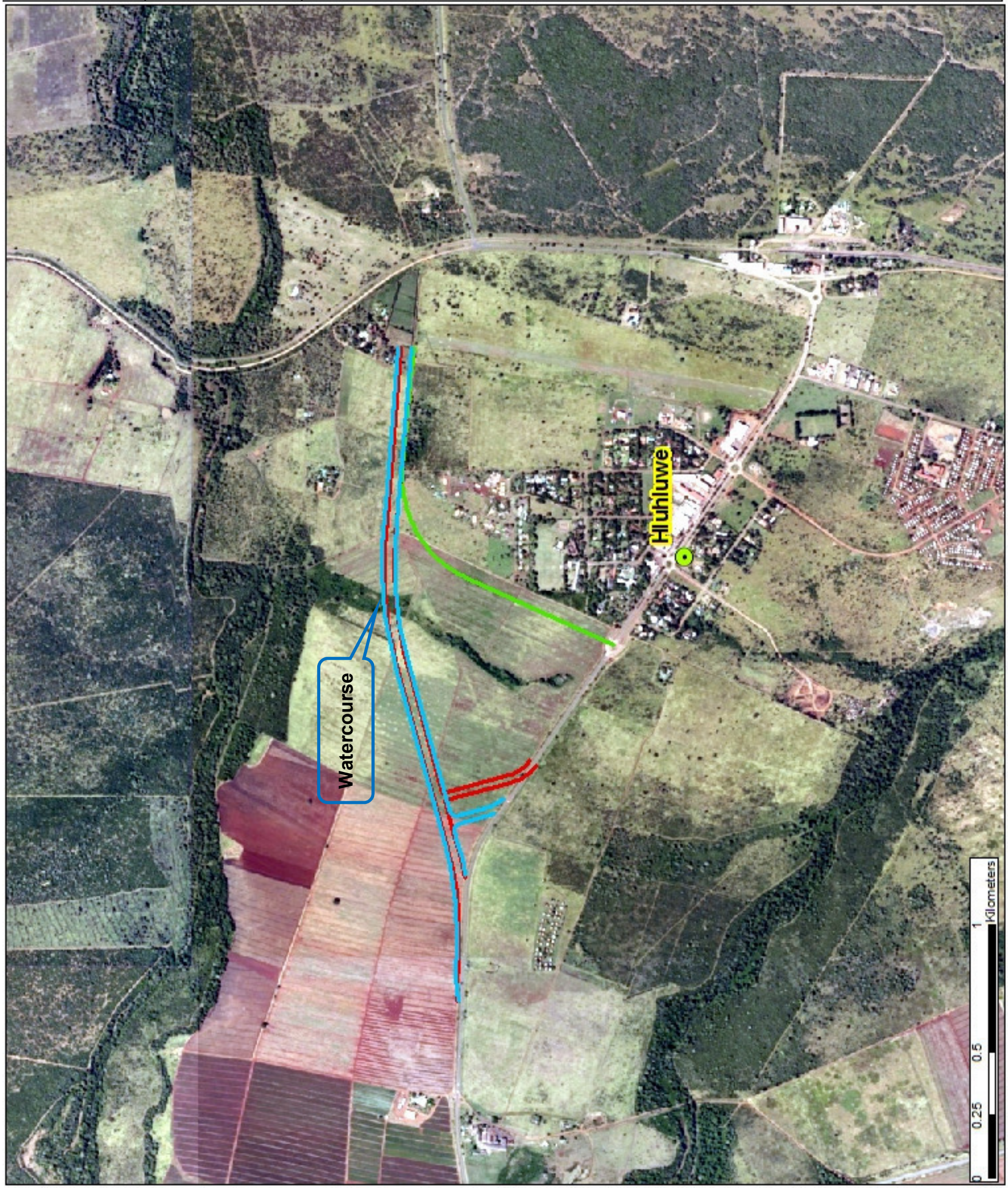


Figure 1. The Preferred and Alternative Route Alignments for the realignment of the R22 around Hluhluwe town.

1. Introduction

Terratest (Pty) Ltd has been appointed by the South African National Roads Agency Limited (SANRAL) to undertake the Screening and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process and Water Use Licence Application (WULA) for the proposed realignment of the Regional Route 22 (R22), envisaged to bypass the town of Hluhluwe within the Big 5 False Bay Local Municipality, KwaZulu-Natal.

This Notification Document aims to inform Interested and Affected Parties of the EIA and WULA processes to be conducted. The EIA process is being undertaken in accordance with the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998), EIA Regulation (2014). Terratest (Pty) Ltd, as the appointed Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP), is required to conduct the EIA Process and manage the public participation process for the project. The EIA process to be conducted for the proposed developments is broken into two phases, namely:

- Phase 1: Scoping; and
- Phase 2: Environmental Impact Assessment.

Phase 1: The Scoping Phase aims to identify potential issues, impacts, project alternatives, specialist Terms of Reference for the relevant investigations and key issues to be addressed in the Environmental Impact Assessment Phase (Phase 2). The key product of the Scoping Phase is the Impact Assessment Methodology (Plan of Study). This determines how the Environmental Impact Assessment Phase will be undertaken. Following the acceptance of the Plan of Study by the Competent Authority (Department of Environmental Affairs), the Environmental Impact Assessment Phase (Phase 2) will commence.

2. Description of the project

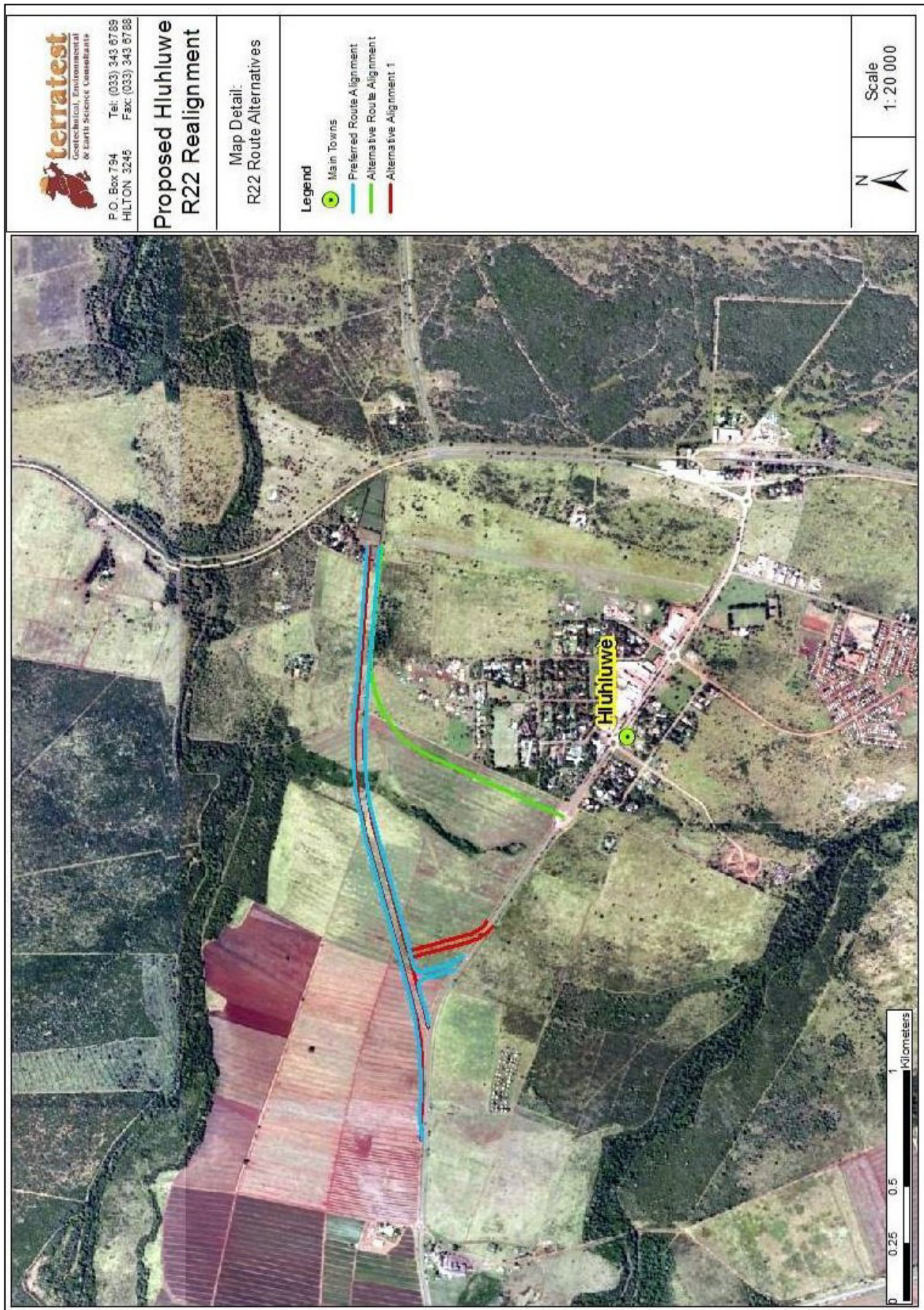


Figure 1: Proposed layout alternatives for the realignment of the R22.

The road realignment is proposed to bypass the town of Hluhluwe. The proposed project is located on the existing R22, Section 1 on the outskirts of the Hluhluwe town, 2km off the N2. Both local and cross boarder traffic use this route as a main access point both to and from the N2 in Northern KwaZulu-Natal into the economic heartland of South Africa. The design requirements envisage for the realignment include the construction of a single carriageway road, with a total width of ~13 metres. This will serve to accommodate one lane of traffic per direction. The proposed realignment will tie into the authorised Road-Over-Rail Bridge and Approach Alignment (DEA EIA Reference Number 14/12/16/3/3/1/1502). Three layout alternatives have been identified and investigated for the realignment. Please refer to the proposed layout alternatives as provided in Figure 1.

3. EIA Regulations (2014)

In accordance with the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998) and the EIA Regulations (2014), the following Listed Activities are triggered and require the undertaking of a Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment:

- GN R 983, Activity 12: *“The development of bulk stormwater outlet structures exceeding 100 square metres in size.”*
- GN R 983, Activity 19: *The infilling or depositing of any material of more than 5m³ into, a watercourse.”*
- GN R 983, Activity 24: *“The development of a road with a reserve wider than 13.5 metres, or where no reserve exists where the road is wider than 8 metres.”*
- GN R 984, Activity 27: *“The development of (i) A national road as defined in section 40 of the South African National Roads Agency Limited and National Roads Act, 1998 (Act No. 7 of 1998);*
 - *A road administered by a provincial authority;*
 - *A road with a reserve wider than 30 metres.”*
- GN R 985, Activity 4: *“The development of a road wider than 4 metres with a reserve less than 13.5 metres. (d) In KwaZulu-Natal, (xii) Outside urban areas: (aa) Areas within 10 kilometres from national parks or world heritage sites or 5 kilometres from any other protected area identified in terms of NEMPAA or from the core areas of a biosphere reserve.”*
- GN R 985, Activity 14: *““The development of – (xii) infrastructure or structures with a physical footprint of 10m² or more. d) In KwaZulu-Natal, (ii) Outside urban areas: (hh) Areas within 10 kilometres from national parks or world heritage sites or 5 kilometres from any other protected area identified in terms of NEMPAA or from the core areas of a biosphere reserve”.*

As such, Environmental Authorisation will be applied for prior to construction commencing.

4. WULA Regulations

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 41 (4) of the National Water Act (NWA), 1998 (Act 36 of 1998) that a Water Use License (WUL) is being applied for. Due to the nature of this project, water use in terms of Section 21 (c) and (i) under the NWA (No. 36 of 1998) is applicable, thus requiring a WUL:

- 21 (c): *“Impeding or diverting the flow of water in a watercourse.”*
- 21 (i): *“Altering the bed, banks, course or characteristics of a watercourse”.*

An application will be made to the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) for the above mentioned development.

5. Public Participation Process

The Public Participation Process, as promulgated in terms of Chapter 6 of the NEMA Regulations (GNR 982, 2014) forms major part of the EIA process and aims to assist in identifying potential impacts and areas of concern through consultation with Interested and Affected Parties. This process will be undertaken in the following manner:

- Compilation and distribution of the Notification Document (this Document);
 - Placing an advertisement in a local newspaper;
 - Placing site notices in conspicuous places along the R22 and in Hluhluwe town;
 - Giving written notice to landowners and occupiers of land along the proposed alignment;
 - Identification of key stakeholders, authorities and municipalities, environmental groups and interested or affected members of the public, hereafter referred to as IAPs;
 - Giving written notice to the local Ward Councillor; and
- Record all comments of IAPs and present such comments, as well as responses provided by Terratest, in a full comment and Responses Reports that will be submitted with the Scoping and Environmental Impact Assessment Reports, to the DEA.

Upon the completion of the Draft Scoping Report, all IAPs will be afforded 30 days to review and comment on the report. Thereafter, the Final Scoping report will be submitted to the DEA for acceptance and for a decision to be granted to either proceed onto the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Phase or submit further information for consideration.

Once the Final Scoping Report is accepted, the EIA Phase will be initiated. Registered IAPs and Stakeholders will be notified of, and afforded the opportunity to comment on the Draft EIA Report combined with the Environmental Management Programme (EMPr), for period of 30 days. There after the Final EIA Report will be submitted to the DEA for a decision on Environmental Authorisation.

Section 41 (4) of the NWA requires that public notification be undertaken for the WULA. Notice of the water use licence application is open to public scrutiny and/or comments. Written objections may be lodged, to the contact person listed above, against the application no more than 60 days after the date of this publication. Please ensure you submit your name and contact information.


