JG Afrika (Pty) Ltd have been appointed by the eThekwini Municipality Roads Provision Department to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment (Basic Assessment) for the upgrading an existing municipal road and associated crossing. The proposed upgrade will occur on Track 83887, off Reeves Road in Bhekulwandle, Ward 109, eThekwini Municipality.

Track 83887 is a 330m long dirt road which links Road 510137 and Reeves Road. Track 83887 is fairly steep and requires regular maintenance due to constant erosion. It is proposed that the road be upgraded to a concrete surface with associated side drains and an upgrade of the present 900m pipe crossing to a 1.5m x 1.5m culvert crossing.


