### SAMARA MINING APPLICATION – LOWER ORANGE RIVER

I refer to our discussions and meeting with regard to the Samara Mining applications lodged under NCS 30/5/1/1/2/1 PR and NCS30/5/1/1/2/1 (12663) PR. As you are aware Lower Orange River Diamonds (Pty) Ltd (LOR) currently hold the mining rights on the area which these applications encompass. Further LOR have advised you that these areas fall under the 100 year flood line, as determined from time to time by LOR. LOR have also lodged formal objections to the applications.

Subsequent to our meetings, and discussions, we have agreed, without prejudice to any LOR rights that might exist, to cooperate with you on a number of initiatives within Namaqualand. Whilst a number of these are yet to be identified we have agreed on the following.

Samara Mining, or its agreed nominee, will enter into an exclusive collaboration agreement with LOR to explore the economic feasibility of mining, between the 100 year flood line and the south bank of the Orange River, within the area of the current LOR license. We have agreed to pursue this on the same terms and conditions of the LOR Business model. All consents necessary and authorities required will be submitted by LOR to the relevant authority, on behalf of Samara, or its nominee, who will provide LOR with such documentation.
