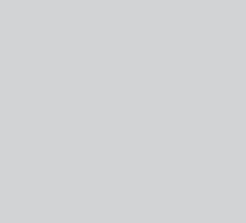

Notice is hereby given in terms of Chapter 6, National Environmental Management Act 107 of 1998 (as amended) Regulations 2010(as amended), the National Environmental Management Waste Act 59 of 2008, GN 921 of November 2013 Section 4, of an intent to conduct an Environmental Impact Assessment pursuant a Waste Management License for the activities described below. An application of intent to conduct and Environmental Impact Assessment for the proposed activity has been lodged with the Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs on the 19th of September 2014.

The proposed development involves the establishment of a landfill site at the above mentioned location, of which it is anticipated that the Landfill Site will be servicing the following three areas, Harrismith, Kestel and Phuthaditjhaba.

It is proposed that the new Landfill site will have the following

- Recycling facility (thus a buy-back center).
- Compost facility
- And an area allocated for inert waste disposal

The footprint of the proposed Landfill site is approximately 20 hectares. The calculation of the expected tonnages with a life expectancy of 20 years for the proposed landfill site was done with an estimation of 550 tons of waste to be disposed per day. In addition to the above, the proposed landfill site includes the following associated infrastructure and facilities;

- Perimeter fencing
- Remote gate,
- Security guard house, and Administration block with Ablution facilities, Computers, and workshop
- Platform station.
- Recycling facilities & sorting facilities
- Constructions of landfill cells and leachate management and
- Unsurfaced access road, ring road and storm-water drainage management system

According to the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008), Government Notice 921 29 November 2013, category B, Section 4 pursuant to the Waste Management license an Environmental Impact Assessment is required for the following identified activities.

- **Government Notice 921 29 November 2013, Category B.**
- Activity (8), the disposal of general waste to land covering in excess of 200m2 and with a total capacity exceeding 25 000 tons.
- Activity (9), the disposal of inert waste to land in excess of 25 000 tons, excluding the disposal of such waste for the purposes of levelling and building which has been authorized by or under other legislation.
- Activity (10), the construction of a facility for a waste management activity listed in Category B of this Schedule (not in isolation to associated waste management activity).

In addition a Water Use license will be required for the proposed landfill site as it poses a potential to generate leachate. The calculation of the expected tonnages with a life expectancy of 20 years for the proposed landfill site was done with an estimation of 550 tons of waste to be disposed per day.
