The impact was shown to be low. It was advised by the specialist that construction of the dams should be initiated and completed while the birds are away in the northern parts of their migratory range during May to August, so as to minimise any construction-related disturbances in the vicinity. Further work is also done by Dr Garth Batchelor to identify actual breeding site and to provide alternative breeding sites. More information will be provided in the EIA Report. 2. The Mooifontein plantation is downstream adjacent the Crocodile River after the confluence of Devil's Creek and Crocodile River. There should not be an impact of the proposed dam on the Mooifontein plantation but it will be assessed in the EIA.
