BA Process

- The requirements for the BA process are specifically contained in Chapter 4 Part 2 and Appendix 1 of the EIA Reg No 326 (amended on 7 April 2017)
- The BA process are undertaken for project activities that are included under Listing Notices 1 and 3.
- Impacts of these activities are more generally known and can often be mitigated or easily managed.
- The BA process is shorter and less tedious



Timeframes

- The BA process can take up to 90 days to complete and 107 days for competent authority to review

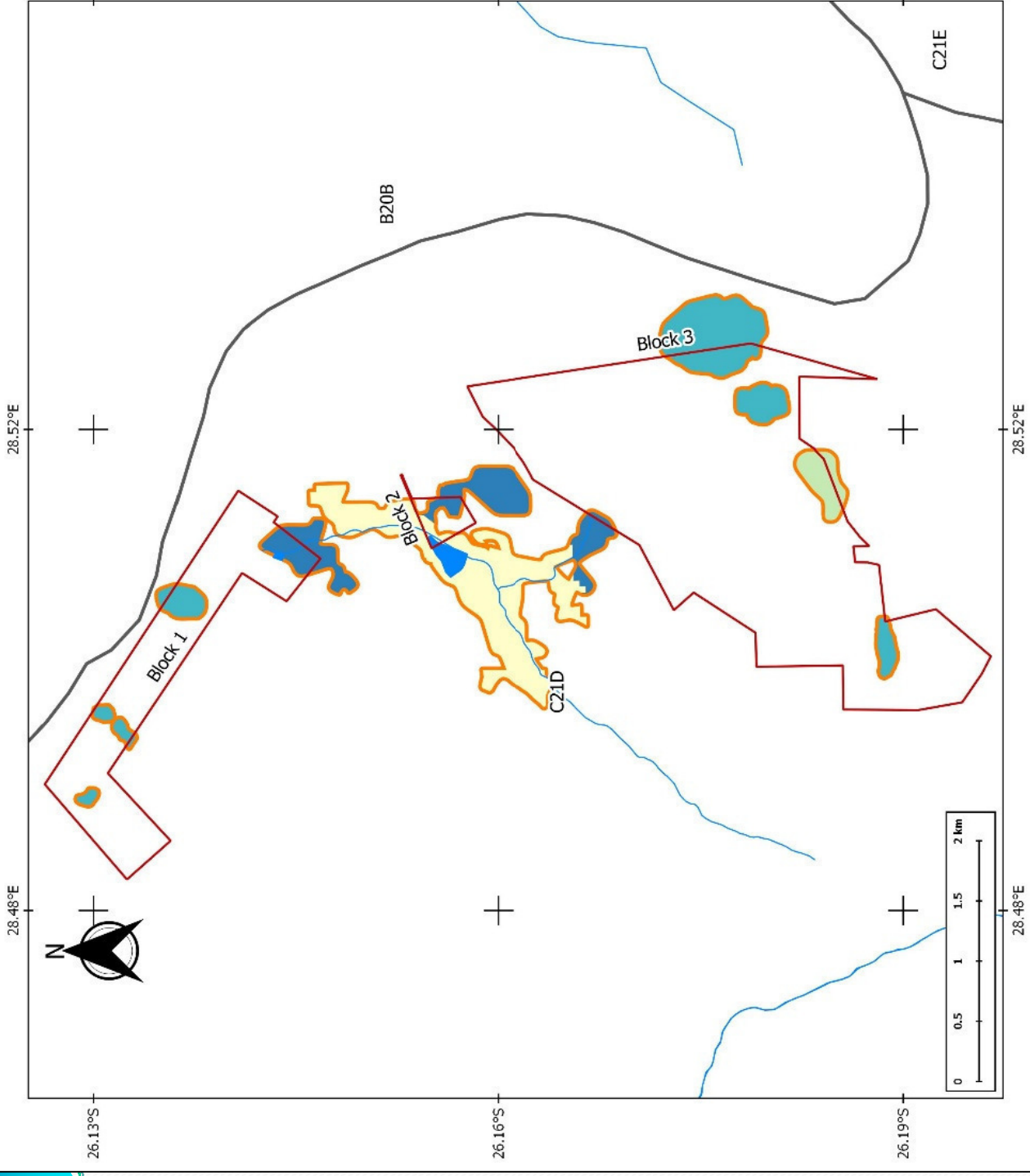
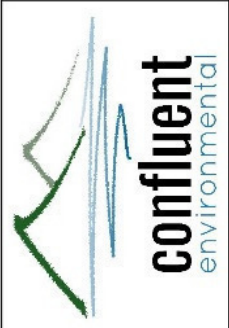
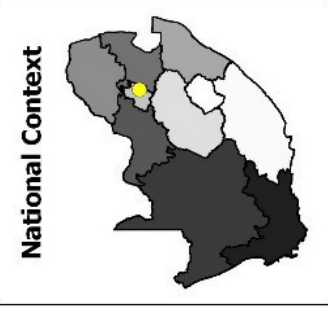

Wetland Assessment

Impacts to all wetlands can easily be avoided through implementing the following mitigation measures:

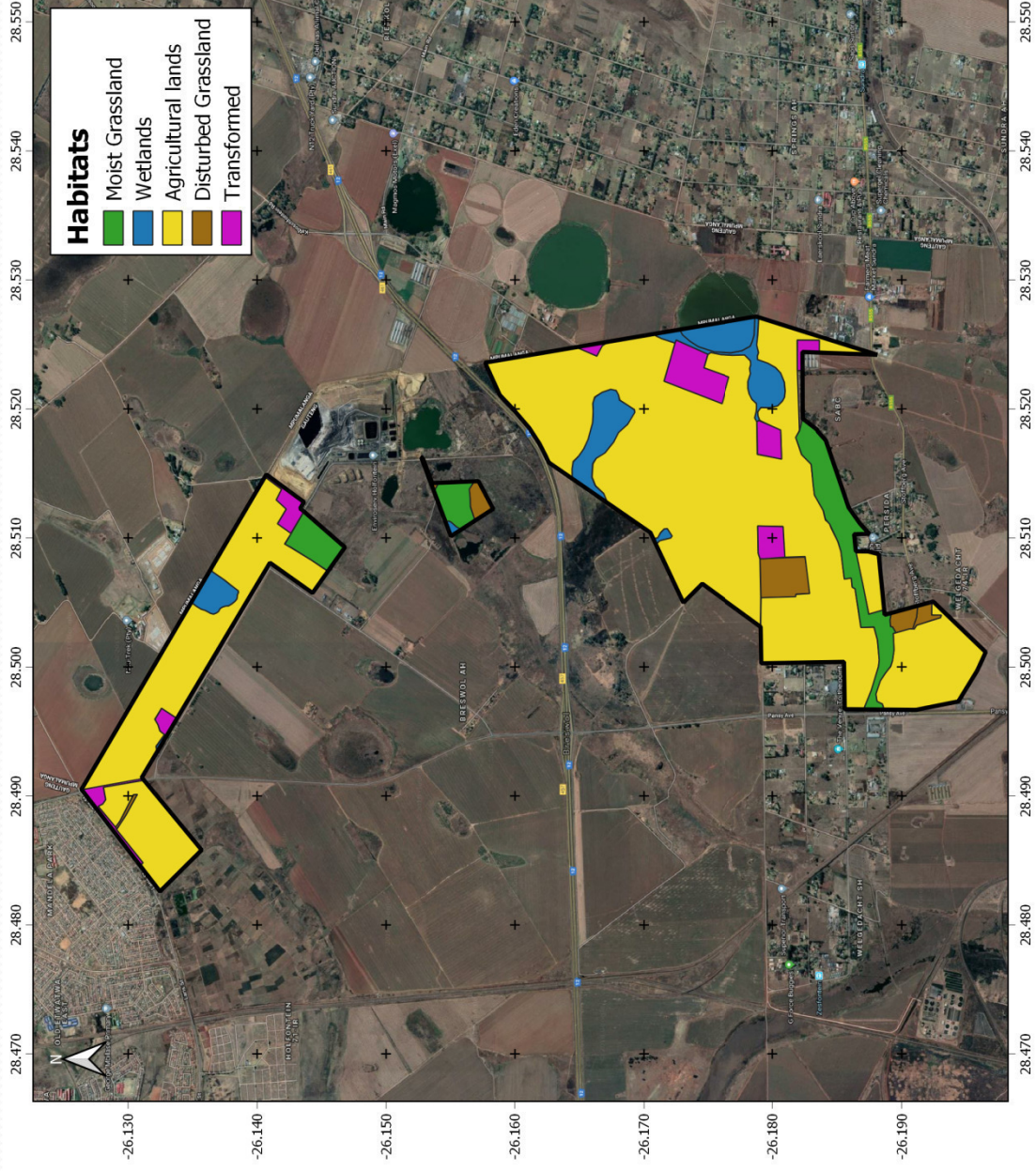
- All drilling activities must take place outside of the recommended buffer zone for each wetland;
- Driving through wetland areas must be avoided when navigating towards drilling locations
- The soil disturbance and clearance of vegetation at drill pad areas must be limited to the absolute minimum required;
- Vehicles and equipment must be regularly serviced and maintained;
- Refuelling of vehicles and equipment must be done with care to minimise the chance of spillages;
- A spill kit must be available on each site where prospecting activities are in progress; and
- Any spillages must be cleaned up immediately to prevent further contamination



Terrestrial Ecology

- The study area is located predominantly in the Eastern Highveld Grassland (Gm 12) vegetation type regarded as Endangered
- A small portion falls in the Eastern Temperate Freshwater Wetlands (AZf 3) located on Portions 42 and 43 of the farm Holfontein 71 IR
- Located in the Critically Endangered (CR) Blesbokspruit Highveld Grassland and a small section in the Vulnerable Eastern Highveld Grassland threatened ecosystems
- The study area is located in CBA: Important, ESA, Primary vegetation and Red Listed Bird Habitat (GDARD C-Plan)
- Large sections of the study area are located in category B (Highest Biodiversity Importance) and D (Moderate Biodiversity Importance) - Mining and Biodiversity Guideline

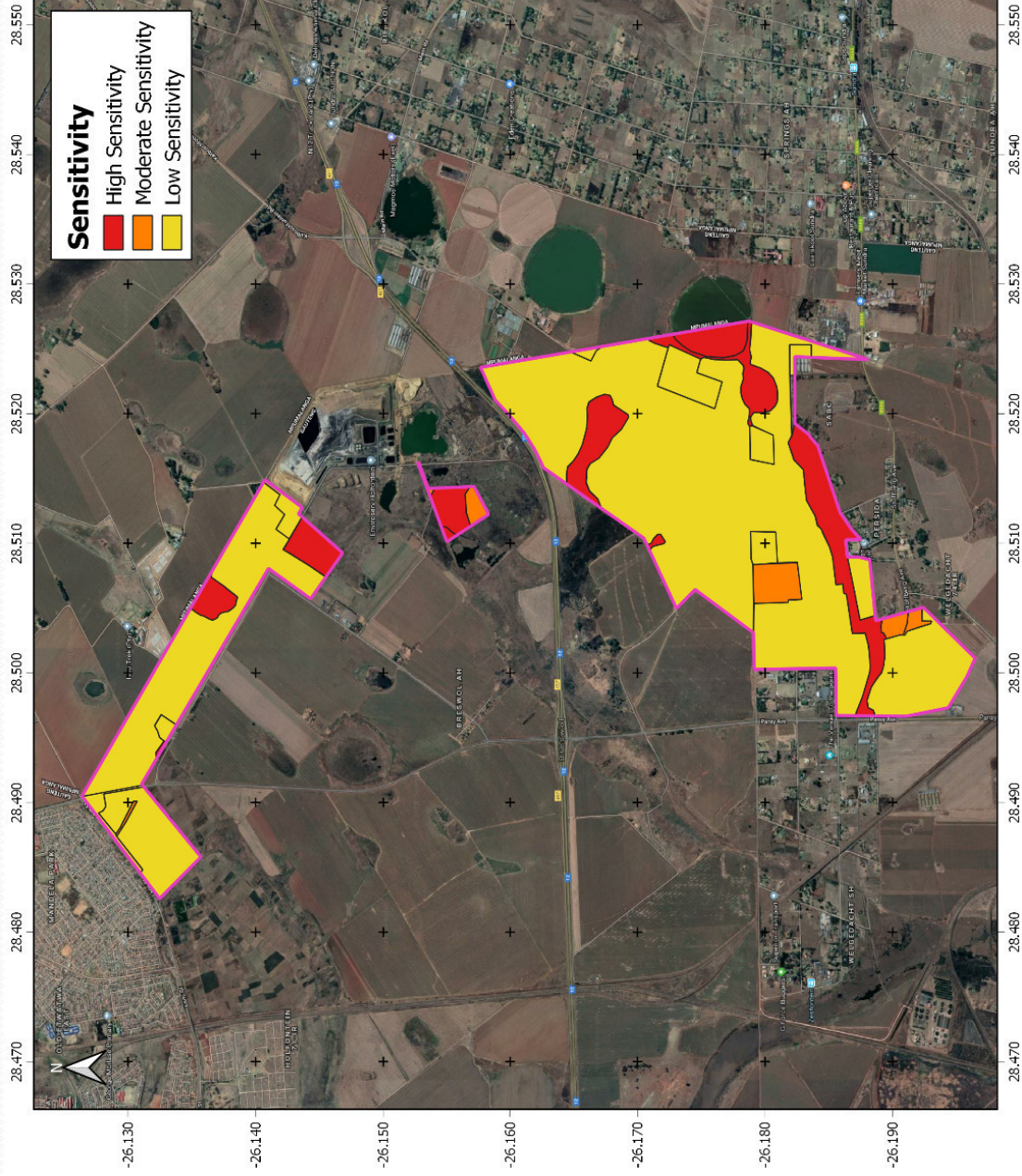

Heritage Impact Assessment

This study revealed that very few known heritage sites occur in the immediate vicinity of the study area. The following conclusions can be made:

- Archaeological or historical sites that might occur within the proposed development area will have a Generally Protected B (GP. B) rating and all sites should be mitigatable and no red flags are identified.
- Graves are of high social significance and can be expected anywhere in the landscape and pose the biggest risk to the project.
- According to the SAHRIS Paleontological map the area is of high paleontological significance.

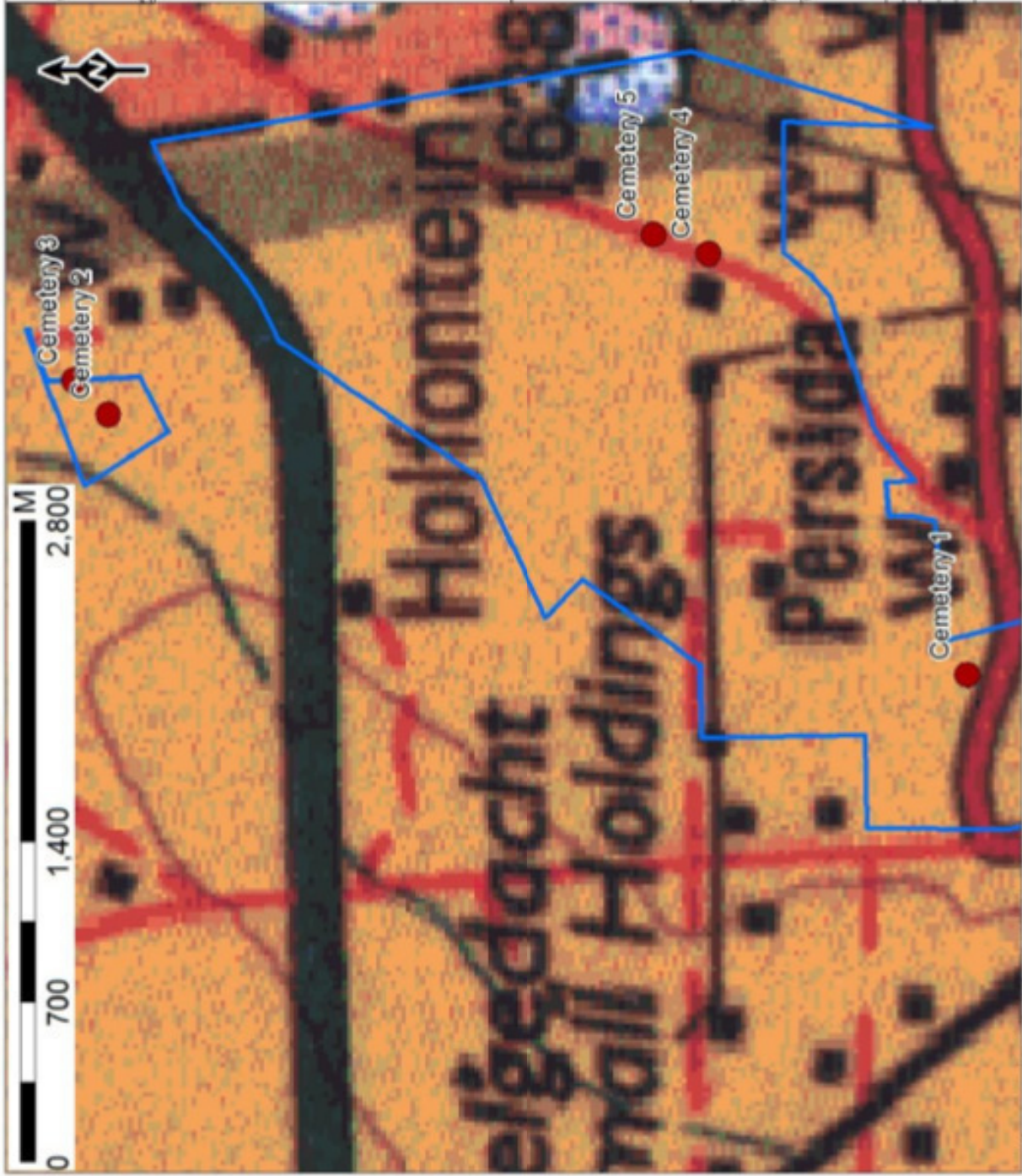
It is expected that identified impacts on heritage resources in this area can be mitigated to an acceptable level. From a heritage point of view the proposed project is considered to be viable and no fatal flaws are expected.

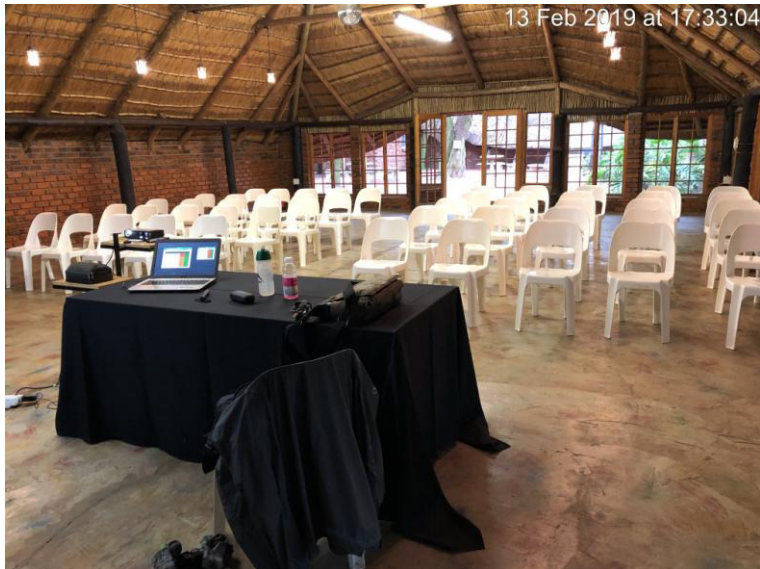

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION

Background Information Document
Proposed Welgedacht Prospecting Right Application
Reference: GP 30/5/1/1/2 (10553) PR

The above-mentioned and Registration and Comment Form dated January 2019 have relevance.

The National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) has no objection to the issuing of a Prospecting Right by the Department of Mineral Resources, subject to the following conditions:

SANRAL requirements relevant to prospecting:

- In the interest of road safety, drilling operations or exploration activities are not allowed inside the road reserve boundaries of any national road nor within a distance of 20 metres from the road reserve boundary – in this case national route N12;
- No direct access to a drilling site may be established from a national road without the written approval of SANRAL;
- Drilling sites shall be reinstated to their original condition on completion of drilling/prospecting operations;
- Where SANRAL properties outside the road reserve boundaries of national roads, currently on lease are affected, the written permission of the occupant(s) of the affected property(ies)

will be obtained before the commencement of any prospecting activities on the property(ies) concerned.

SANRAL requirements relevant to mining:

- Before mining commences an extensive traffic impact study shall be prepared by a registered traffic engineer and submitted to SANRAL for approval. This study will, apart from others, investigate the additional heavy vehicle traffic road trips generated, the tonnages of coal and gravel transported on roads for determination of the E80's, measures to negate the impact thereof on roads, and mining contribution towards maintaining and upgrading of roads affected;
- The applicant will adhere to sections 44 "Access to and egress from national roads", 46 "Damaging of national roads", and 48 "Structures and other works on, over or below national roads and certain other land" of the National Roads Agency Limited and national Roads Act, 1998, Act No. 7 of 1998, and other relevant legislation;
- No structures, including earth safety berms shall be established within the 60 metre building restriction area measured from the N12 road reserve boundaries without the written approval of SANRAL;
- No direct access to national route N12 will be permitted.
- No blasting within a distance of 500 metres of national N12 will be permitted without the written authorization of SANRAL.

There is no need to not register SANRAL as an I & AP as environmental, socio-economic and cultural issues falls outside the ambit of SANRAL.



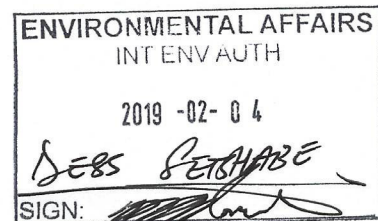
