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Invitation to register as an Interested and Affected Party, comment on the Draft Scoping Report

Background: TotalEnergies EP South Africa B.V. (TEEPSA) together with its joint venture partners, QatarEnergy, CNR International (South Africa) Limited, and a South African consortium, Main Street 1549 held an Exploration Right (Exploration Right Ref. No.: 12/3/067) over Block 11B/12B, offshore from the Southern Cape coast, South Africa. TEEPSA now seeks to convert its Exploration Right for the block into a Production Right in terms of Sections 83 to 86 of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (MPRDA: Act 28 of 2002), to allow for the development and production of gas and condensate in Licence Block 11B/12B.

Nature of activity: Proposed development and production related activities include: the drilling of up to six development wells, laying of deep-water subsea manifolds and flowlines to connect the production wells to the existing PetroSA FA Platform at Block 9, and exploration related activities, which might include the drilling of four exploration wells, sonar surveys, seafloor sampling surveys, and metocean surveys.

Location: Block 11B/12B is within the South African Exclusive Economic Zone in the Outeniqua Basin. The closest north-eastern point of the application area is ±75 km from Cape St Francis. The closest north-western point is ±120 km from Mossel Bay.

Applicant: The applicant is TotalEnergies EP South Africa B.V.

As part of the application process, an application for an Environmental Authorisation (EA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA: Act 107 of 1998) must also be submitted. The application for EA must be supported by a scoping and environmental impact assessment process in accordance with the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2014, as amended. The EA application must be submitted to the Petroleum Agency of South Africa (PASA) for a recommendation to the Minister of Minerals and Energy, who will decide on whether to grant the EA.
