SPRINGBOK - Die streepveldmuiseprojek het in 2001 in die Goegap Natuurreservaat begin. Professor Carsten Schradin verduidelik waarom dit so belangrik is om die gedrag en gewoontes van die streepmuis te bestudeer.

"Gestreepte muise word as model gebruik om te verstaan hoe diere klimaatsverandering kan hanteer, veral droogtes. Net soos ons laboratoriumknaagdiere benodig om wetenskaplike deurbrake in biomediese navorsing te maak, het ons ook modelorganismes nodig om te verstaan hoe globale verandering, insluitend klimaatsverandering, ons planeet beïnvloed.

Aangesien streepmuise slegs een jaar leef en daar elke jaar in die lente 'n nuwe generasie gebore word wat die wintermaande. In die reënseisoen vind voortplanting plaas en dan is daar meer kompetisie onder die muise en word die groepe onstabiel. "As die bevolkingsdigtheid laag is, kan hulle alleen leef om die konflik te vermy. In die somer woon hulle altyd in groepe. Hulle eet dan 'n baie algemene maar nie baie goeie struik nie; dus is daar geen kompetisie vir hierdie slegte voedselbron nie. Hulle slaap snags saam en maak mekaar warm wat hulle help om energie te bespaar sodat hulle minder kos benodig. Hulle is ook minder aktief in die somer om energie te bespaar," sê die professor.

Die studies toon daar is 'n verskil in die gedrag van muise in die somer teenoor die wintermaande. In die reënseisoen vind voortplanting plaas en dan is daar meer kompetisie onder die muise en word die groepe onstabiel. "As die bevolkingsdigtheid laag is, kan hulle alleen leef om die konflik te vermy. In die somer woon hulle altyd in groepe. Hulle eet dan 'n baie algemene maar nie baie goeie struik nie; dus is daar geen kompetisie vir hierdie slegte voedselbron nie. Hulle slaap snags saam en maak mekaar warm wat hulle help om energie te bespaar sodat hulle minder kos benodig. Hulle is ook minder aktief in die somer om energie te bespaar," sê die professor.

Die Universiteit van die Witwatersrand, Universiteit van Zurich (Switserland) en die CNRS Strasbourg Navorsingsentrum in Frankryk is betrokke by hierdie projek. Hul bevindings word in vooraanstaande internasionale joernale gepubliseer. 'n Ongelooftlike 80 artikels wat verband hou met hul werk in Goegap is die

afgelope 20 jaar gepubliseer.

Vanaf 2005 tot en met Maart 2020 was daar altyd studente by die navorsingstasie, maar weens Covid-19 moes dit sluit. In September en Oktober het daar egter weer 'n groep Suid-Afrikaanse studente kom werk. Een sal waarskynlik vroeg 2021 terugkeer om data vir haar PhD in te samel.

Professor Carsten sê wat die streepmuis so interessant maak, is die feit dat hulle "meesters in energiebesparing is en dat hulle saamwerk om dit te bereik." Die muise is baie sosiaal en help mekaar wanneer omstandighede versleg. Nietemin, in die uiterste droogte van 2003 het hulle amper uitgesterf. Dit is weer eens 'n bewys hoe broos ons natuurstelsel is.

Hy sê dat hulle bevind dat daar wel 'n verskil is tussen die kleiner en groter soogdiere. "Klein soogdiere het die meeste gely gedurende die relatief kort, maar uiterste droogte van Januarie tot Augustus 2003. Dit was so droog, daar was geen kos nie en die meeste het gevrek.

Groot soogdiere het vetreserwes gehad en het beter daarvan afgekom. Maar gedurende die droogtejare 2016-2019 het klein soogdiere relatief goed gevaar, terwyl groot soogdiere veel meer gely het. Dit wys ons dat verskillende vorme van droogtes ons natuurstelsels op verskillende maniere skadelik beïnvloed."

Watter ander navorsingspotensiaal bestaan daar in Namakwaland? "Studies oor die biodiversiteit van plante en insekte en aanpassing by droogtes. Ons begin nou met 'n studie oor die Karoo-rot om die koste en voordele van alleenstaande lewens te verstaan."

Hy sluit af deur te sê Namakwalanders moet besef dat hulle in 'n unieke omgewing van uiters hoë biodiversiteit leef wat baie kwesbaar is. Namakwaland het 'n groot aantal endemiese spesies en juis daarom moet ons hierdie area koester en na aan ons hart dra.
