Thank you for informing SAHRA of the proposed expansion to the existing open pit Kolomela Mine for iron ore near Postmasburg in the Northern Cape. The proposal for expansion is intended to facilitate an increase in production at the mine. To this end, additional infrastructure is required.

Although the details of the proposed expansion have not yet been finalised, it is envisaged that the required additional infrastructure will include water management infrastructure, office space, fuel storage, a change house, workshops, a first aid room, a sewerage treatment facility, laboratory space, housing infrastructure and more.

It is noted that the existing mine is underlain, at least in part, by the Cambell Rand Subgroup of the Transvaal Supergroup. This geological formation is known to be of moderate palaeontological significance.

According to the above reports, significant heritage resources are known from the area. However, as no details have yet been provided regarding the nature and location of the specific infrastructure required, SAHRA is unable to determine what heritage resources are likely to be impacted by the proposed development. More information is therefore required.

Interim Comment

SAHRA is unable to comment on the likely impact of the proposed expansion project on heritage resources as insufficient information has been provided. As such, SAHRA requires that the following information is provided before any further comments are issued;

- A Desktop Palaeontological Assessment is required to determine the impact of the proposed mine expansion on the Cambell Rand Subgroup which is known to have moderate heritage significance. This report must be authored by a palaeontological specialist.

- A report on the likely impact of the new proposed infrastructure on the heritage resources identified in the reports by D. Morris (2005), U. Kusel (2011) and M. van der Ryst (2011) is required. This report must identify the proposed location for new infrastructure development in relation to the known heritage resources. This report must also take into consideration the recommendations contained in the Heritage Management Plan for Kolomela Mine (Kusel, 2011).

SAHRA will await the submission of the above information before commenting further.
