Notice is given in terms of Regulations published in Government Notice No. R.543 in Government Guzatis No. 33306 18 June 2010, under Section 54(a)(j) of the National Environmental Management Act, 1996 (Act No.107 of 1995), as amended [NEMA], that Huddle investments (Pty) Ltd intends to undertake a development that will compromise of primarily Residential and Private Open Space components, with elements of Business.

The development is approximately \$5 heaters: in extent (excluding measurable) infrastructure), and will be located on proposed Portion 84 (a partion of the remainder) of the Ferm Bedford 65 IR, Linksfeld, City of Johannesburg Metropoliten Municipality (CJMM), Gauteng Province. The proposed site is bordered by Linksfield Road and Club Street.
