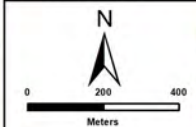

PROJECT BACKGROUND & DESCRIPTION

In support of the need to find solutions for the current electricity shortages, the increasing demand for energy, as well as the need to find more sustainable and environmentally friendly energy resources, South Africa has embarked on an infrastructure growth programme supported by various government initiatives. In response to this goal, Leeuwbosch PV Generation (Pty) Ltd and Leeudoringstad Solar Plant (Pty) Ltd are proposing to construct two (2) solar photovoltaic (PV) facilities (namely the Leeuwbosch 1 and Leeuwbosch 2 Solar PV Plant, each with a generation capacity of up to 9.9MW) and a 132kV/11kV substation (namely the Leeudoringstad Solar Plant Substation) near the town of Leeudoringstad in the North West Province. The overall objective of the projects is to generate electricity (by capturing solar energy) to feed into the national electricity grid and “wheel” the power to customers based on a power purchase agreement. Additionally, an agreement is in place to sell the energy to PowerX, who hold a NERSA-issued electricity trading license which allows them to purchase energy generated from clean and renewable resources and sell it to its customers.

PROJECT TECHNICAL DETAILS

Leeuwbosch 1 and Leeuwbosch 2 Solar PV Plant

At this stage, it is anticipated that the proposed solar PV plants will include PV fields (arrays) comprising multiple PV modules with a maximum total generation capacity of up to approximately 9.9MW. The associated infrastructure would include, but not be limited to, internal access roads, one (1) switching substation per PV plant, one (1) permanent guard house per PV plant and one (1) temporary building zone per PV plant. The electricity generated by the proposed solar PV plants will be fed into the national electricity grid via the Leeudoringstad Solar Plant Substation.

In summary, the following key components are to be constructed as part of each proposed solar PV plant:

- Solar PV arrays:
 - The proposed solar PV plant will include PV fields (arrays) comprising multiple PV modules.
 - PV panel mountings. PV panels will be single axis tracking mounting, and the modules will be either crystalline silicon or thin film technology.
 - Each PV module will be approximately 2274mm (≈2.3m) long and 1134mm (≈1.1m) wide and mounted on supporting structures above ground. At this stage it is anticipated that the structures will be mono-facial modules. The final design details will become available during the detailed design phase of the proposed development, prior to the start of construction.
 - The foundations will most likely be either concrete or rammed piles. The final foundation design will be determined at the detailed design phase of the proposed development
- On-site Switching Substation:
 - Each solar PV plant will include the construction of one (1) new on-site switching substation with a capacity of more than 33kV but less than 275kV. The switching substation will occupy an area of up to approximately 0.2ha.
 - The switching substation will contain transformer(s) for voltage step-up from medium voltage to high voltage. DC power from the modules will be converted into AC power in the inverters and the voltage will be stepped up to medium voltage in the inverter transformers.
 - Medium voltage cabling (anticipated to be approx. 0.8m x 0.6m wide at this stage) will link the various PV arrays to the switching substation as well as the Leeudoringstad Solar Plant Substation. These cables will be laid underground, wherever technically feasible.
- Access Roads:
 - Access to the solar PV plants will be via an existing gravel road which connect to the tarred R502 road.

- Existing internal gravel roads will be used to access the PV arrays as well as the on-site switching substation.
- New internal gravel roads of up to approximately 4m wide may however be constructed, where necessary.
- One (1) permanent guard house for each solar PV plant, each occupying a site of approximately 0.0876ha (i.e. 876m²).
- Fencing will surround the entire extent of each proposed solar PV plant. At this stage it is anticipated that the fencing will be approximately 2.1m high and will be made of galvanised steel with electrification on top. In addition, fencing is anticipated to cover an area of up to approximately 18ha for each solar PV plant.
- Temporary infrastructure:
 - to obtain water from available local sources. Existing boreholes will be utilised. Water will potentially be stored in temporary water storage tanks. The necessary approvals from the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) will be applied for separately (should this be required).
 - One (1) temporary building zone per solar PV plant which will each occupy a site of up to approximately 0.2944ha (i.e. 2 944m²).

Leeudoringstad Solar Plant Substation

The project will include the construction of one (1) new 132/11kV on-site substation (namely the Leeudoringstad Solar Plant Substation) to serve the Solar PV Plant projects, occupying an area of up to approximately 10 016m² (i.e. 0.1ha). The proposed substation will be a step-up substation and will contain transformer(s) for voltage step-up from medium voltage to high voltage. Direct Current (DC) power from the respective solar PV plants will be converted into Alternating Current (AC) power in the inverters and the voltage will be stepped up to medium voltage in the inverter transformers.

Leeudoringstad Solar Plant Substation Site Alternatives

Two (2) location / site alternatives for the proposed substation site (both located within Portion 37 of the Farm Leeuwbosch No. 44) have been considered and comparatively assessed by the respective specialists. The substation site alternatives were informed by the identified environmental sensitive and/or “no-go” areas, as various environmental specialists assessed the project area during their respective investigations.

PROJECT LOCATION

The above-mentioned proposed projects will be located between 5-7km east of the town of Leeudoringstad in the Maquassi Hills Local Municipality, within the Dr Kenneth Kaunda District Municipality of the North West Province. All three (3) of the above-mentioned proposed projects will be located on Portion 37 of the Farm Leeuwbosch No. 44.

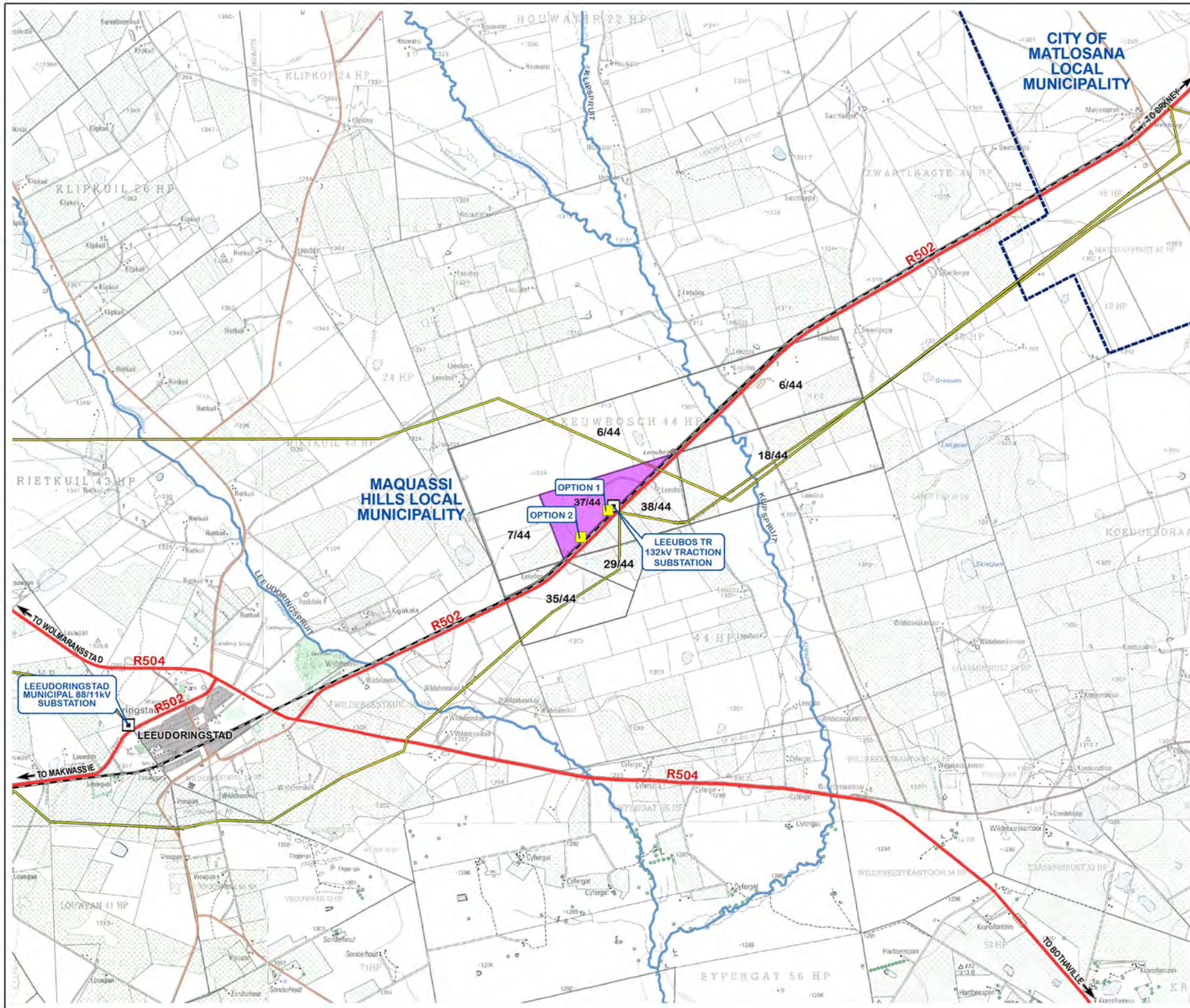
