Proposed trial mining activities**









**NOTIFICATION WITH RESPECT TO THE APPLICATION FOR A MINING RIGHT
FOR THE PROPOSED DOORNHOEK FLUORSPAR MINE ON VARIOUS PORTIONS
OF FARMS AS INDICATED ON THE ATTACHED FIGURE 1: ZEERUST DISTRICT**

SOUTHERN PALACE 398 (PTY) LIMITED**

SA Fluorite (Pty) Limited and Southern Palace 398 (Pty) Limited are exploration and mining companies which hold prospecting rights over the area shown on Figure 1. The controlling interest in both these companies is held by the ERG Group which is planning on consolidating the prospecting rights and applying for a mining right over the consolidated area.

Prospecting activities which were carried out over the past few years indicated that economically viable concentrations of fluorspar may be found underlying these properties, and hence the reason for applying for a consolidated mining right.

Your farms fall within the mining right area, and this letter serves to inform you of our planned activities, and also offer you the opportunity to comment on the proposal and to voice your concerns. A formal public participation process in accordance with the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of 2014 will be initiated (GN R982 of 8 December 2014). A public meeting will also be held where all other interested and affected parties will have the opportunity to voice their concerns.

Due to poor international market conditions it will be necessary to gradually phase in the mining activities, and to divide the mining activities into two phases. The first phase will take place on portions of Renosterfontein 304 JP, and the second phase will take place on portions of Farm 306

JP. The mine surface infrastructure is proposed to be located on the above farms. Additional mineral resources are also located on surrounding farms within the mining right area.

Phase 1 activities involve the following:

During phase 1, the company is planning on erecting an approximately 50 ton/hr pilot plant on Renosterfontein. The purpose of this plant will be to test the metallurgy of the ore, and also to produce sufficient tonnages required for marketing purposes.

Water studies are underway to determine the source of the required water supply. This will be done in cooperation with the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS), and will not be sourced without a valid water use license. Impacts relating to water quantity and quality will be assessed by means of specialist assessment during the EIA process. Water and waste water management will be strictly controlled as to minimize the impacts on surface or underground water sources.

All activities will be rehabilitated upon completion in accordance with the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA) Regulations pertaining to the Financial Provision for Prospecting, Exploration, Mining or Production Operations (GN R1147).

Phase 2 activities involve the following:

Phase 2 will involve the erection of a larger processing plant, with an associated mining operation. Surface lease agreements will be negotiated with those surface owners that will be affected by the planned operations.

Waste dumps and rehabilitation will be strictly managed in terms of the approved environmental management programme.

Similar to phase 1, water studies are underway to determine the source of the required water supply. This will be done in cooperation with DWS, and will not be sourced without a valid water use license. Impacts relating to water quantity and quality will be assessed by means of specialist assessment during the EIA process. Water and waste water management will be strictly controlled as to minimize the impacts on surface or underground water sources.

Labour will be sourced from the local community as far as possible, and is planned to be accommodated in the town of Zeerust.

Should at any stage access be required to any of the farms, the explicit consent of the owner will be acquired prior to access.

All mining activities will be undertaken in accordance with the company's strict mine, health and safety rules, as well as all legislative requirements, and all disturbances will be rehabilitated upon completion.

In terms of timing, mining activities will commence within three months of the granting of all relevant authorizations, licenses and permits. This process could take at least a year.




