Black Mountain Mining (Pty) Ltd (the Applicant) has submitted an application for a Prospecting Right in terms of Section 16 of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (Act 28 of 2002) (MPRDA) and an Application for Environmental Authorization in terms of Chapter 6 of GNR 326 promulgated under the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998) (NEMA) to prospect for ferrous & base metals (Copper Ore, Iron Ore, Zinc Ore, Lead Ore, Manganese Ore, Nickel and Molybdenum) and all associated metals and minerals, precious metals (Gold Ore, Silver Ore) and all associated metals and minerals as well as nuclear fuels (Uranium) and all associated metals and minerals. The proposed project that will aim to ascertain if economically viable mineral deposits exist within the application area. In order to undertake prospecting activities, Black Mountain Mining will require a Prospecting Right in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act (MPRDA, Act No.28 of 2002). The Applicant is also required to obtain an Environmental Authorisation (EA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, Act No. 107 of 1998) which involves the submission of a Basic Assessment Report (BAR). Environmental Impact Management Services (Pty) Ltd (EIMS) have been appointed by Black Mountain Mining to compile the BAR in support of the Prospecting Right application submitted by EIMS on behalf of Black Mountain Mining, which in turn will be submitted to the DMR for adjudication.

Environmental Impact Management Services was appointed by Black Mountain Mining (Pty) Ltd to conduct a Basic Assessment Process in support of an Environmental Authorisation (EA) Application for proposed prospecting activities on several farms in the Namakwaland Magisterial District, Northern Cape Province. A draft Basic Assessment Report (BAR) has been submitted in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (NEMA) and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2014 for activities that trigger the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (MPRDA)(As amended). The application area is 57 951.951 ha and prospecting activities will include drilling of 30 boreholes. Supporting infrastructure will include access roads.

Van Ryneveld, K. 2017. Phase 1 Archaeological and Cultural Heritage Impact Assessment: Koa Valley Prospecting Right Application (without Bulk Sampling), Portions of the Farms Haramoep 53, Oonab-Noord 609, Amam 46 and Nooisabes 51, near Springbok/Aggeneys, Namakwa District Municipality, Northern Cape.

Low density Middle Stone Age (MSA) and Later Stone Age (LSA) artefacts are present in surface gravels near proposed boreholes BH0221, BH031, and BH0232. These sites were rated as having a low significance rating. A possible MSA/LSA workshop was identified at proposed borehole BH0071 and an occupied Colonial Period farmstead is present within the application area. The workshop site was rated as a site of low significance while the farmstead was rated as highly significant. The farmstead will not be directly impacted by the proposed prospecting activities; however, the remaining identified heritage sites will be directly impacted.

It is noted that the BAR states that 30 boreholes will be drilled, while the HIA assessed 34 boreholes.

Recommendations provided in the report include the following:

- Future mining application, resulting from the prospecting application, may have more direct impact on archaeological resources as well as a visual and cumulative impact on the cultural landscape;
- In the event of any incidental archaeological and cultural heritage resources, as defined and protected by the National Heritage Resources Act, Act 25 of 1999 (NHRA), being identified during the course of the development, and not reported on this report, the process described in the Heritage Management Plan should be followed.

Butler, E. 2016. Palaeontological Desktop Assessment for the Proposed Prospecting Right Project without Bulk Sampling, in the Koa Valley, Northern Cape Province.

The proposed prospecting right area is underlain by the Mid-Proterozoic basement rocks of the Namaqua-Natal Metamorphic Province (Bushmanland Group), which do not contain fossils. They are mantled by Caenozoic superficial deposits that may contain fossils; however, these rocks are rated as having low significance in terms of palaeontological resources as such occurrences are sparse and low in diversity.

Recommendations included in the report include that should fossil remains be discovered in the Caenozoic superficial deposits during any phase of construction, either on the surface or exposed by fresh excavations, the Environmental Control Officer (ECO) responsible for these development should be alerted immediately. Such discoveries ought to be protected (preferably *in situ*) and the ECO should alert SAHRA so that

appropriate mitigation (e.g. recording, sampling or collection) can be undertaken by a professional palaeontologist.

Additional recommendations included in the BAR include the following:

- There is a need for temporary heritage signage during the construction phase around the Colonial Farmstead
- If a possible heritage site (including graves) or artefact is discovered during construction, all operations in the vicinity of the discovery (at least 30 m buffer) should stop and a qualified specialist contracted to evaluate and recommend appropriate actions. Depending on the type of site that can include initiating a grave relocation process, documentation of structures or archaeological excavations.

Final Comment

The SAHRA Archaeology, Palaeontology and Meteorites (APM) Unit has no objection to the proposed development and accepts the heritage specialist reports and the recommendations contained therein. The recommendations contained within the reports and the following conditions must be included in the Environmental Management Programme (EMPr):

- The Final BAR and appendices must be submitted to SAHRA for record purposes;
- If any evidence of archaeological sites or remains (e.g. remnants of stone-made structures, indigenous ceramics, bones, stone artefacts, ostrich eggshell fragments, charcoal and ash concentrations), fossils or other categories of heritage resources are found during the proposed development, SAHRA APM Unit (Natasha Higgitt/John Gribble 021 462 5402) must be alerted. If unmarked human burials are uncovered, the SAHRA Burial Grounds and Graves (BGG) Unit (Mimi Seetelo 012 320 8490), must be alerted immediately. A professional archaeologist or palaeontologist, depending on the nature of the finds, must be contracted as soon as possible to inspect the findings. If the newly discovered heritage resources prove to be of archaeological or palaeontological significance, a Phase 2 rescue operation may be required subject to permits issued by SAHRA; and
- If the development receives an Environmental Authorisation (EA), SAHRA must be informed and all documents pertaining to the EA must be uploaded to the SAHRIS Case file.
