## NOTICE OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION PROCESS FOR EASTERN PLATINUM – MARIKANA OPERATIONS' PROPOSED RE-MINING OF ITS TAILINGS DAM 2, LOCATED NEAR MARIKANA, NORTH WEST PROVINCE

#### 1. Introduction and Background

Sibanye-Stillwater owns and operates the Marikana Operations located near Marikana, in the North-West Province. The Marikana Operations are divided into Western Platinum (Pty) Ltd (WPL) and Eastern Platinum (Pty) Ltd (EPL), each with its own set of mining rights. Marikana Operations are currently mining both the Merensky and Upper Group 2 Reef (UG2) for Platinum Group Metals (PGMs).

The EPL Tailings Dam Complex comprises two tailings dams, namely Tailings Dam 1 (TD1) and Tailings Dam 2 (TD2). TD1 has been dormant since October 2004 and re-mining of this facility commenced in February 2018. TD2 has been operational since 2002 with tailings deposited from EPL and Eastern Platinum Concentrator (EPC) plants.

It is the intension of Sibanye-Stillwater to commence with the re-mining of TD2, once the remining of TD1 is completed. Re-mining will be undertaken via a hydraulic mining process and tailings material will be transported in existing pipelines to the UG2 Concentrator for retreatment. Before Sibanye-Stillwater may commence with the re-mining of TD2, environmental authorisation needs to be obtained.

#### 2. Purpose of this letter

This notification letter provides stakeholders with information about the proposed project, the regulatory processes and how to become involved in the process. Alta van Dyk Environmental Consultants cc (AVDE) has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to undertake the required environmental authorisation and associated public participation process.

You are invited to register as an Interested and Affected Party (I&AP) for this project and to comment or raise any issue of concern. To register for the proposed project and receive additional notifications, please complete the enclosed registration form, and send to the undersigned.

## 3. Location of the project

A description of the property on which the proposed project is located is provided in Table 1. Figure 1 provides a visual representation of the TD2 to be re-mined. Refer to



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#### 4. Legislative requirements

The environmental authorisation required for the proposed remining of EPL TD2 is as follows:

 A Basic Assessment process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act (Act 107 of 1998) (NEMA) and the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations. The competent authority for this process is the North West Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE);




Figure 3: Basic Assessment Environmental Authorisation Processes

During the Basic Assessment process, potential impacts are identified, and management measures are proposed to mitigate negative impacts and enhance positive impacts. A Basic Assessment Report will be compiled and made available for public comment for a period of 30 days. All registered I&AP's will be informed of the availability of the Draft Basic Assessment Report. Once the public comment period is concluded, the Basic Assessment Report will be updated with the comments received from stakeholders and will be submitted to DMRE for decision making. The legislative process to be followed is illustrated in Figure 3 overleaf.
