- Are concerned that the development area falls on land that is under the tribal authority and is not municipal land, and there are houses being built in the area.
- Concerns regarding radiation from a 22kv line and impacts on stray animals and people living in the vicinity.
- Would like to understand the economic benefits of local SMMEs regarding the project and/or how contractors are to be chosen.

As explained telephonically we are currently conducting an Environmental Impact Assessment and the Basic Assessment process is being followed. Once the report has been drafted and placed out for public review all registered Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) would be notified of the opportunity to review the report and comment.
